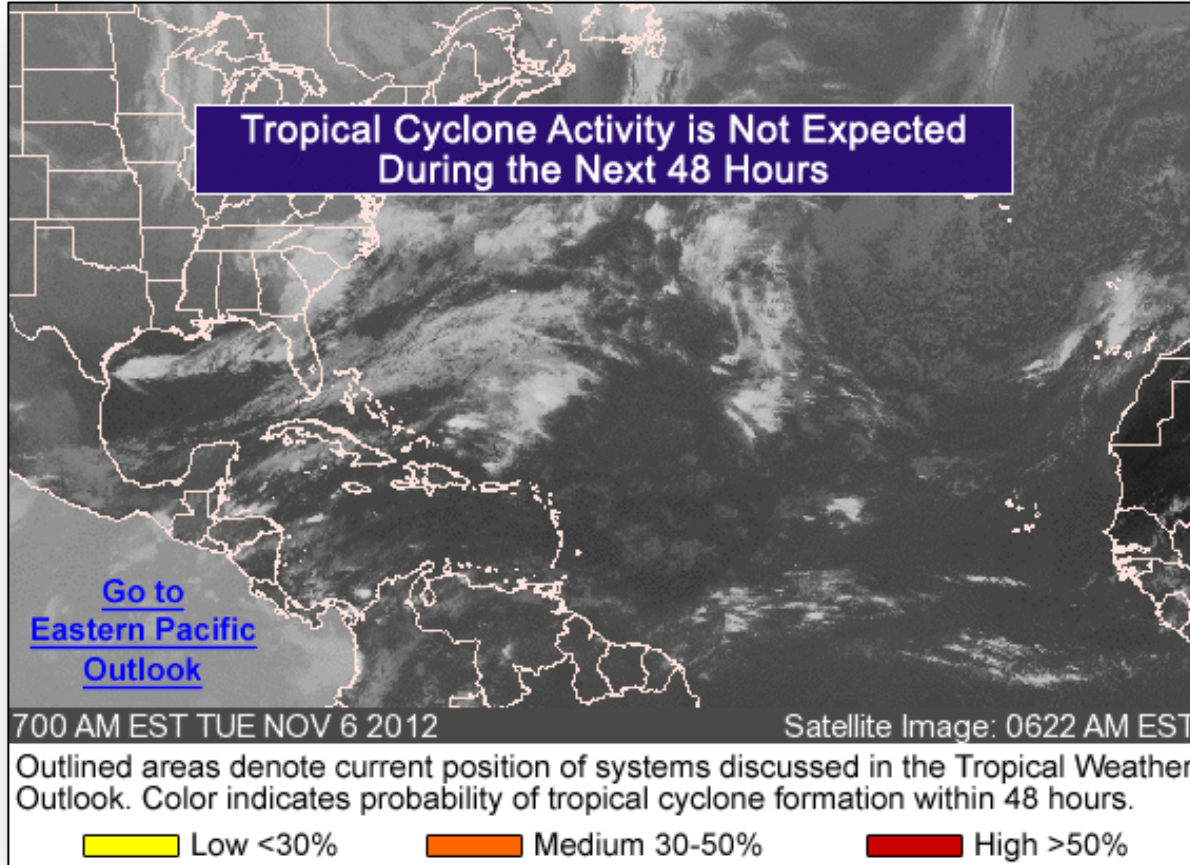

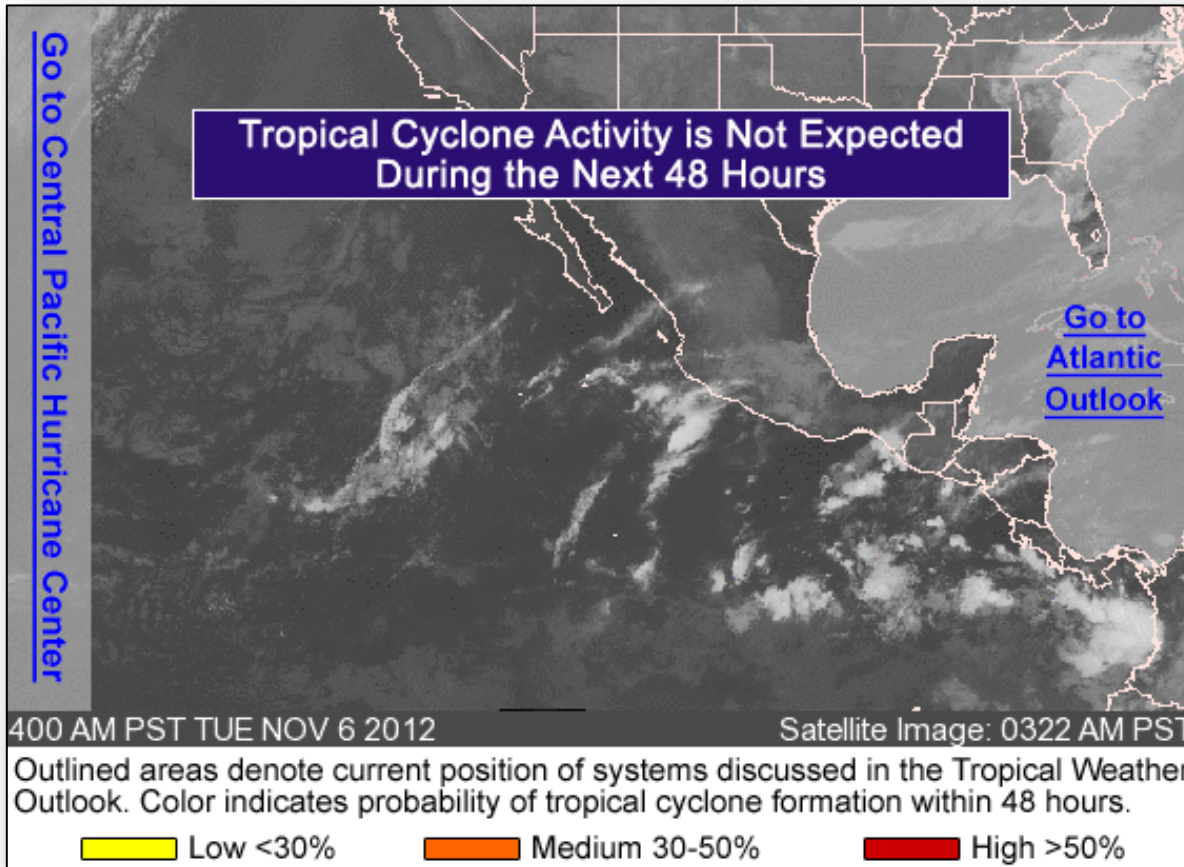
Atlantic – Tropical Outlook



