The Intermountain Center for Disaster Preparedness (ICDP) is a disaster training center founded in March 2012. The mission of the ICDP is to improve disaster readiness through collaboration and integration among the whole community.

The focus areas of the ICDP are:

- **Training and Education**: Increase knowledge, skills and abilities by (1) developing curriculum to promote the application of academic theories and concepts for those working in disasters and (2) providing disaster training for “first responders” (police, fire, EMS), healthcare providers, and the community as a whole. Training on disaster-related fundamentals encourages a well-rehearsed and coordinated response.
- **Exercises**: Provide assistance with the development and execution of dills and exercises to develop and enhance the skills needed to cope with all stages of a disaster.
- **Planning and Assessment**: Provide subject matter expertise to assist organizations to evaluate the effectiveness of organizational emergency management programs and plans; assess hazards, vulnerabilities, risks, and capabilities; and identify training and/or resource gaps.
- **Research**: Conduct research to expand the existing body of knowledge in disaster readiness and resilience.
