Dear Indiana Trauma System Stakeholder:

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) is pleased to announce the 2015 Trauma Tour, which will run from June through August. ISDH Division of Trauma and Injury Prevention staff, along with local stakeholders, will hold "open house" style meetings in all 10 Indiana public health preparedness districts for Hoosiers to learn more about trauma, how state and local agencies currently respond to trauma and how a trauma system could help the state.

Injury is the #1 killer of Americans ages 1-44. A traumatic injury is a severe injury or injuries requiring rapid evaluation and transport to specific hospitals with trauma care capabilities. More than 4,409 died from injuries in Indiana in 2013 and nearly 32,000 Hoosiers are hospitalized every year from injuries.

In previous years, the ISDH Trauma and Injury Prevention staff toured all 10 preparedness districts and gathered information and again this year, we think we have new and improved developments to share about different ways we can prevent injuries in Indiana. We invite local stakeholders, including hospitals, emergency medical services, fire departments, county health departments, rehab facilities and Area Agencies on Aging to join us with displays and information on how your organization helps prevent injuries and assist in trauma when it happens.

The Trauma Tour kicks off with its first stop in District 10 (Knox, Daviess, Martin, Gibson, Pike, Dubois, Crawford, Posey, Vanderburgh, Warrick, Spencer and Perry counties) on **Tuesday, June 30** at the Southern Indiana Career & Technical Center, 1901 Lynch Road, Evansville, IN 47711 from 2 to 5p.m. (Central).
