

WATER RESOURCES DIVISION DENNIS AND NANCY SCHREUR, HELENA TOWNSHIP, ANTRIM COUNTY, PERMIT APPLICATION NUMBER 13-05-0069-P. The Water Resources Division has reviewed modified plans submitted March 06, 2015, and is proposing to issue a permit to Dennis and Nancy Schreur. The modified proposal requests the construction of an 80-foot long, 6-foot wide open pile dock, a 36-foot long, 4-foot wide section of dock perpendicular to the main dock, and two 38-foot long, 4-foot wide sections of dock on Clam Lake. Additionally, discharge of 30 cubic yards of peastone to an area 40 feet long by 20 feet wide to a depth of 6 inches below the ordinary high water mark. The DEQ recommends approval of the scaled back modified project from the original proposal of a new 64 feet long by 40 feet wide four slip boathouse.
