2014 INTRASTATE RENEWAL APPLICATIONS HAVE BEEN MAILED

The 2014 applications for renewal of MPSC authority were mailed out October 1, 2013. These are renewals for Intrastate only, Household Goods, and Temporary Discontinuance authorities and vehicle registrations. To insure processing of your 2014 credentials by January 1, 2014, renewal applications must be received in our office by December 1, 2013. Renewals not postmarked by December 31, 2013, will not be accepted and those MPSC authorities will be revoked.

How can you expedite the processing of your renewal?

You can take steps prior to receiving your renewal which will assist you in expediting your completion of the renewal process. The following are suggestions for your consideration now to prepare for the receipt of your renewal package.

Review your insurance coverage expiration date(s) – Renewal applications are reviewed to assure that required insurance coverage is on file and is valid. Check your coverage to determine your current expiration dates to insure you will have coverage on file when you submit the renewal application.

General commodity carriers (intrastate only) are required to maintain proof of valid, effective PL/PD coverage on file with the MPSC.

Household goods carriers are required to maintain proof of valid, effective PL/PD and cargo insurance on file with the MPSC.

If your required coverage has expired, the processing of your renewal will be delayed until replacement coverage has been received.

Review your current vehicle registrations and needs for 2014 – Vehicle registration information will be required to complete most renewal applications. Review your fleet to identify those vehicles to be registered for 2014 operations and those which may be retired from your fleet at the end of 2013. Lease agreements should also be reviewed for vehicles to be registered for 2014. New lease agreements will be required for the renewal of registration where the lease on file with MPSC expires prior to February 1, 2014.

Watch your mail for the renewal mailing – The first step to completing the renewal process is in receiving the renewal package sent by MPSC. Watch the mail for your renewals! If you do not receive your renewal package in October 2013, please contact MPSC at 517-241-6030 for further information.

File your renewal application early – Applications are processed in the order in which they are received. Renewals delivered in person to our office location, will not be processed at the time of delivery. Also, office closures on holidays and holiday mail processing can delay the delivery, processing and return of your renewal.

Non- payment of UCR Fees - If sent a 2014 renewal package, an intrastate motor carrier with interstate operations must pay their 2013 and 2014 UCR Program fee before January 1, 2014, or return a completed renewal package in order to keep their intrastate authority active for 2014. If you have paid the 2013 and 2014 UCR fees, verify your USDOT number, simply write on the renewal application that you do conduct interstate operations and have paid the 2013 and 2014 UCR Program fees. If you had active UCR for 2013, but have changed your authority to intrastate only, you will need to contact our office (517-241-6030) to receive a 2014 intrastate renewal application from us in order to obtain MPSC decals for your vehicles.

What is Unified Carrier Registration?

The Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) is a system for registering motor carriers operating in interstate commerce, including private, for-hire, and exempt carriers; farmers operating in interstate commerce; and brokers, freight forwarders, and leasing companies.

The UCR registration requirement is enforced on motor carriers for the current year and the previous two UCR registration years. Please ensure that you have registered for 2012 and 2013 UCR when registering for 2014 UCR, if you are registered with the FMCSA as a motor carrier conducting interstate operations during that time. LEGISLATION EXEMPTS SOME INTRASTATE CARRIERS FROM FMCSA SAFETY REGULATIONS

Public Act 231, eff. June 29, 2012, amended the Michigan Motor Carrier Safety Act (PA 181 of 1963). With the amendment, sections of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations no longer apply to a vehicle that does not meet the definition of a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) in 383.5 of the federal regulations, and, is operated in intrastate commerce. A CMV that does not meet the definition of 383.5 and operates in intrastate commerce is not subject to the following:

- 1) Obtaining or displaying a USDOT number,
- 2) Hours of Service regulations
- 3) Compliance with the vehicle inspection requirements

Vehicles exempted by Public Act 231 continue to be subject to sections 391 through 393 of federal regulations. These sections pertain to driver qualifications, safe vehicle operation, required vehicle maintenance and cargo securement.