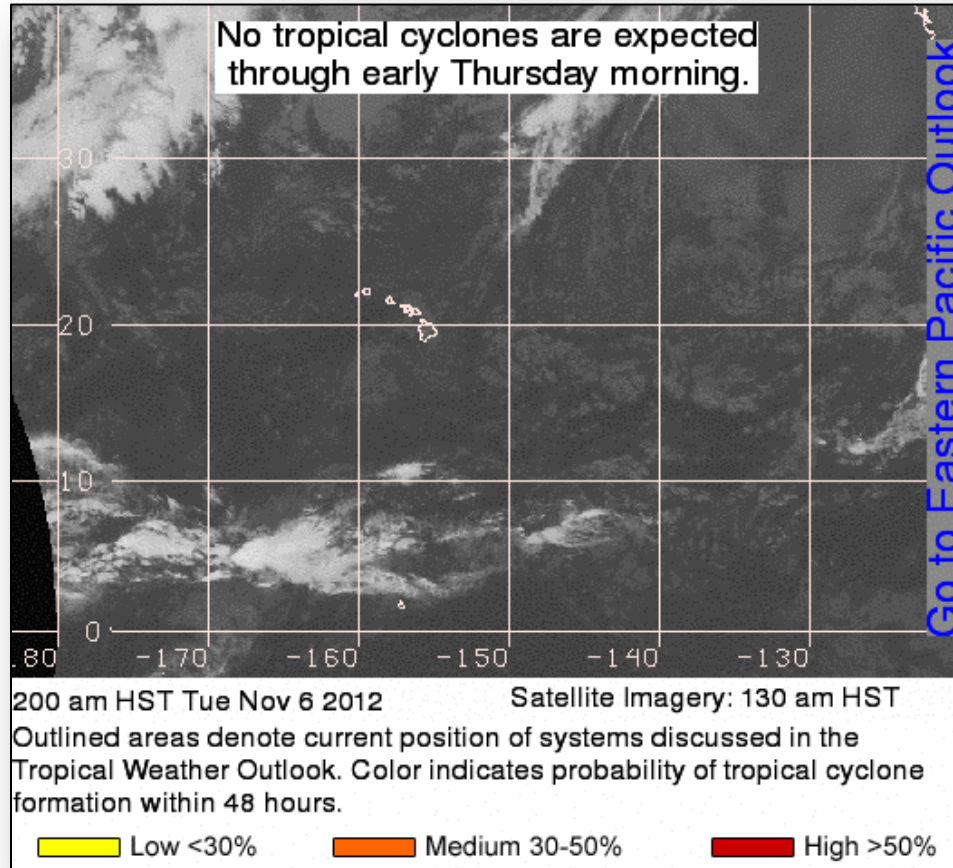
Eastern Pacific – Tropical Outlook



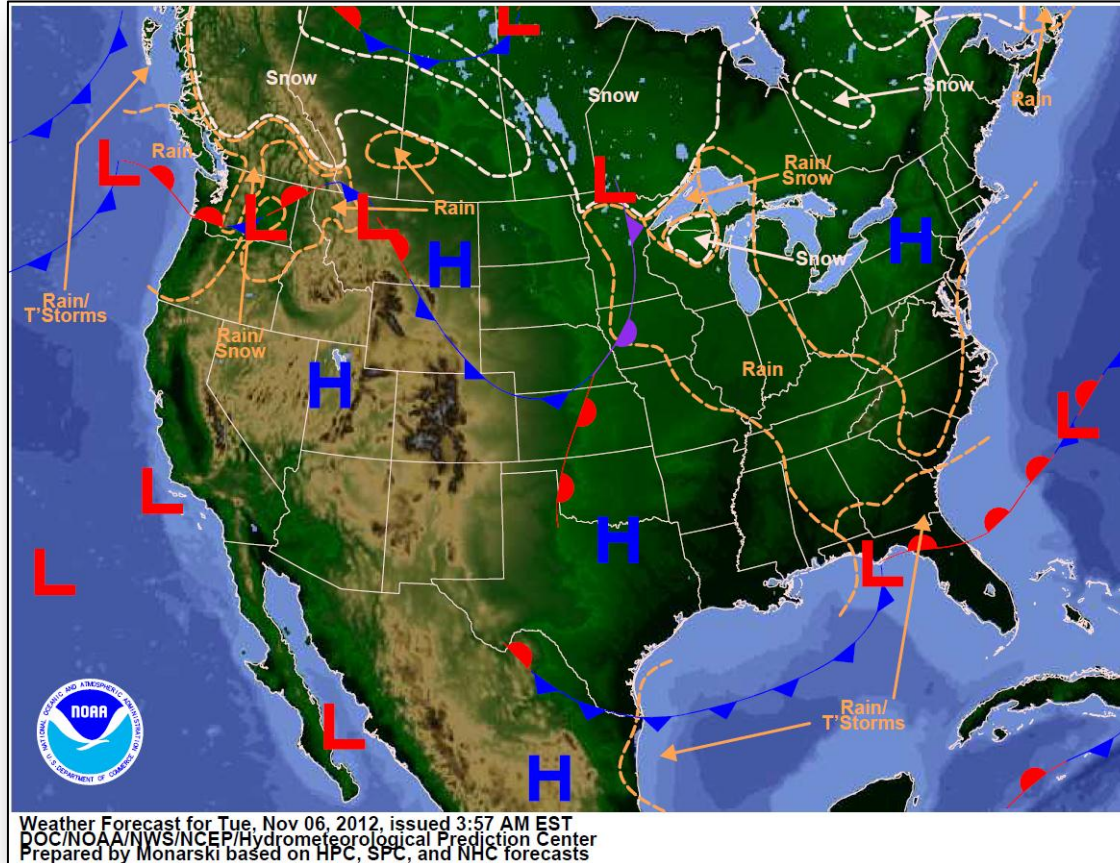

