Earthquake Activity: No significant activity

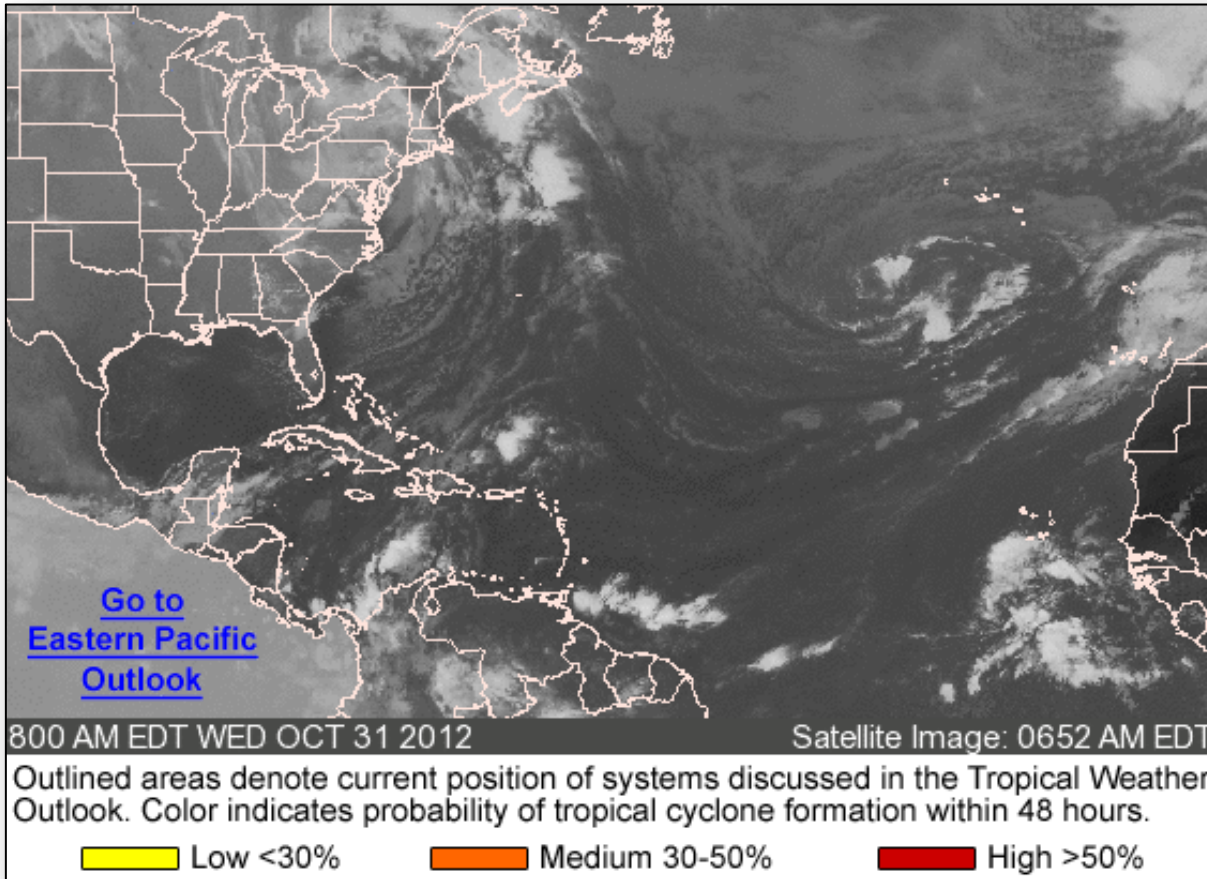

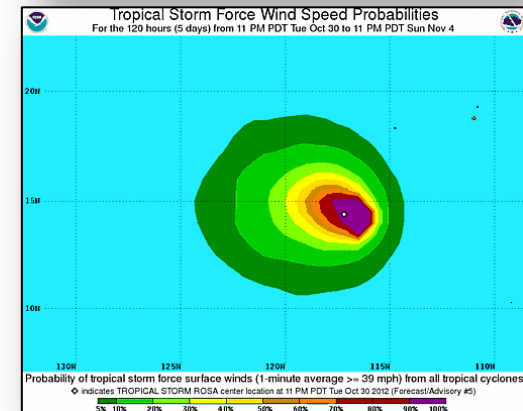
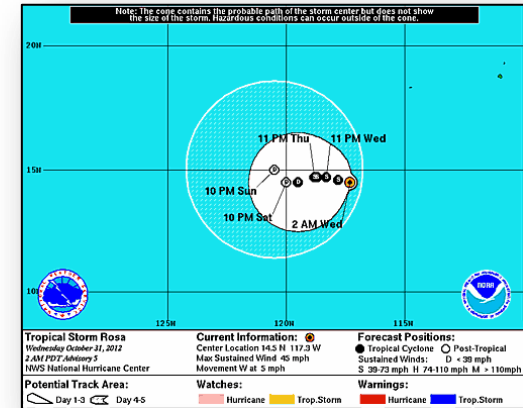


