## OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - November 2013

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

### November unemployment rates down in almost all Oklahoma counties

In November, the unemployment rates for 76 of the state's 77 counties dropped over the month. **Latimer County** posted the state's highest rate of 9.3 percent. **McCurtain County** claimed the second highest rate, while **Hughes and Sequoyah counties** tied for the month's third highest county rate. **Roger Mills County** provided Oklahoma's lowest county unemployment rate of 2.6 percent. The only county that didn't report a rate improvement was **Ellis County**, which remained unchanged in November.

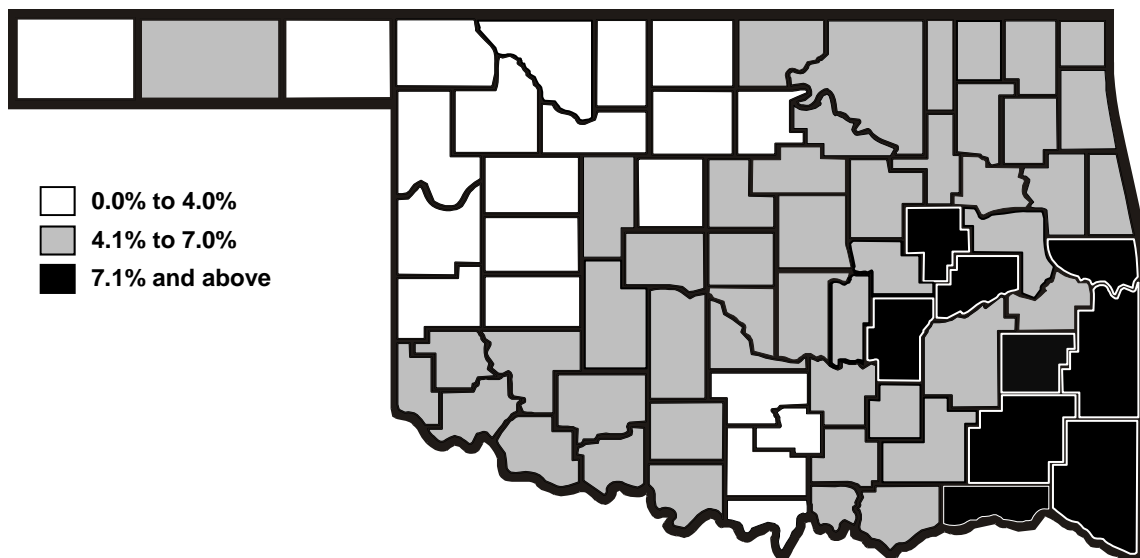