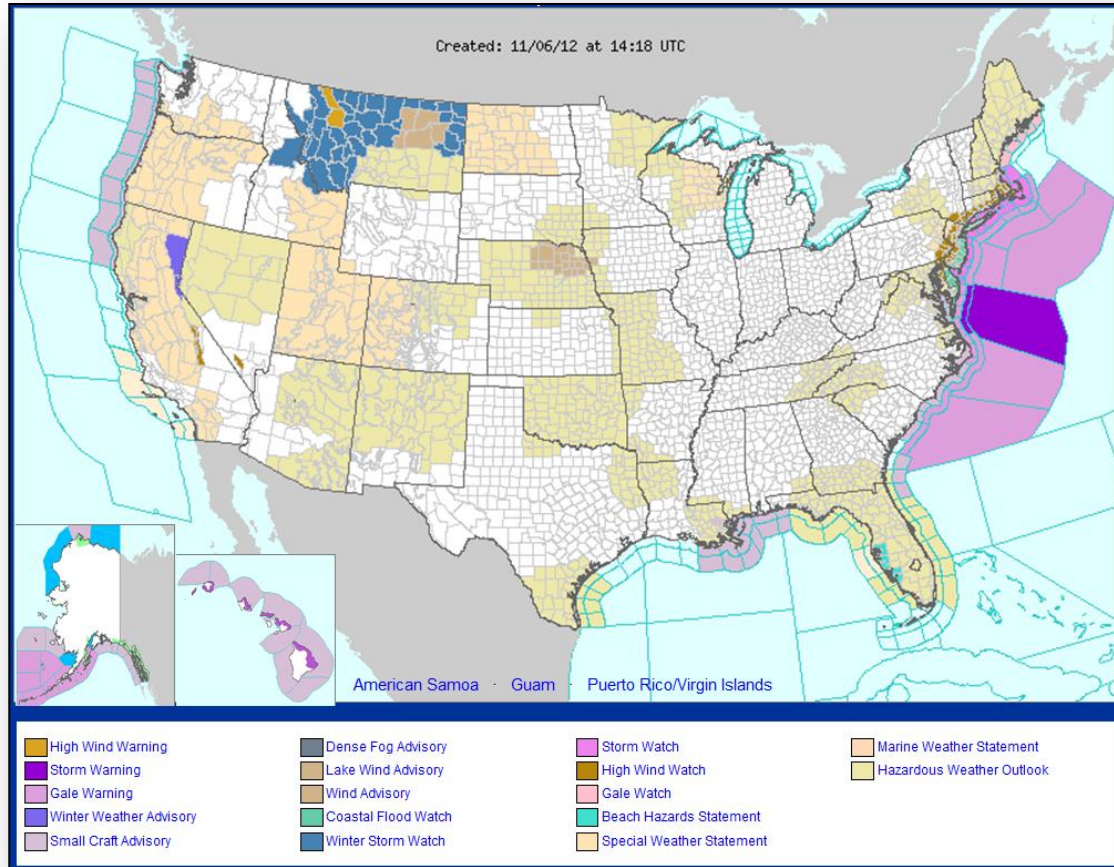

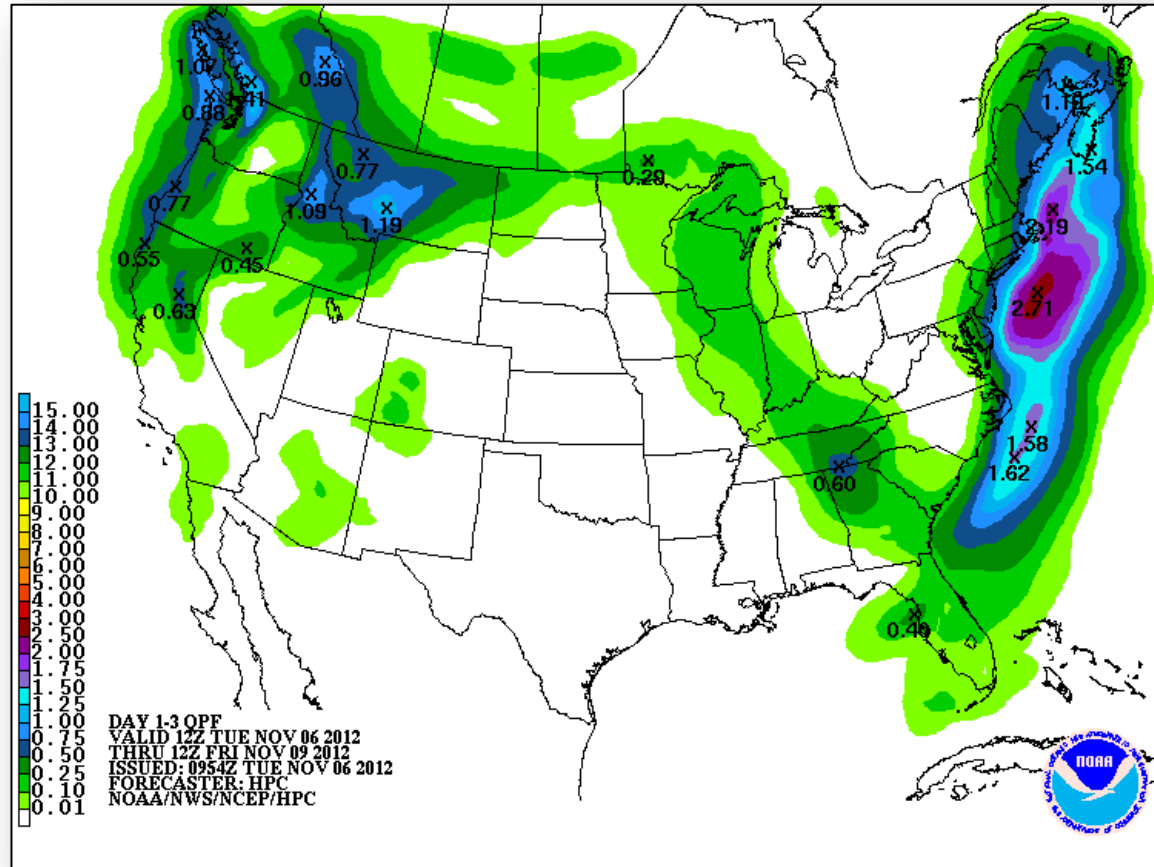
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