Eastern Pacific – Tropical Storm Rosa

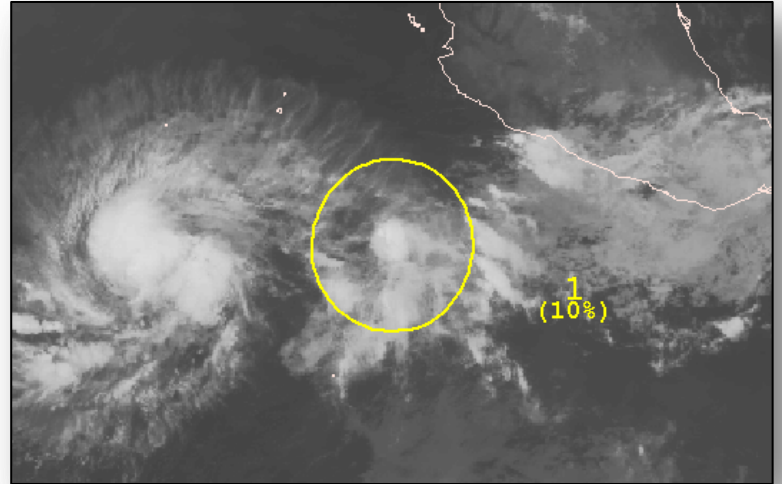

- Tropical storm force winds extend 115 miles



