The U.S. Census Bureau is researching modern and new methods for the population to exercise their civic obligation to be counted in the next census. The Census Bureau is committed to making the once-a-decade headcount quick, easy, and safe for all to participate through the internet, telephone, or traditional paper questionnaires. Through the smart use of technology and existing government data sources, the 2020 Census hopes to provide a substantial taxpayer savings while maintaining the highest quality and accuracy standards mandated by the U.S. Constitution.

The 2014 Census Test is one of the key activities that the Census Bureau is conducting in a portion of Montgomery County, MD, and a portion of Washington D.C. Your community has been selected to participate in this National test and your participation will help the Census Bureau acquire more accurate counts of the people and housing units in your community in 2020. In addition, temporary jobs will be provided in your community during the census test. There will be temporary full-time and temporary part-time jobs available in the test site areas.
