


Online Crime Mapping





<u>All Shifts</u> Patrol the Norfolk Area, including not only Norfolk Proper, but also the surrounding area of Lambert and Sanford, Buechel Bank, Bannon Crossing and Brandon Dunes and Buechel Bank. Patrol the area off of Old Bardstown Rd. by the Buechel Bypass.

First Platoon A Burglary at (Dairy Mart) Fegenbush and Norfolk. Arrested Eugene Hatcher

Second Platoon A Burglary in the 4000 Blk. Hurstbourne Woods occurred during this shift.

<u>Third Platoon</u> Three Burglaries (2000 Blk. Shady Grove, 4000 Blk. Orchard Lake, 4300 Blk. Norbrook) and a TFA in the 3300 Blk. Fegenbush occurred during this shift.

<u>Flex Platoon</u> Emphasize drug enforcement in Norfolk.

<u>Quality of Life Issues</u> Emphasize enforcement in school zones.

<u>All Shifts</u> Increase patrol in the Bon Air, High Gate Springs and Breckenridge Estates. These areas have been experiencing burglaries and TFAs on all shifts. The trend of particular concern is the sharp increase in daytime burglaries in the Bon Air and High Gate Springs area over the past 2 weeks.

Increase patrol in the area of Klondike, Mid Dale, Brinkey, White Hall, Clingstone, and Orchard Manor.

<u>First Platoon</u> A Burglary in the 1700 Blk. Summerset occurred during this shift and a TFA in the 4100 Blk. Hunsinger Woods probably occurred during this shift.

Several Burglaries occurred on day shift in the Bon Air/Seneca High School area. These Burglaries include 2 in the 3700 Blk. Downing; and 1 in the 2900 Blk. Rio Rita, and the 2400 Blk. Proctor Knott. An additional Burglary in the 2300 Blk. Meadow probably occurred during this shift. Additionally, a strong arm Robbery (purse snatch) occurred in the 3300 Blk. Bardstown.

<u>Third Platoon</u> Burglary in the 3000 Blk. Pamela Way occurred during this shift.

<u>Quality of Life Issues</u> Look for any parties possibly involved in the TFAs and graffiti issues in Brookhaven and St. Regis Park over the past month. Look in on Doral Court where several cars have been keyed and had their tires slashed.


If you have stuff that you are **not willing to lose**, I suggest you keep it in one of these or a safe!
