Sample Itinerary:

Day 1 - Really one of the most charming tours in America's South. Get ready for another memorable vacation with Shoreline Tours. Overnight in Wytheville, Virginia.

Day 2 - Breakfast included. Step back to a simpler time when you visit Mount Airy. Actor Andy Griffith grew up here, and it's no coincidence that a stroll down Mount Airy's Main Street reminds people of the town of Mayberry from The Andy Griffith Show, the endearing and enduringly popular 60's hit TV series. You can visit Floyd's City Barber Shop, Opie's Candy Store, Wally's Service Station, Mayberry Soda Fountain, Mayberry Courthouse, the Old City Jail, and Andy's childhood home. Around dinner time arrive in beautiful Savannah, Georgia. We'll stay (3) nights at the charming Hampton Inn-Historic District. The Hampton is one of Savannah's most popular hotels and the location is ideal, close to River Street, City Market and dozens of galleries, boutiques, pubs and restaurants. Built in classic Southern style, this property offers the charm you desire while in Savannah. The lobby features heart pine floors, graceful antiques and a fireplace lobby bar. Guest rooms are very tastefully appointed. Dinner included tonight at River House Seafood, one of Savannah's top riverfront restaurants.

Day 3 - Breakfast included. The only way to sightsee in Savannah is aboard the Savannah Trolley Tour. This allows us to explore Savannah's 21 lush "Green Squares", an interesting variety of architecture with 1600 restored structures all rated historically and architecturally significant, all within a 25 square mile area. Next, visit the beautiful Andrew Low Home and Gardens and learn about the driving force behind the Girl Scouts of America and the founder Juliette Low. Enjoy the afternoon browsing on restored River Street. Here you'll find an eclectic mix of specialty shops, boutiques, taverns, pubs and unique eateries. Savannah is the city with the "nations largest registered historic landmark district" and the evening is yours to relax in our elegant hotel or explore the historic district.

Day 4 - Breakfast included. A day trip takes us to two lovely islands....St. Simons and Jekyll Island. St. Simons captivates visitors with remarkable beauty and fascinating history. Historic remnants of bygone eras and the sites of antebellum mansions dot the island. Take an island trolley tour where vast marshlands and expansive oaks draped with Spanish moss create a peaceful and charming atmosphere. You'll also have some leisure time to enjoy the upscale "Village District" with unique galleries, boutiques and eateries. This afternoon, visit Jekyll Island. From English colonization in 1735 to private ownership by French landowners; from the gilded age playground for the rich at the turn of the 20th century to the islands conversion in 1947 to a state park. Jekyll Island's history is as diverse as it is significant. A trolley tour offers an interesting look at this stunning island.

Day 5 - Breakfast included. Enroute to Charleston visit The Byrd Cookie Company. Their 2400 square foot retail store and showplace has been a tradition in Savannah, and in the gourmet food industry since 1924. Traveling through "Low Country" arrive in charming Beaufort, the "Queen of the Carolina Sea Islands". Nestled in the curve of a beautiful bay along the Intra-Coastal Waterway, the sophisticated charm of Beaufort offers a unique Low Country experience. Perhaps you'll opt to explore Beaufort's charms in a horse-drawn buggy or stroll around downtown's Main St. at your leisure. Stay (2) nights at the charming Hampton Inn in Mt. Pleasant, SC, a picturesque community only a (3) miles from downtown Charleston. Dinner included tonight in Charleston.

Day 6 - Breakfast included. As one of America's most beautiful and historic destinations, Charleston's tours, sightseeing and attractions chronicle the stories of people and places dating back more than 300 years ago. Historic preservation is a point of pride. Tour by cobblestone streets scented with Confederate jasmine, past the historic harbor with its salty, fresh breeze, by quiet, shaded courtyards and walled gardens. A sightseeing tour highlights our morning. Visit the Charleston Market District where an eclectic array of merchandise and interesting eateries may be found. This afternoon experience southern plantation living as we explore one of America's oldest working plantations, Boone Hall Plantation. A guided tour allows us to experience what plantation life was like in the 1800's. View the remarkably preserved original slave cabins, unusual in their brick construction. The evening is at your leisure.

Day 7 - Breakfast included. Columbia, SC is home of Riverbanks Zoo and Gardens. The Zoo is home to more than 2,000 animals that represent more than 350 species from around the world. A visit plays host to an array of wild adventures-from a diving expedition on a Pacific coral reef, to a safari through the plains of Africa, to an interactive Outback encounter with a flock of sociable lorikeet. Mid-afternoon continue to the Knoxville area for our last overnight.

Day 8 - Breakfast included and then head for home.
