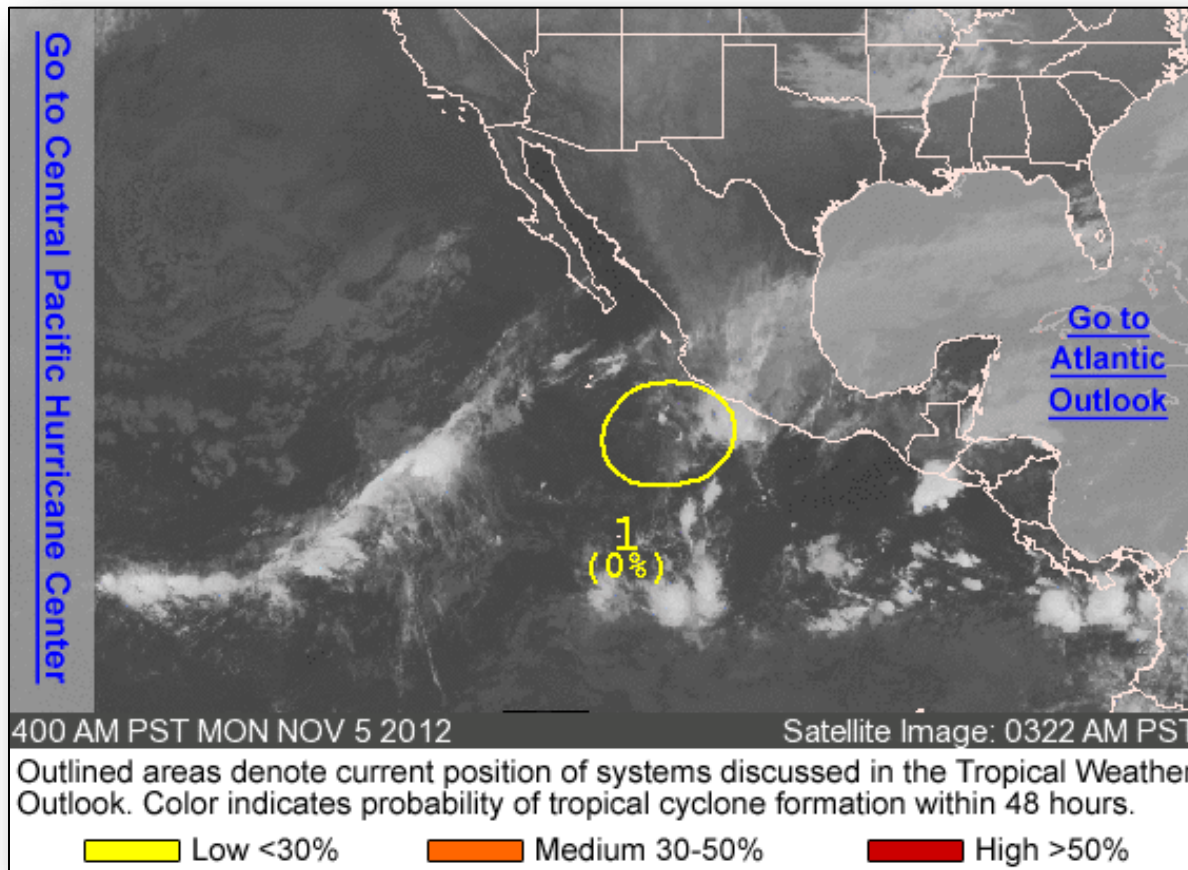

Central Pacific – Tropical Outlook



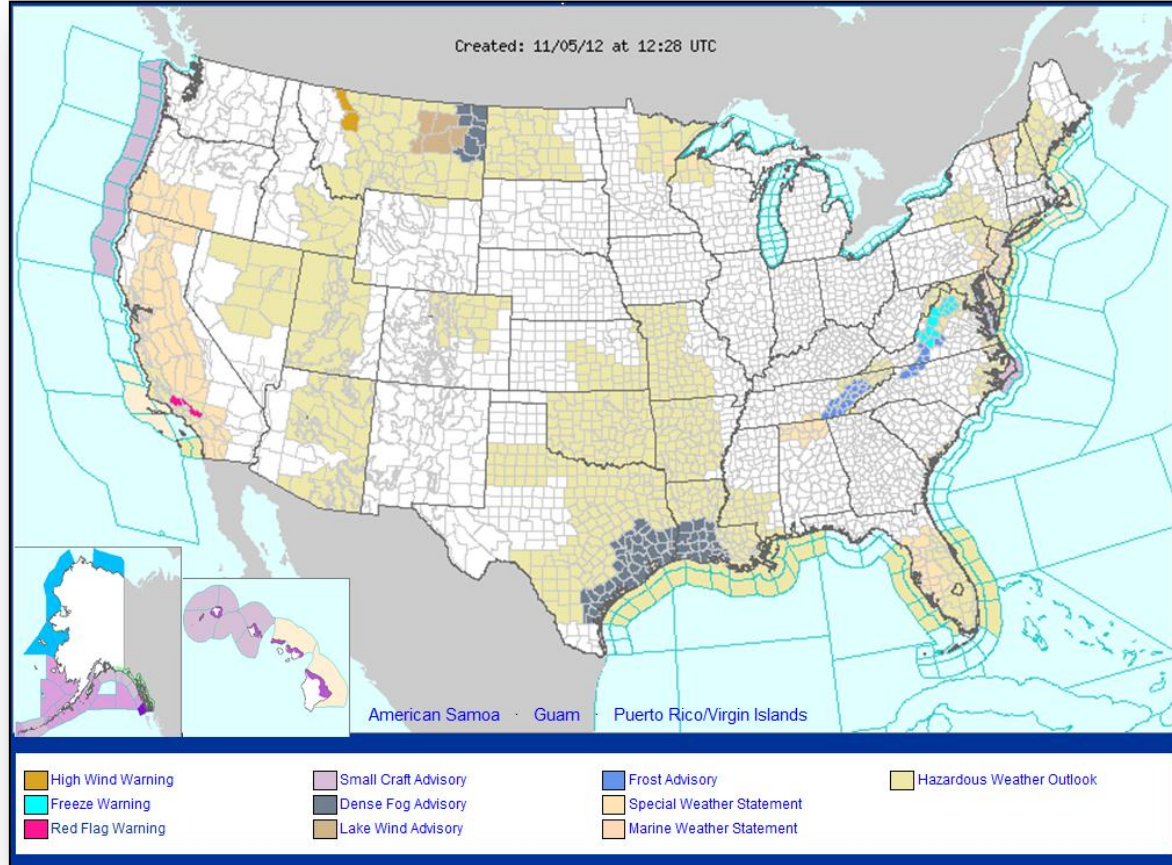

