Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

County unemployment rates up in January

McCurtain County kicked off the year by posting the state's highest county unemployment rate of 12.6 percent. **McIntosh County** and **Choctaw County** provided the second and third highest rates for the month. January's lowest county unemployment rate of 2.3 percent came from **Alfalfa County**. Rates increased over the month in 76 of Oklahoma's 77 counties. **Cimarron County** reported no change in January.