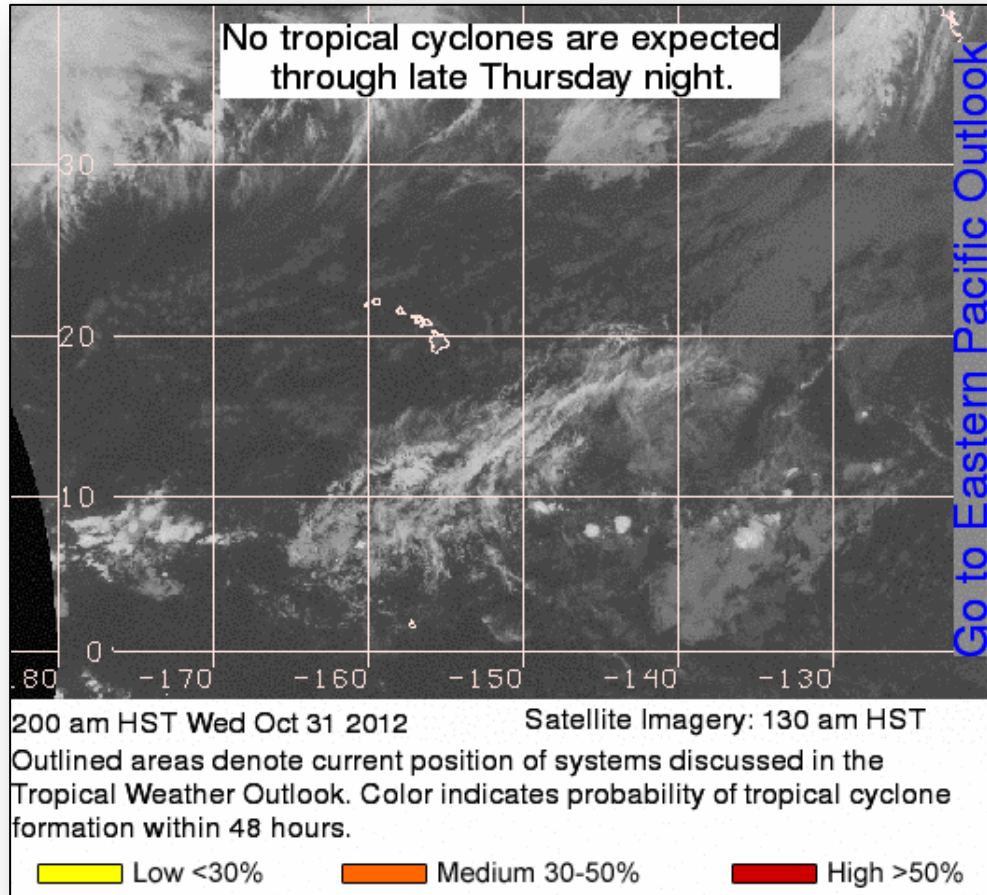

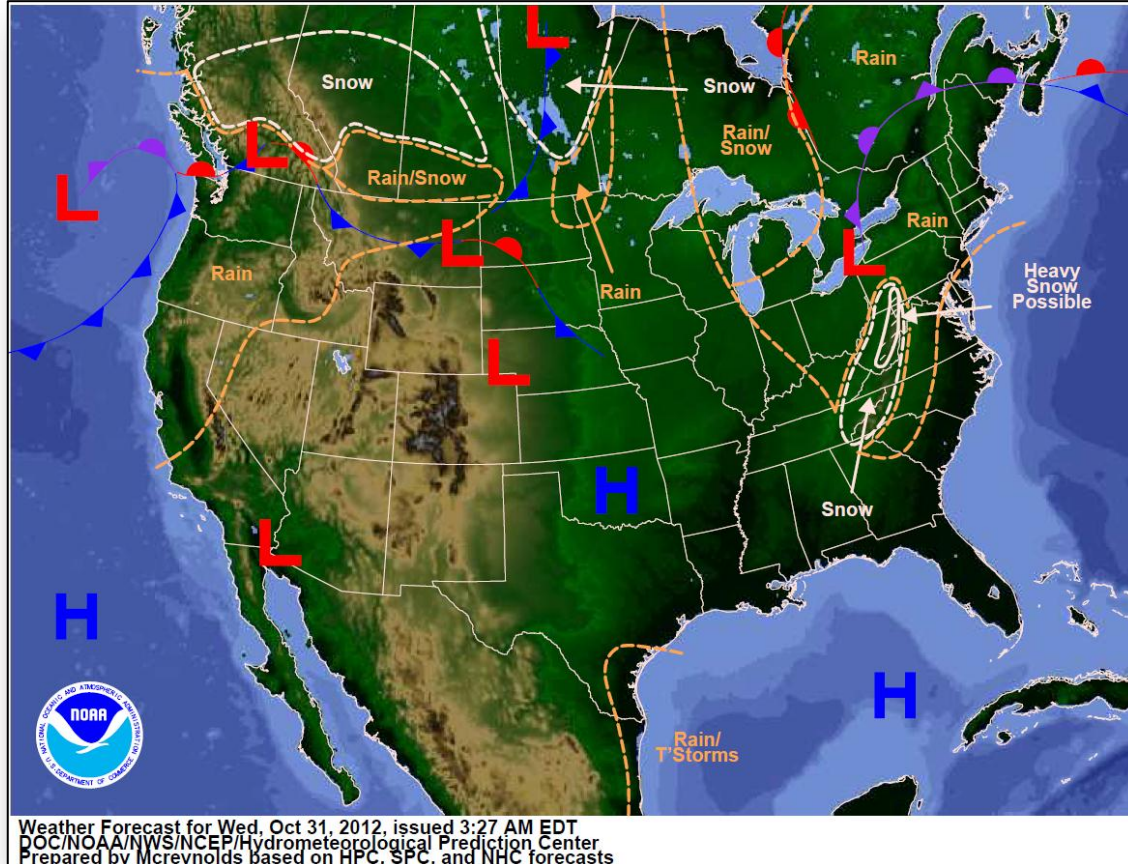
- 375 miles SW of Manzanillo, Mexico