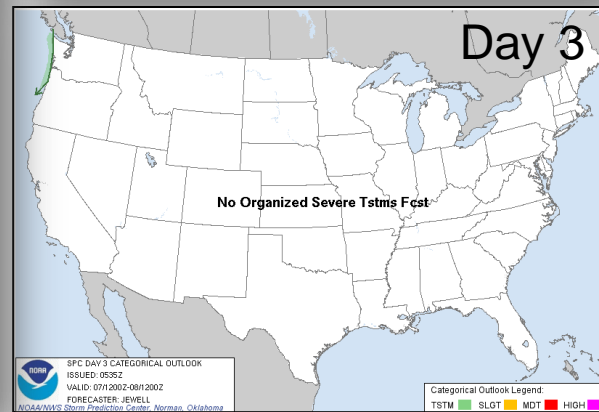
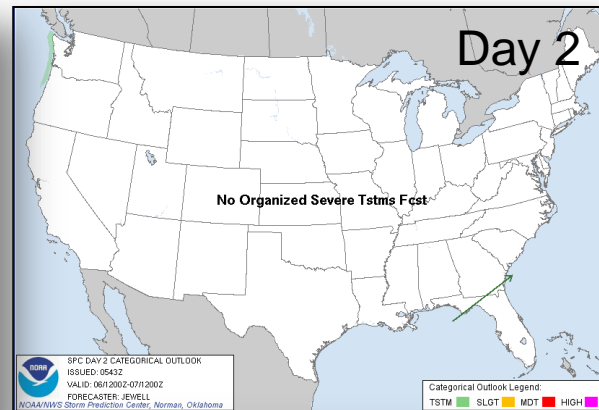
Precipitation Forecast Days 1 – 3



