

COMMUNITY WORKSHOP



Golden Valley Road and Plymouth Avenue Station Locations

The Metropolitan Council will host a community workshop on Thursday, February 26 to receive public input on the benefits and impacts of two potential LRT station locations.

Two station locations intended to serve Golden Valley/North Minneapolis residents were evaluated in the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (Draft EIS) – Golden Valley Road and Plymouth Avenue. Project designers and engineers want to hear from the public about their preferences and concerns with the proposed stations.

Specifically:

- What are the potential benefits to your neighborhood? city? region?
- What are the potential impacts to your neighborhood? city? region?
- What should the project team know more about?

Participants will have the opportunity to review and comment on station concepts. Public input will help inform a recommendation of which station(s) should move forward for further design.