Precipitation Forecast Days 1 – 3



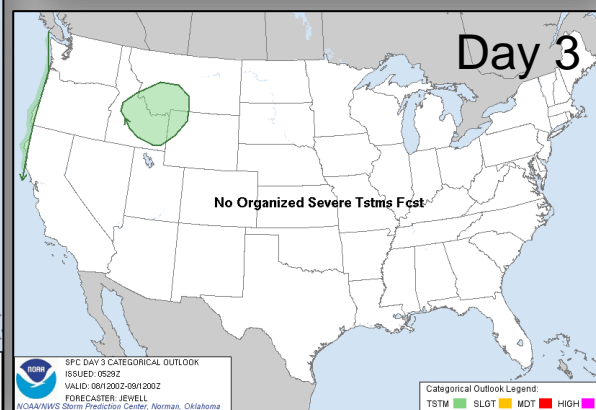
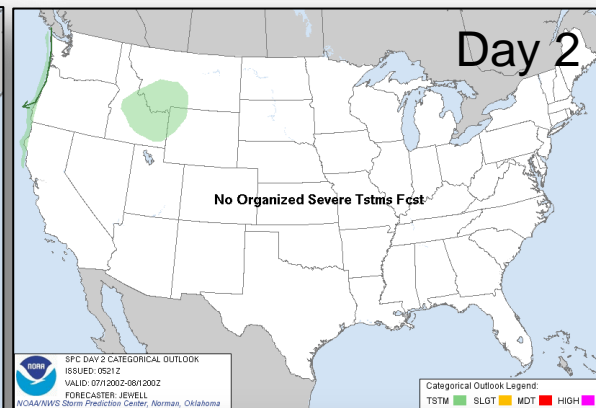