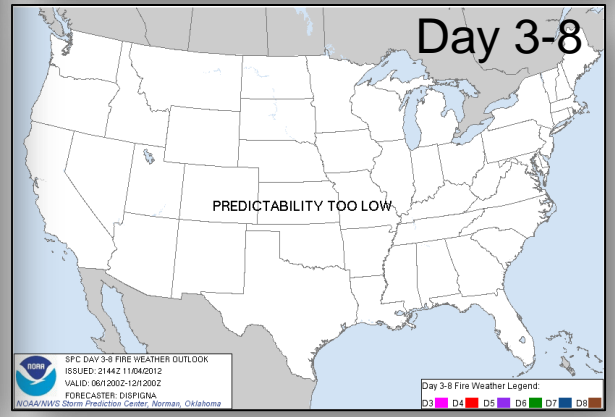
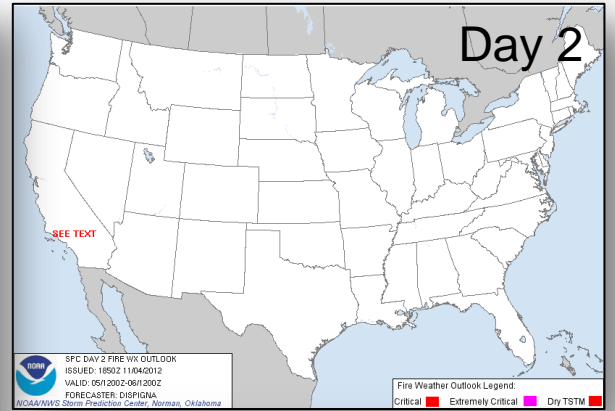
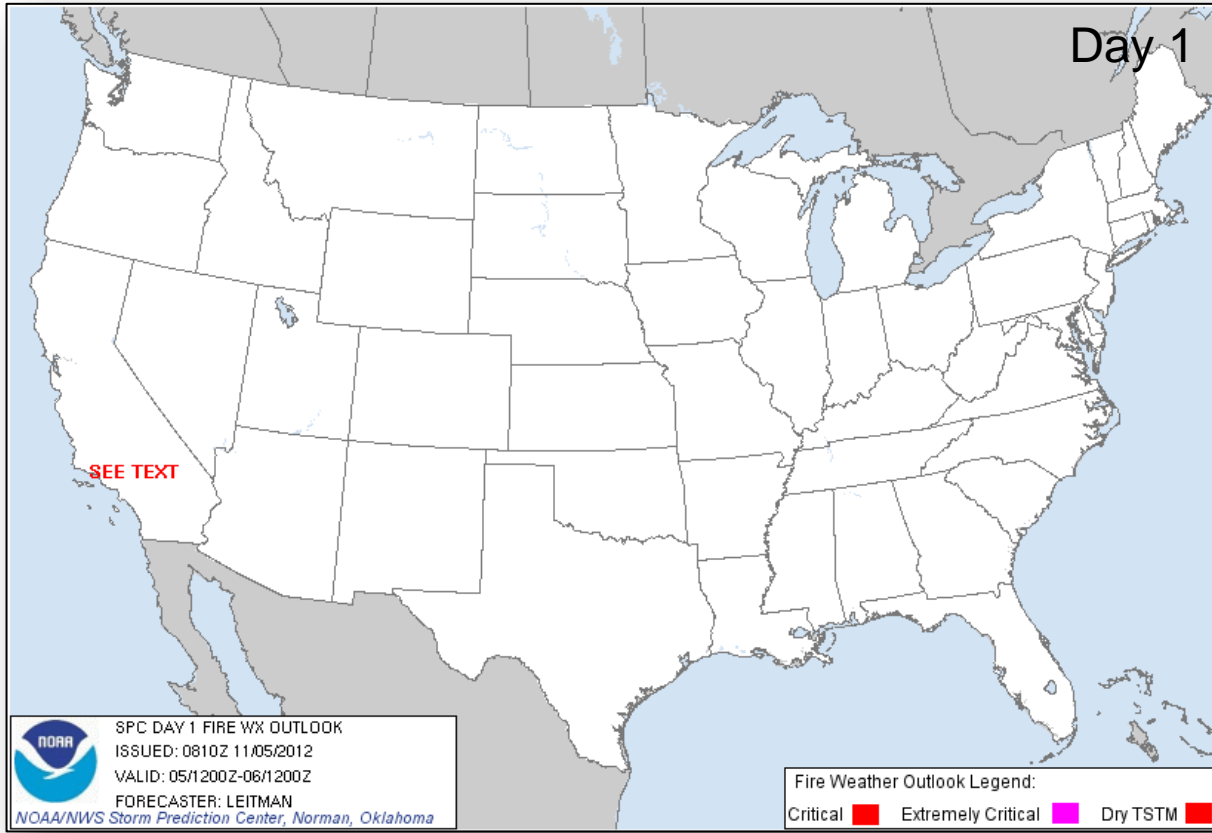
River Flood Outlook – 7 Day