Vehicles being transported continue to be defined as hazardous materials; therefore, towing and other vehicle transport operations are subject to the 1 million dollar hazardous materials insurance requirements of Act 254.

Under 49 CFR 383.5, Commercial Motor Vehicle means a motor vehicle or combination of motor vehicles used in commerce to transport passengers or property if the motor vehicle meets one of the following criteria:

- (1) Has a gross combination weight rating or gross combination weight of 11,794 kgs or more (26,001 lbs. or more), whichever is greater, inclusive of a towed unit(s) with a gross vehicle weight rating or gross vehicle weight of more than 4,536 kgs (10,000 lbs.), whichever is greater; or
- (2) Has a gross vehicle weight rating or gross vehicle weight of 11,794 or more kilograms (26,001 lbs. or more), whichever is greater; or
- (3) Is designed to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver; or
- (4) Is of any size and is used in the transportation of hazardous materials and is required to be placarded under subpart F of 49 CFR part 172 or any quantity of a material listed as a select agent or toxin in 42 CFR 73.

Intrastate commerce means any trade, traffic or transportation in any state that is not described in the definition of interstate commerce.

Under 49 CFR 390.5, Interstate commerce means trade, traffic, or transportation in the United States:

- (1) Between a place in a State and a place outside of such State (including a place outside of the United States)
- (2) Between two places in a State while passing through another State or a place outside of the United States
- (3) Between two places in a State as part of trade, traffic, or transportation originating or terminating outside the State or the U.S.

USDOT NUMBERING PROGRAM

The USDOT # is available free of charge and is easy to obtain via telephone or online. The phone number to call is 1-888-464-8736. The hours of operation are Monday – Friday 8:30 am – 12:00 noon and 1:00 pm – 4:30 pm. This web site has step-by-step instructions in obtaining a USDOT number or updating an existing registration:

This service involves **no fee** and provides step-by-step explanation and guidance to complete registration. Upon completion of all requested information, carriers will be issued their unique USDOT number while on line. The screen displaying the assigned USDOT number should be printed and a copy retained in your file. A USDOT notification letter will be sent to you by mail.

USDOT Q&A

I want to inactivate or reactivate my USDOT Number. Can I do this online?

You are allowed to inactivate your USDOT Number online, using your Personal Identification Number (PIN). However, you cannot reactivate your USDOT Number online.

To reactivate a USDOT Number, you will need to send a signed letter on your company's letterhead, listing your USDOT Number, the name, address and phone number of the company, and a request to reactivate your USDOT Number to:

How can I update my USDOT record?

You can update your USDOT Number over the Internet at https://li-public.fmcsa.dot.gov/LIVIEW/PKG_REGISTRATION.prc_option by filing a MCS-150 (Motor Carrier Identification Report). To update online you will need a Personal Identification Number (PIN) but the good news is that you can also apply for your PIN online at https://li-public.fmcsa.dot.gov/LIVIEW/PKG_PIN_START.PRC_INTRO.

You may also update your USDOT record by filing a MCS-150 by mail. You may mail the forms to FMCSA, MCMIS Team, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE, Washington, DC 20590. Please put "update" on the MCS-150 form and make all necessary changes. You can also call toll free number at 1-800-832-5660 to have an MCS-150 form mailed to you.

ENFORCEMENT POLICY

Enforcement Policy – Court Decision on the 30-Minute Rest Break Provision

BACKGROUND:

HOS Final Rule: On December 27, 2011 (76 FR 81133), FMCSA published a final rule amending its hours-of-service (HOS) regulations for drivers of property-carrying commercial motor vehicles (CMVs). The final rule adopted several changes to the HOS regulations, including a new provision requiring drivers to take a rest break during the work day under certain circumstances. Drivers may drive a CMV only if 8 hours or less have passed since the end of the driver's last off-duty or sleeper-berth period of at least 30 minutes. FMCSA did not specify when drivers must take the 30-minute break, but the rule requires that they wait no longer than 8 hours after the last off-duty or sleeper-berth period of that length or longer to take the break. Drivers who already take shorter breaks during the work day could comply with the rule by taking one of the shorter breaks and extending it to 30 minutes. The new requirement took effect on July 1, 2013.

