Inspection Fee Recalculation in RTS

There can be occurrences where the inspection fee printed on the registration renewal notice does not match the fee for the most recent inspection completed. This can happen when the customer moves from one county to another, or if the vehicle is no longer required to complete an emissions inspection.


RTS release 8.4 will proactively notify you when the printed fee does not match the fee for the last inspection completed. The Recalculate Inspection Fee button will appear in the bottom right hand corner of the RTS REG029 screen to allow you the option of recalculating the inspection fee due. The Recalculate Inspection Fee button will appear only when registration is being renewed and will appear if inspection is verified electronically or manually.

Counties should recalculate the inspection fee for walk-in customers. Counties have the option of choosing to recalculate the inspection fee for mail-in registration renewals.


In March 2015, TxDMV created a RTS workaround to use to correct the inspection fee charged. The workaround is now obsolete with the implementation of the Recalculate Inspection Fee button. Instructions for using the Recalculate Inspection Fee button are below.

Recalculate Inspection Fee button Instructions


Step 1: Click the Recalculate Inspection Fee button



Step 2: Click Yes to confirm request to recalculate inspection fee




Step 3: New inspection fee displays on REG029. Continue with transaction



Inspection Fee Recalculation in IVTRS

IVTRS will automatically recalculate the inspection fee due when the fee printed on the registration renewal notice does not match the fee for the most recent inspection completed. In this situation, IVTRS will display the message "Vehicle Inspection fee recalculated due to updated inspection information". Below is a sample image with the message the customer will see.

Inspection Fee Recalculation in webSUB

webSUB will automatically recalculate the inspection fee due when the fee printed on the registration renewal notice does not match the fee for the most recent inspection completed. In this situation, webSUB will display the message "Vehicle inspection fee recalculated due to updated inspection information". Below is a sample image with the message the webSUB user will see.

Collection in RTS of Buyer Tag and Inspection Fee for Dealer Sales Out of State


RTS release 8.4 includes a new button in the Status Change Event to allow for collection of the Buyer Tag and Inspection Fees due when a Texas dealer sells a new or used vehicle to a customer who is not a Texas resident. This button should be used when the vehicle will not be titled and registered in Texas.

Recalculate Inspection Fee button Instructions

Step 1: Select Title/Registration, then Status Change



Step 2: Enter VIN of vehicle then click Enter



Step 3: If CTL001 screen displays, then click Yes



Step 4: If RTS00057 screen displays, click OK




Step 5: Select Dealer Sale - OOS then click Enter.



Note: Vehicle and owner information will not display if no Texas record exists for the vehicle.

Step 6: Select Dealer Sale - OOS then click Enter.



Note: Buyer Tag and Inspection Fee are checked by default and may be unchecked if needed.

Step 7: Buyers Tag and Inspection Fee collected will display on PMT004 screen. Continue with transaction
