



Ohio Rail Grade Crossing Elimination Program *May 2026 Award Announcement*

COUNTY	PROJECT DESCRIPTION	FUNDING
Delaware	The city of Delaware is proposing to replace the existing at-grade railroad crossing at Berlin Station Road with a grade separation.	\$1.25 million
Franklin	The city of Columbus is proposing to replace the existing at-grade railroad crossing at Hilliard-Rome Road with a new grade separation.	\$3.86 million
Lucas	The city of Toledo is proposing to replace an existing at-grade railroad crossing in the Point Place neighborhood with a new grade separation nearby.	\$5.5 million
Scioto	The project proposes to close the existing at-grade railroad crossing in Haverhill, Ohio at Haverhill-Ohio Furnace Road and construct a new grade separation nearby.	\$7.74 million + \$4 million in contingency funds
Seneca	The city of Fostoria proposes to close at minimum of three at-grade railroad crossings and build a new grade separation at S Town Street.	\$10.6 million + \$3.2 million in contingency funds
Union	The county is proposing to replace the existing at-grade railroad crossing at Bear Swamp Road with a grade separation.	\$2.94 million