Court Decision: On August 2, 2013, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit issued its ruling on the Hours of Service litigation brought by the American Trucking Associations and Public Citizen. The Court upheld the 2011 Hours of Service regulations in all aspects except for the 30-minute break provision **as it applies to short haul drivers**. While the decision does not officially take effect until the mandate is issued 52 days after the decision (unless a party files a petition for rehearing, either by the panel or en banc, or moves to stay the mandate pending the filing of a petition for certiorari in the Supreme Court), FMCSA announces the Agency will immediately cease enforcement of the 30-minute rest break provision of the HOS rule against short-haul operations. The Agency requests that its State enforcement partners also cease enforcement of this provision. States that do so will not be found in violation of the Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program (MCSAP).

ENFORCEMENT POLICY: Effective **August 2, 2013**, FMCSA will no longer enforce 49 CFR 395.3(a)(3)(ii) against any driver that qualifies for either of the "short haul operations" exceptions outlined in 49 CFR 395.1(e)(1) or (2). The Agency requests that State and local enforcement agencies also refrain from enforcing the 30-minute rest break against these drivers. Specifically, the following drivers would not be subject to the 30-minute break requirement:

- All drivers (CDL and non-CDL) that operate within 100 air-miles of their normal work reporting location and satisfy the time limitations and recordkeeping requirements of 395.1(e)(1).
- Non-CDL drivers that operate within a 150 air-mile radius of the location where the driver reports for duty and satisfy the time limitations and recordkeeping requirements of 395.1(e)(2).

FMCSA will also be initiating a rulemaking to include text in the HOS regulations noting that the 30 minute break provisions do not apply to short haul drivers.

FRAUDULENT LETTERS TO MOTOR CARRIERS REQUESTING BANKING INFORMATION

FMCSA Security Bulletin # 071913.01 This bulletin is for use by FMCSA Industry, Government, and Law Enforcement Partners.

Another round of fraudulent USDOT Letters dated July 10, 2013, are being distributed, largely by fax, to motor carrier officials. The letters appear to be from the U.S. Department of Transportation Procurement Office and are signed by a fictitious name Julie Weynel – Senior Procurement Officer who is NOT an employee of USDOT.

The letters are an attempt to obtain banking information from the targeted carriers.

Motor Carrier officials and their employees - as well as government and law enforcement officials, should be vigilant and on the lookout for fraudulent attempts to gather financial (or other personal identifiable Information) data by fax, e-mail, or telephone. Requestors should be verified and authenticated before such data is provided!

APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED: GENERAL COMMODITY AUTHORITY

The following companies have submitted an application for an intrastate Motor Carrier Certificate. This Certificate, if granted by the Commission, will be issued for the transportation of all commodities, except Household Goods, to all points in the State of Michigan.

All applications for operating authority include application for temporary authority. Approval of a temporary authority is not automatic. An applicant must first pass a safety fitness review conducted by the MPSC.

A motor carrier filing a protest to an application shall submit a fee of \$50. Any protest submitted without the required fee will be returned.

A protest, to an application other than a temporary application, shall be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) calendar days of the publication of the application. A protest to temporary authority shall be filed within ten (10) calendar days of the publication of the application.

A submitted protest shall include a certificate of service verifying the date the protest was mailed by first class mail or served in person upon the applicant or the applicant's representative. Failure to file a protest in a timely manner waives participation in the proceeding.

Protests of these applications are limited to safety and insurance reasons only.
