



### Eastern Pacific – Tropical Storm Rosa

- Tropical storm force winds extend 115 miles







- LOW (10%) chance of becoming tropical cyclone next 48 hours










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
### **Remnants of Sandy Precipitation Forecast**






### Precipitation Forecast Days 1-3








### Critical Fire Weather Areas Days 1 - 8