Central Pacific – Tropical Outlook



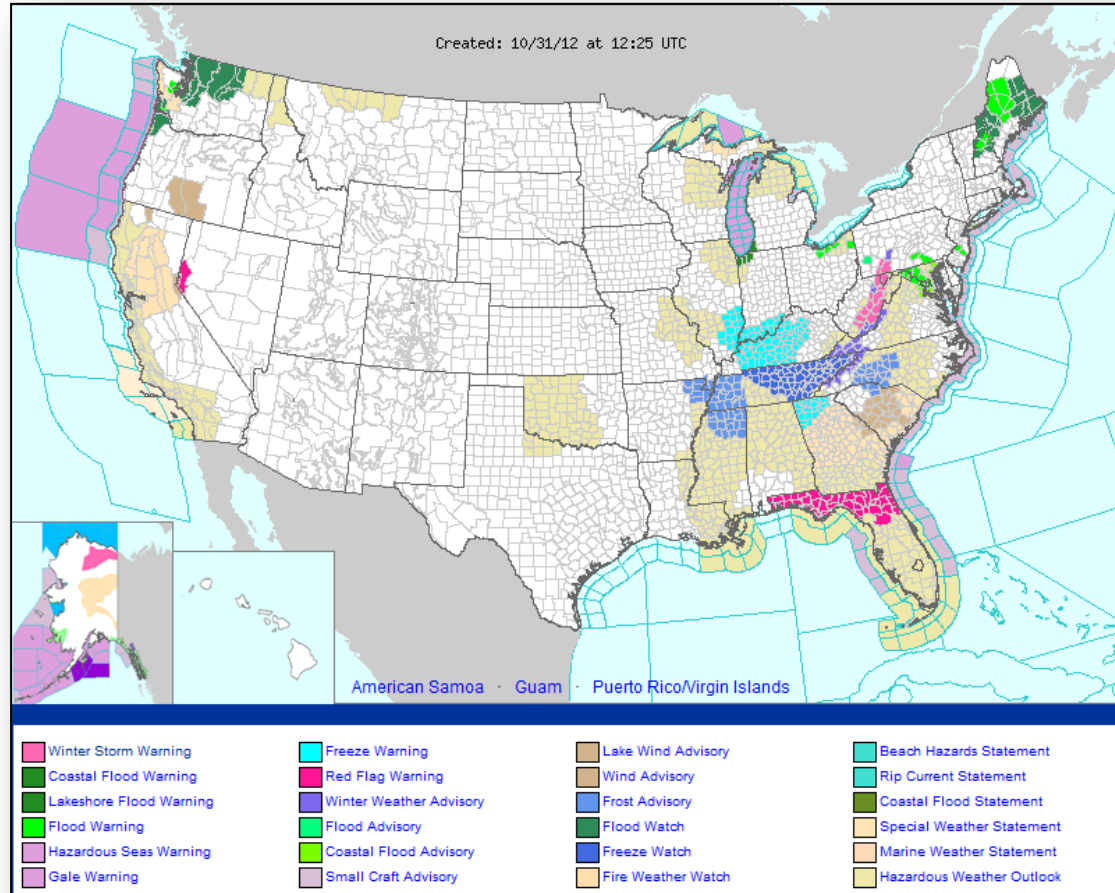

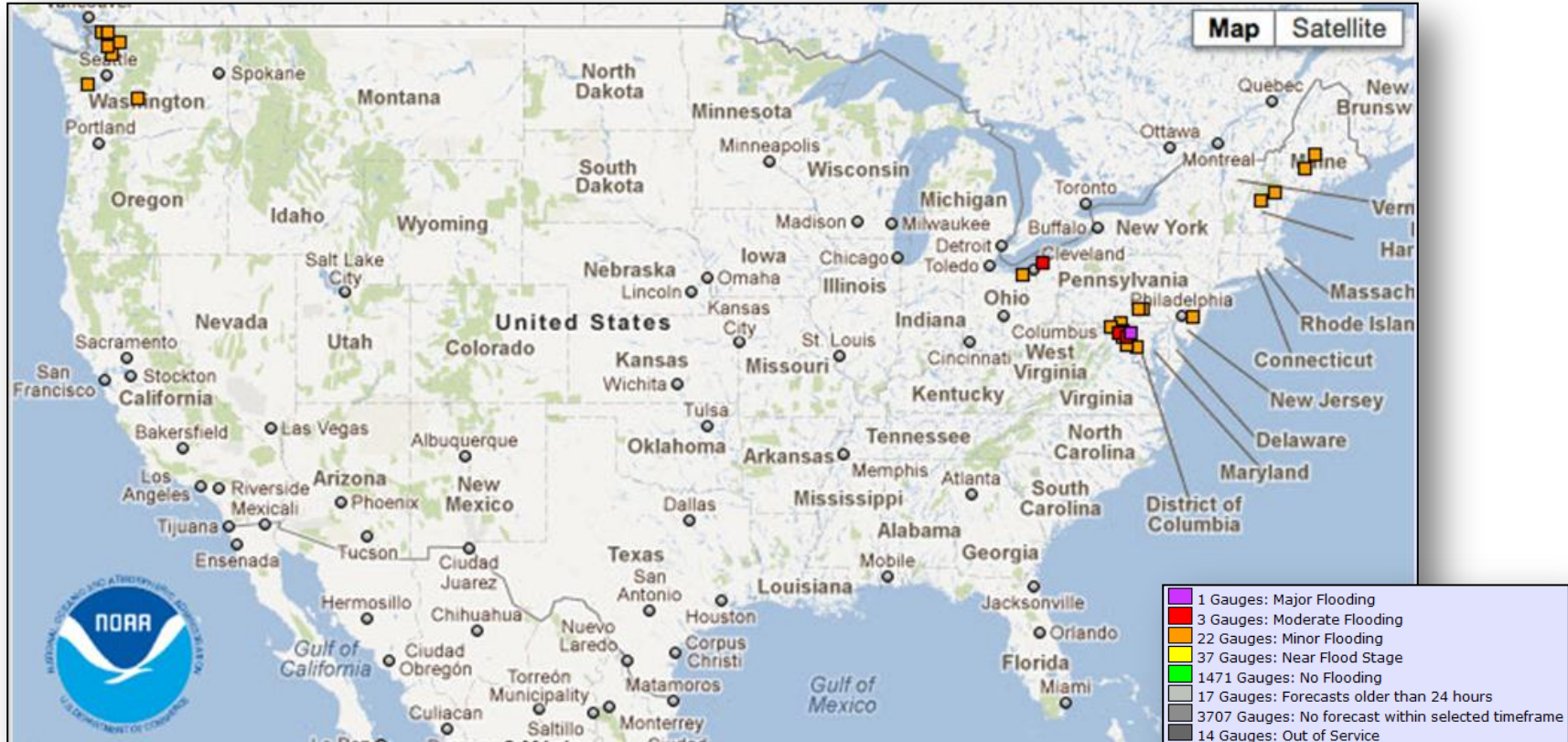
Remnants of Sandy Precipitation Forecast



