1. Is registration restricted to Troy residents?	1. No, Troy Historic Village programs are available to everyone.
2. Are there discounts for Troy Historical Society members?	2. There are no discounts for Summer in Time Camp s.
3. Can I register my child on line?	3. We're sorry, but at this time we can only accept registration in person, by mail or by phone with a credit card. Village public hours are Tues, Wed. and Thurs. from 10 AM-3PM.
4. How many camps can my child participate in?	4. Children may register for any number or all of the camps.
5. Can a sibling under 7 years of age participate?	5. All participants must be 7 years old by the day the camp begins.
6. Must I pay the entire fee at the time of registration?	6. Yes, all camp registration fees must be paid at the time of registration.
7. Can I add Extended Care to the registration fee later?	7. Extended care must be paid in full two weeks prior to the beginning of a camp to allow us to schedule appropriate staff members.
8. How late can I register for a camp?	8. Registrations will be accepted until a camp is full or one week before the camp begins. Please register as soon as possible to ensure that a camp is not cancelled due to lack of registrants.
9. When will you cancel a camp?	9. A camp will be cancelled one week prior to the camp if registrations are insufficient. Full refunds will be provided if we have to cancel a camp.
10. If I withdraw my child from a camp will I receive a refund?	10. Refunds, less a \$25 cancellation fee for each registration cancelled, will be issued by check up to 14 days before the camp start date.
	Half of the registration fee will be returned if a child is withdrawn within 13 days of the beginning of a camp. There are no refunds for campers who withdraw after the camp begins. There is a \$10 fee to transfer to another camp.
11. What time can I drop off and pick up my child?	11. The drop off and pick-up period is 15 minutes before a session begins and 15 minutes after a session ends. Parents who drop off children earlier or pick up children later will be charged \$20 extended care fees for each occurrence. These fees must be

	paid before the child participates in the next camp day.
12. Where are the camp activities held? What happens if it rains?	12. Camp activities are scheduled in our 10 historic buildings and outdoors in the Village. We will also schedule activities in a 20' x40' tent in the Village during the summer. All activities will be moved indoors in the event of rain or storms.
13. Are there special fees for camps that include field trips?	13. The cost of field trips, including transportation by bus, is included in the camp fee. Parents/guardians will complete a separate permission slip for these trips on the first day of the appropriate camps.
14. Who provides lunches and snacks?	14. Campers must bring their lunch from home. They will be refrigerated at the Village until lunchtime. Camp fees include morning and afternoon healthy snacks and sugarfree drinks. Cold water will be available to campers everyday.
