



Eastern Pacific – Tropical Outlook







Eastern Pacific – Tropical Depression Rosa

 expected to degenerate into remnant low by today







- Medium (50%) chance of becoming tropical cyclone next 48 hours




Central Pacific – Tropical Outlook









Precipitation Forecast Days 1-3






River Flood Outlook – 7 Day






Convective Outlook Days 1-3







Hurricane Sandy-Power Outages





Hurricane Sandy-Shelter Status




