Utility Relocation Work, Wilshire and Fairfax

SUMMARY

Utility relocation work will occur on Saturday September 13th and Saturday September 27th, 2014 at the intersection of Wilshire and Fairfax from 8:00am-5:00pm. Metro contractors are working to make room for the future Wilshire/Fairfax Station of the Metro Purple Line Extension.

Work consists of pot holing, excavation & asphalt removal.

This work will be occurring in the street but at least one lane of traffic will be maintained in all directions during construction.

ESSENTIALS

- 8:00am to 5:00pm
- Sept. 13- No left turns on Fairfax at Wilshire for northbound traffic. No left turns on Wilshire at Fairfax for westbound traffic
- Sept. 27- No left turns on Fairfax at Wilshire for southbound traffic. No left turns on Wilshire at Fairfax for eastbound traffic

NOTEWORTHY

WHAT TO EXPECT

- All work has received necessary permits and approvals.
- Access for pedestrians will be maintained outside of the construction zone.
- Access for emergency responders will be maintained.
