Forecasting – Where to find information on upcoming City projects

Forecasting is a valuable tool allowing businesses, especially small, minority, and women-owned businesses, sufficient time to identify and prepare for contracting opportunities of interest. Where can your business locate information on planned City projects before they have been solicited?

- Bureau of Purchases' [Consolidated List of City Contracts \(PDF File\)](#). This report lists all current contracts procured and/or managed by the Department of Finance/Bureau of Purchases on behalf of City agencies. The report, updated periodically, provides a breakdown of projects by buyer, description, agency, vendor, contract expiration date and any renewals. Look for contracts expiring within the year that have no renewal options.
- The [FY 2016 Baltimore City Design and Construction Presentation \(PDF File\)](#). Each year, the City's major construction agencies (Departments of Public Works, Transportation, Housing and Community Development, General Services, and Recreation and Parks) holds a Design and Construction Presentation outreach event to provide contractors with information on upcoming projects in the new fiscal year. This presentation contains a breakdown of projects by agency with descriptions, anticipated advertisement quarter, and agency contacts.