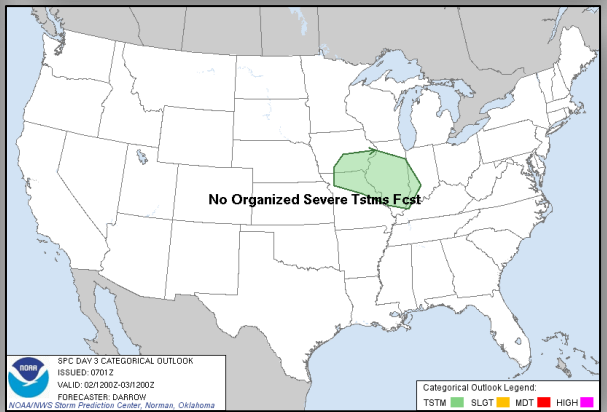
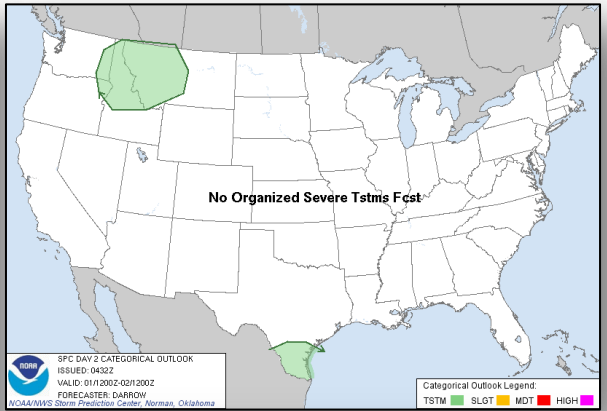
Precipitation Forecast Days 1 – 3