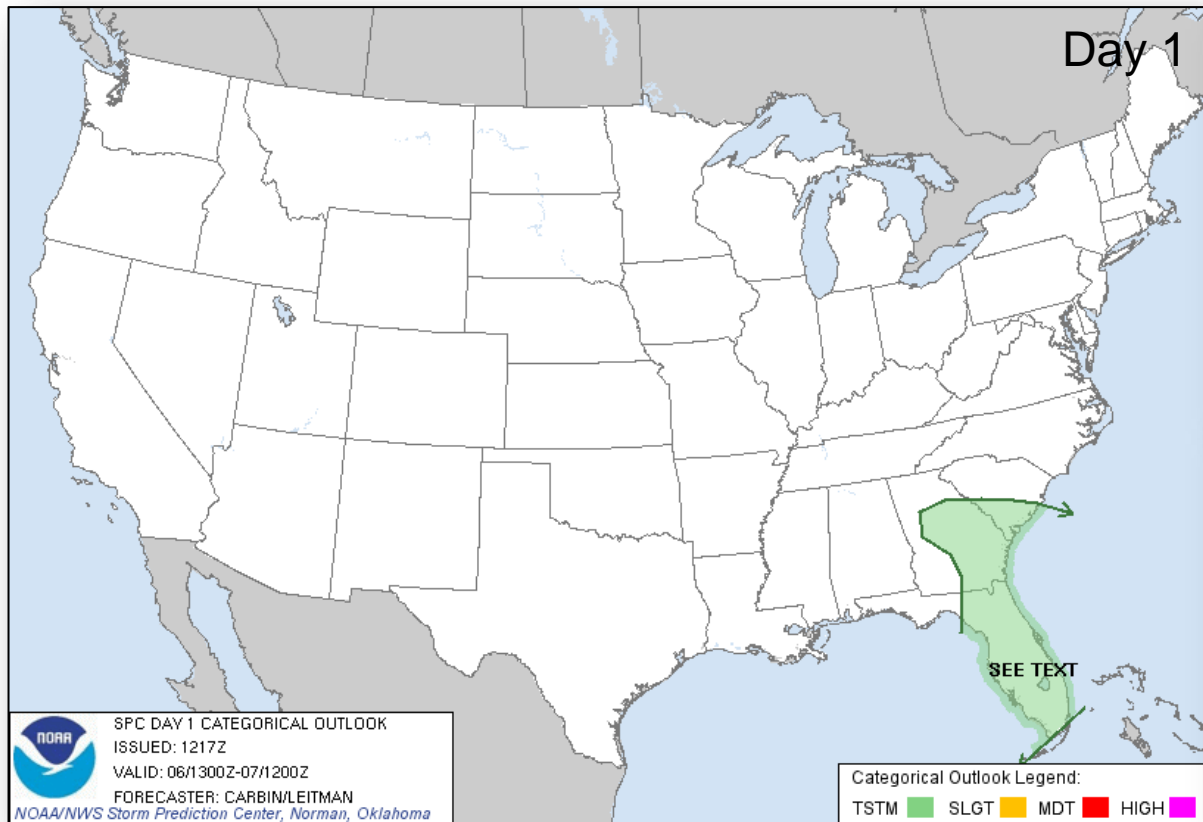

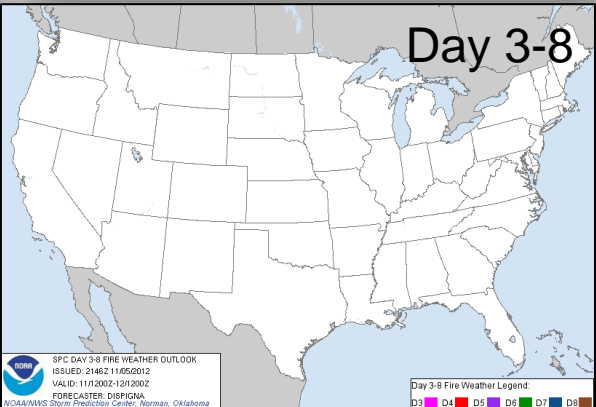
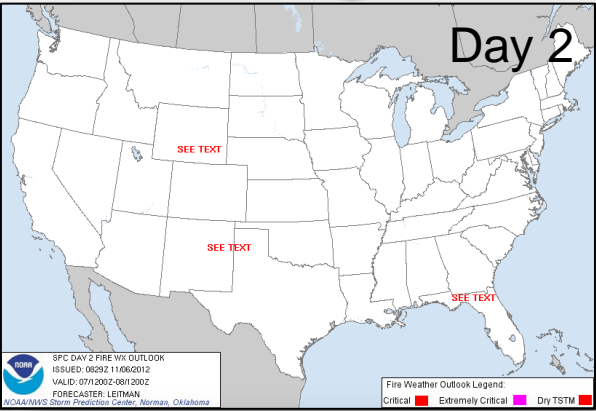