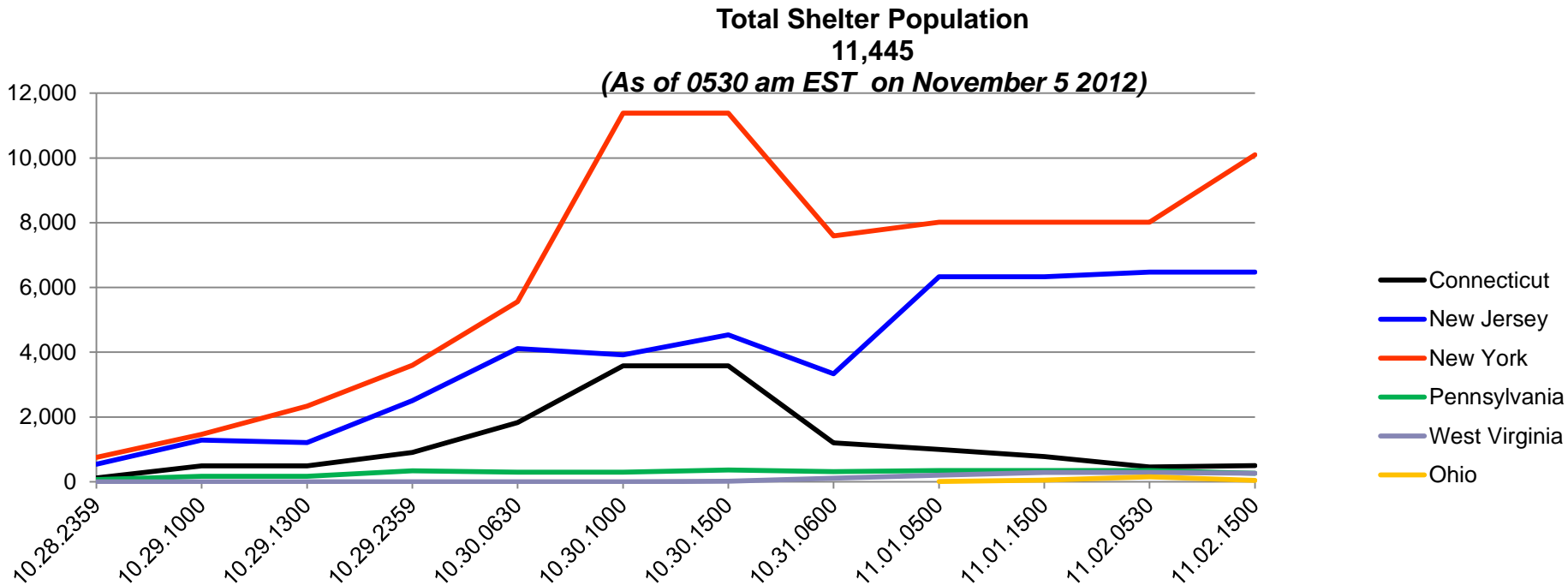


Hurricane Sandy-Power Outages