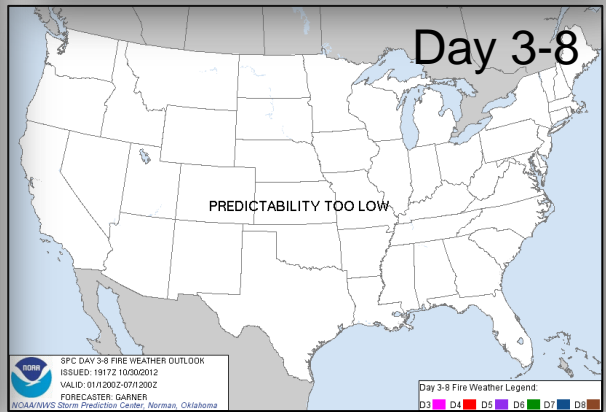
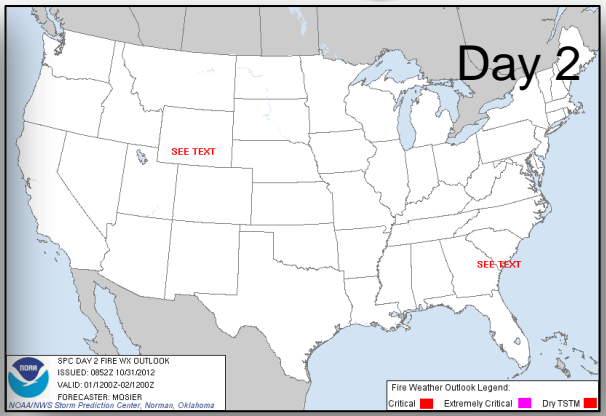
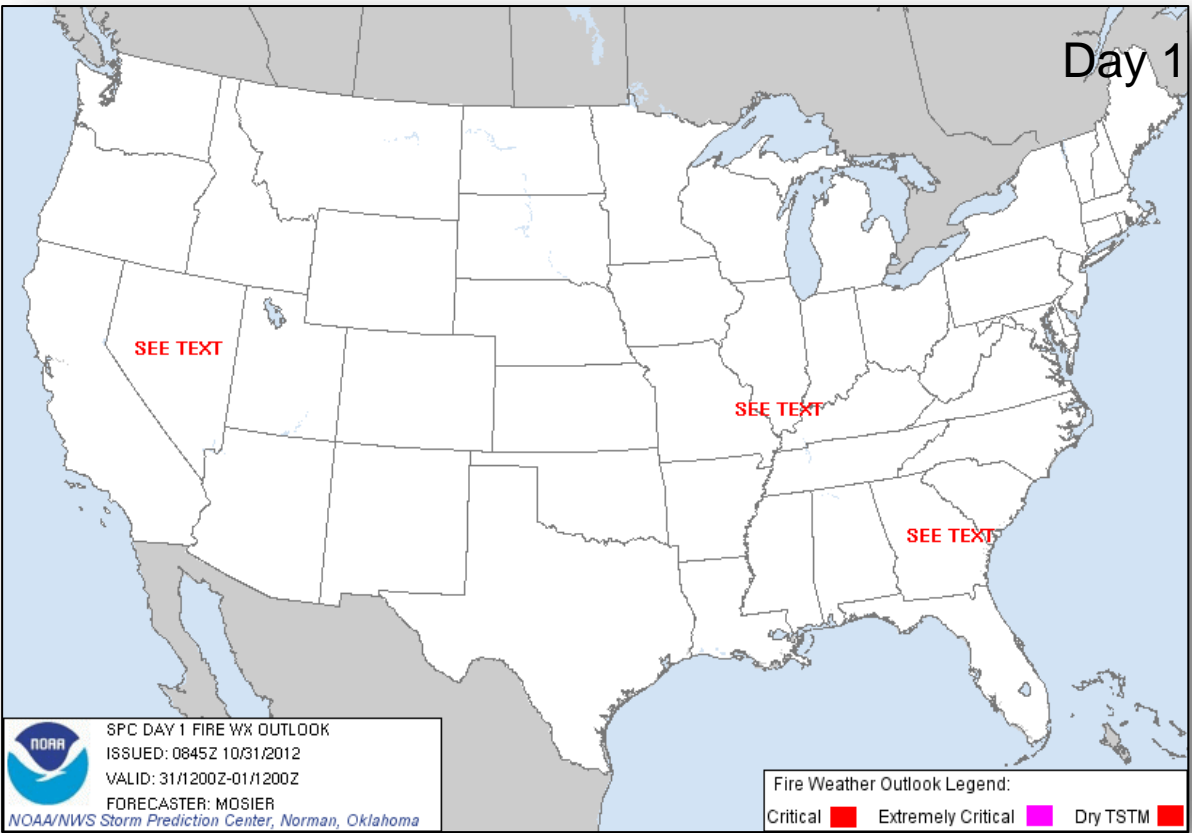
River Flood Outlook – 7 Day