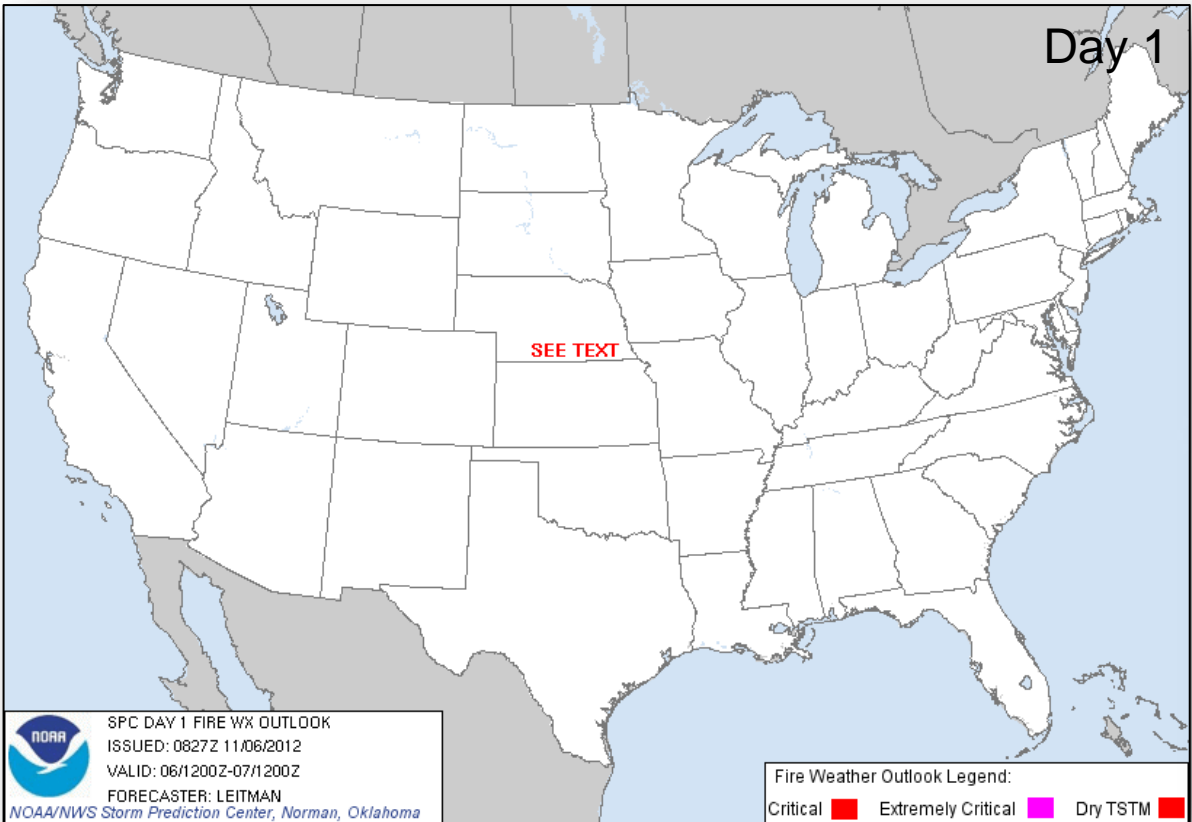
River Flood Outlook – 7 Day



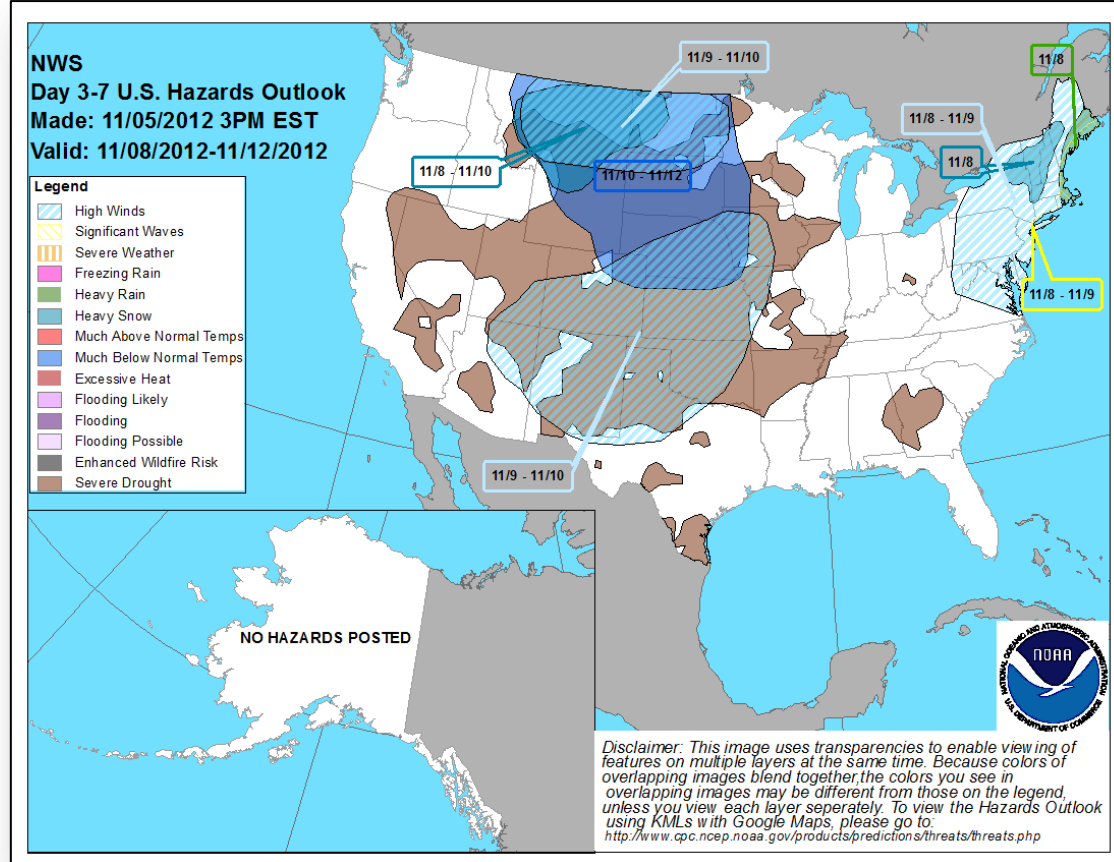