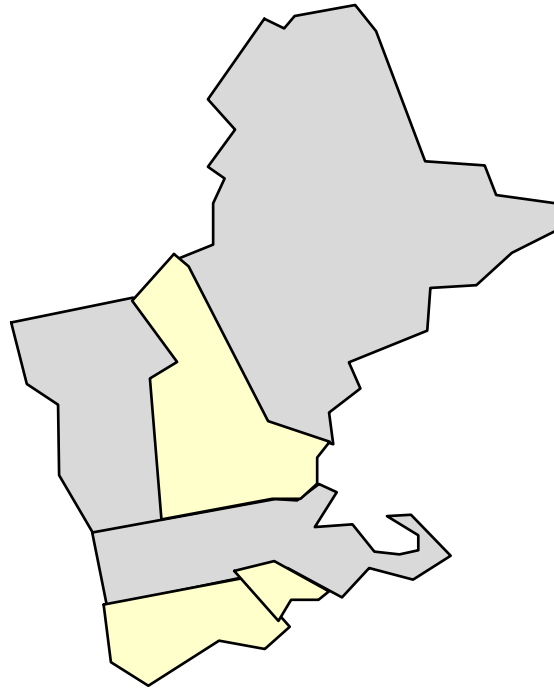

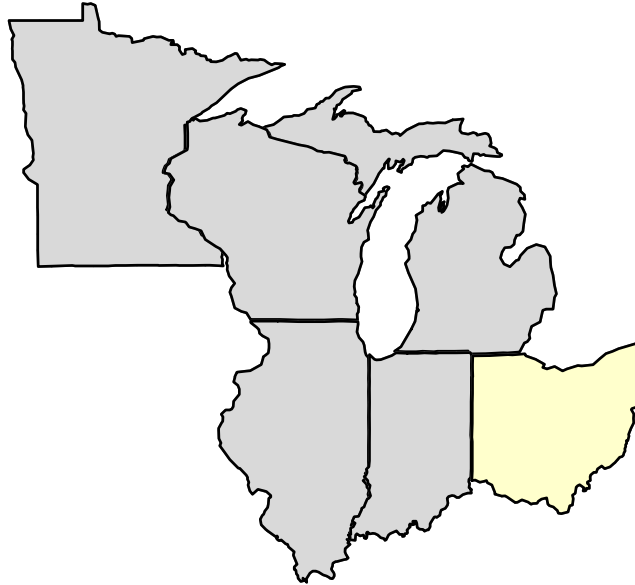

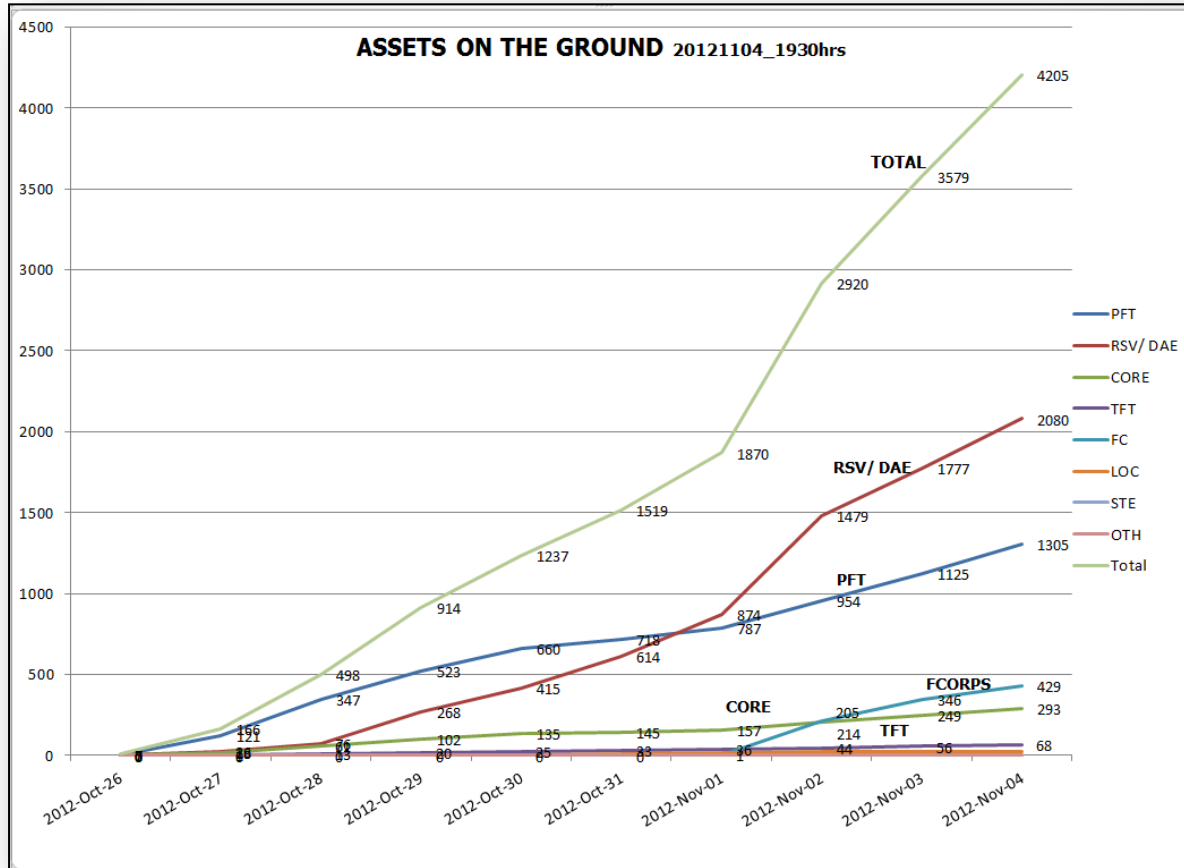