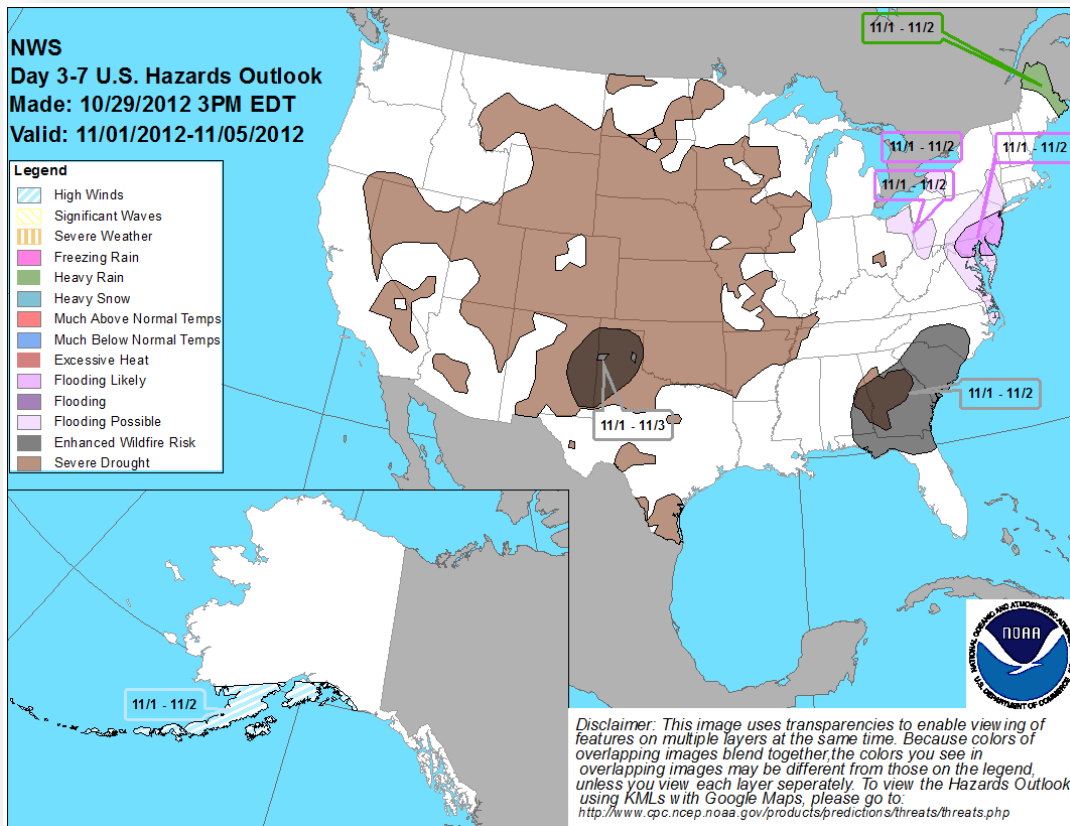
Convective Outlook Days 1 – 3

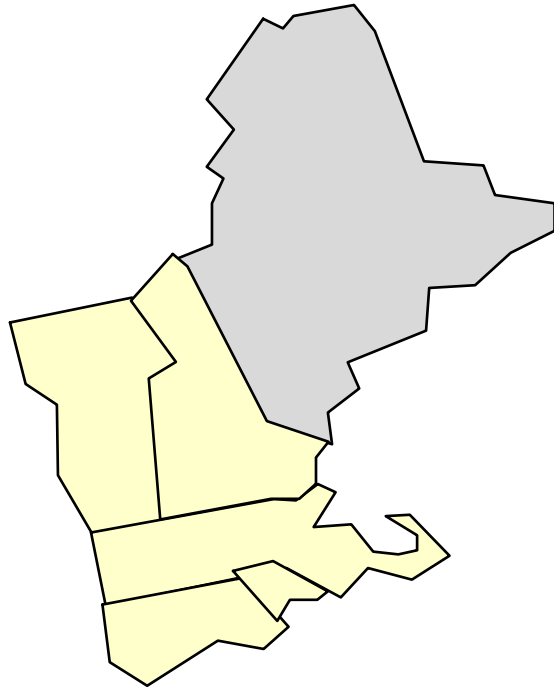

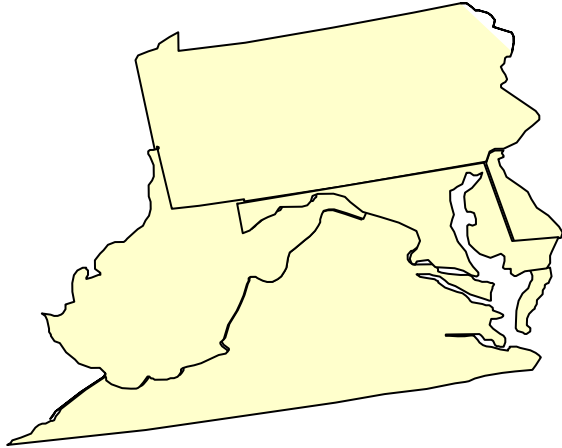

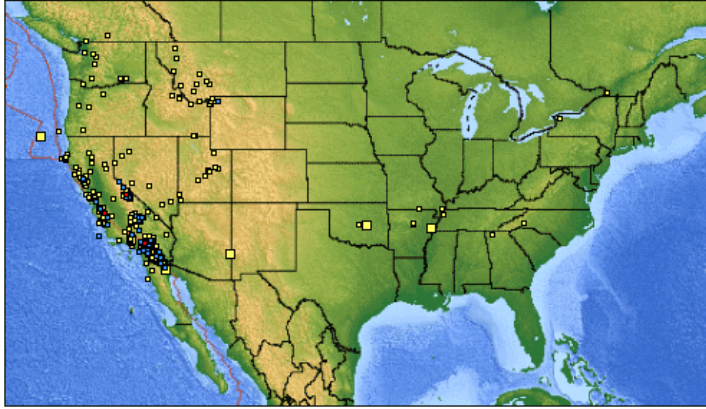

