The Intermountain Center for Disaster Preparedness (ICDP) focuses on integrated and collaborative all-hazards, prevention, preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation for the whole community through education, training and research.

ICDP offers training and education for the “whole community” which encompasses individuals and families, including those with access and functional needs; businesses; faith-based and community organizations; nonprofit groups; schools and academia; the media; all levels of government including state, local, tribal, territorial, and federal partners; healthcare; and first responders.

The Intermountain Center for Disaster Preparedness is a training site for several of the National Domestic Preparedness Consortium Members, including the Center for Domestic Preparedness (CDP) in Anniston, AL and the Center for Radiological Nuclear Training (CTOS) at the Nevada National Security Site.

In addition to classes and course offerings, ICDP provides assistance with the design and execution of drills and exercises to develop and enhance the skills necessary to cope with a disaster or emergency, before, during and after.

The staff at ICDP can help evaluate an organization’s emergency plans to identify gaps and vulnerabilities.