Convective Outlook Days 1 – 3

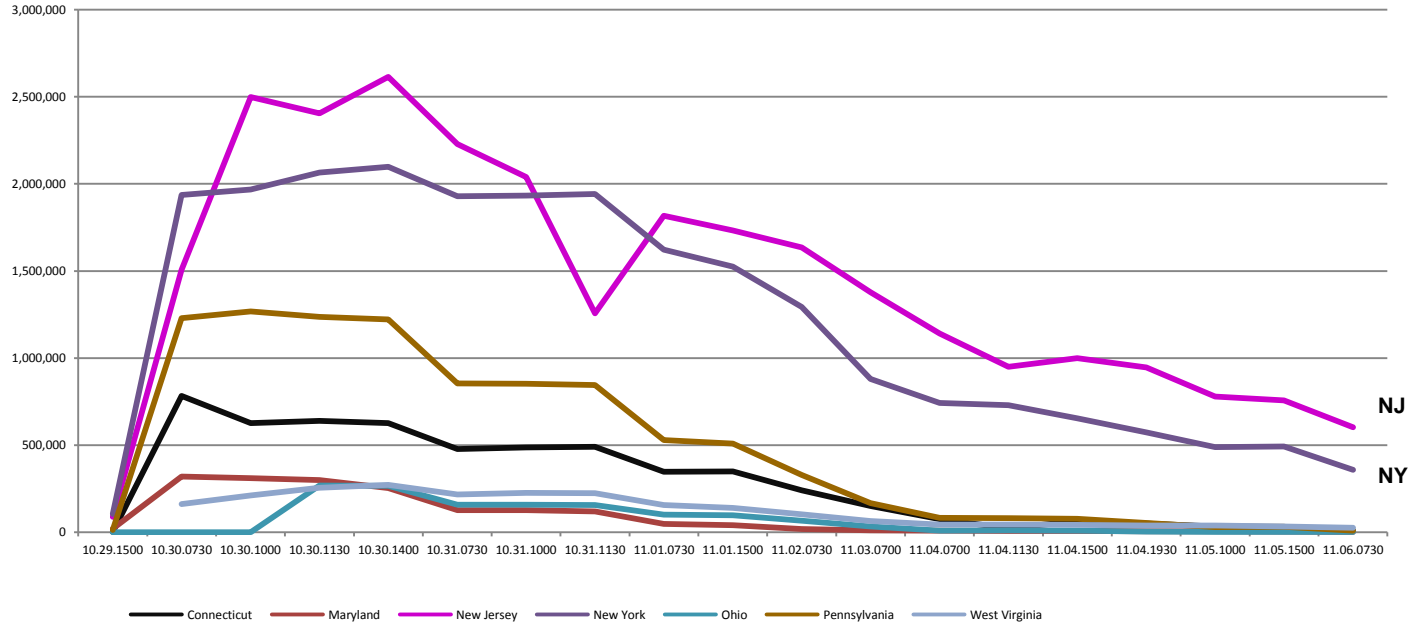


Hurricane Sandy-Power Outages