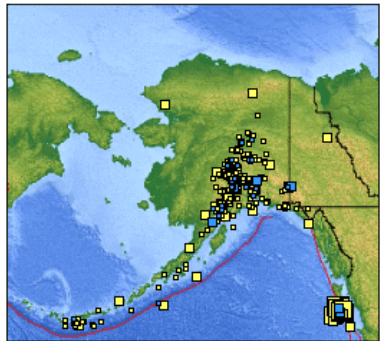

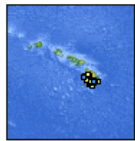

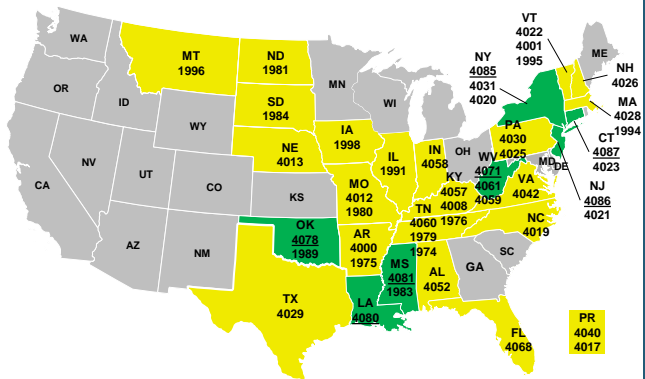

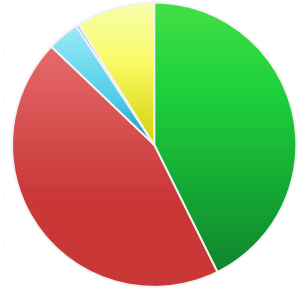

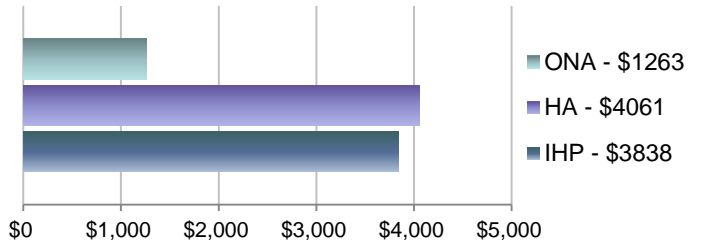
