TRAFFIC ADVISORY

I-84 traffic detoured at Hood River overnight

Local access will be unaffected

HOOD RIVER — Overnight construction work will temporarily close the through lanes of Interstate 84 between exits 63 and 64 in Hood River for two nights next week, Tuesday, Nov. 1 and Wednesday, Nov. 2.

Only one direction will close each night and drivers will follow a detour during the closures. Drivers will encounter brief delays.

To safely conduct striping and median barrier work, contractors for the Oregon Department of Transportation plan to route westbound traffic through the exit 64 and exit 63 off-ramps and on-ramps. The detour will be in effect overnight from 7 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 1 to 6 a.m. Wednesday.

Similarly, contractors will route eastbound freeway traffic through the exit 63 and exit 64 offramps and on-ramps from 7 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 2 to 6 a.m. Thursday, Nov. 3. Both closures are dependent on weather.

During the freeway closures, all local routes to downtown Hood River, Oregon 35 and the Marina Way area near exit 64 will be open. However, motorists may find traffic controlled by flaggers at the ramp intersections.
