New Finance Director Named in Menlo Park

MENLO PARK, CA – Alex D. McIntyre, City Manager of Menlo Park, today announced the selection of Drew Corbett as the City’s new Finance Director. Corbett will succeed Carol Augustine who left in March to become Finance Director with the City of Burlingame, CA. Mr. Corbett will begin work on August 14.

Corbett has served as the Assistant Director of Finance for the City of Sunnyvale for the last three years. Sunnyvale has a \$285 million budget with over 850 permanent employees. Previously, he served in budget leadership positions with Sunnyvale following five years of financial analyst experience with Intel Corporation in Santa Clara. McIntyre said, “Drew is energetic, ambitious and enthusiastic. We’re looking forward to adding Drew’s exceptional public and private sector experience to our talented leadership team and expect his skills will support our goal of continuing to improve Menlo Park’s already excellent financial condition.”

With a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from the University of the South, Corbett joined the Teach for America Corps teaching for two years in Compton, CA. Corbett then earned a Masters in Business Administration from the University of Wisconsin. He serves as a board member of the California Society of Municipal Finance Officers.

“Menlo Park has a reputation as a well-managed and financially-sound city that provides an excellent level of service to its residents and business community,” said Mr. Corbett. “I am very excited about joining the leadership team and contributing to the continued success of the organization.”

Corbett and his family live in San Jose. His annual salary will be \$171,000.
