Utility Relocation Work, Wilshire and Fairfax

West Segment

SUMMARY

Fiber relocation work will continue on Wilshire, east of Fairfax from October 26 - October 28, 2014, from 8pm-6am. Metro contractors are working to make room for the future Wilshire/Fairfax Station of the Metro Purple Line Extension.

Work consists of excavation and backfill.

This work will be occurring in the street but at least one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction during construction.

ESSENTIALS

- 8pm to 6am, Sunday through Tuesday
- October 26th – October 28th
- One lane of traffic will remain open in both directions Sunday – Tuesday

WHAT TO EXPECT

- All work has received necessary permits and approvals.
- Access for pedestrians will be maintained outside of the construction zone.
- Access for emergency responders will be maintained.
- Access to homes and businesses will be maintained at all times unless notified in advance.

NOTEWORTHY

- Work dates are subject to change
- There will be no utility service interruptions
- Right and left turn restrictions may be implemented during construction
