## For One Document with Multiple Transactions:

If one document (power of attorney, heirship affidavit, will, etc.) is used to support the applications of more than one transaction, counties should submit all related transactions in a "SPECIAL HANDLING" envelope with a note stating the transactions should be kept together. Additionally, the county should submit a certification concerning the number of transactions for which the original document was submitted (see *Title Manual*, Chapter 11, "Signature - Authority to Sign" for information on acknowledgements and certifications).