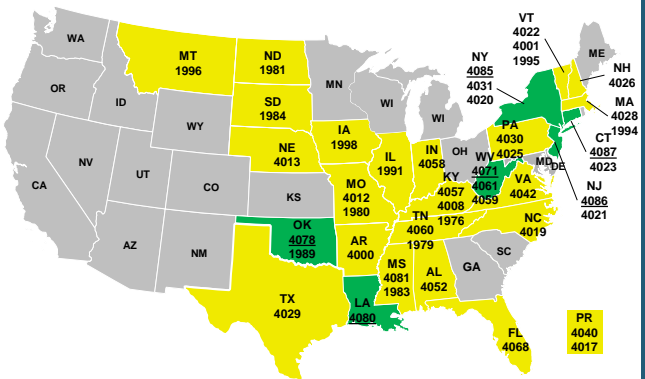

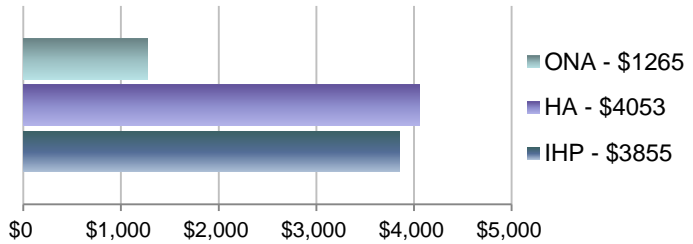