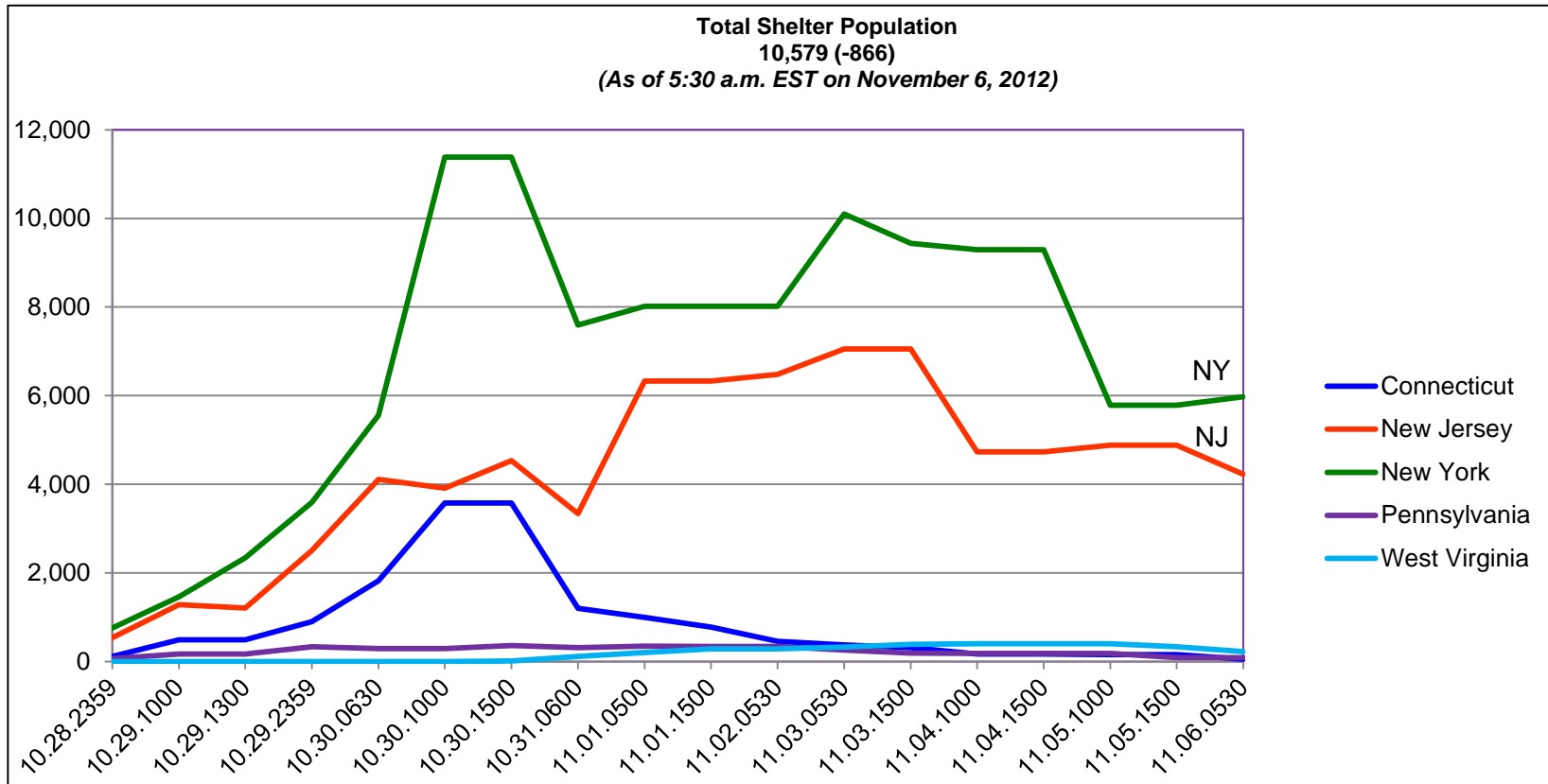

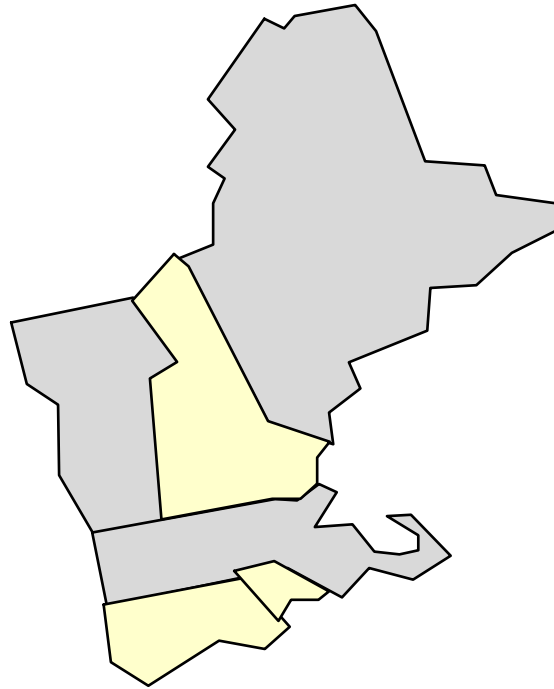

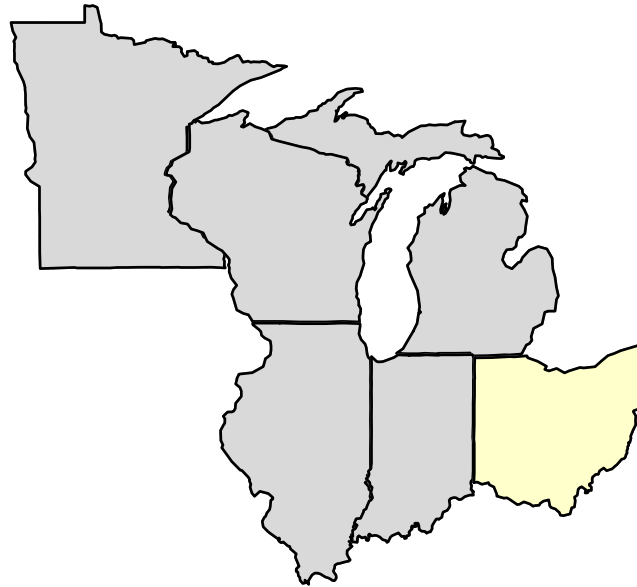

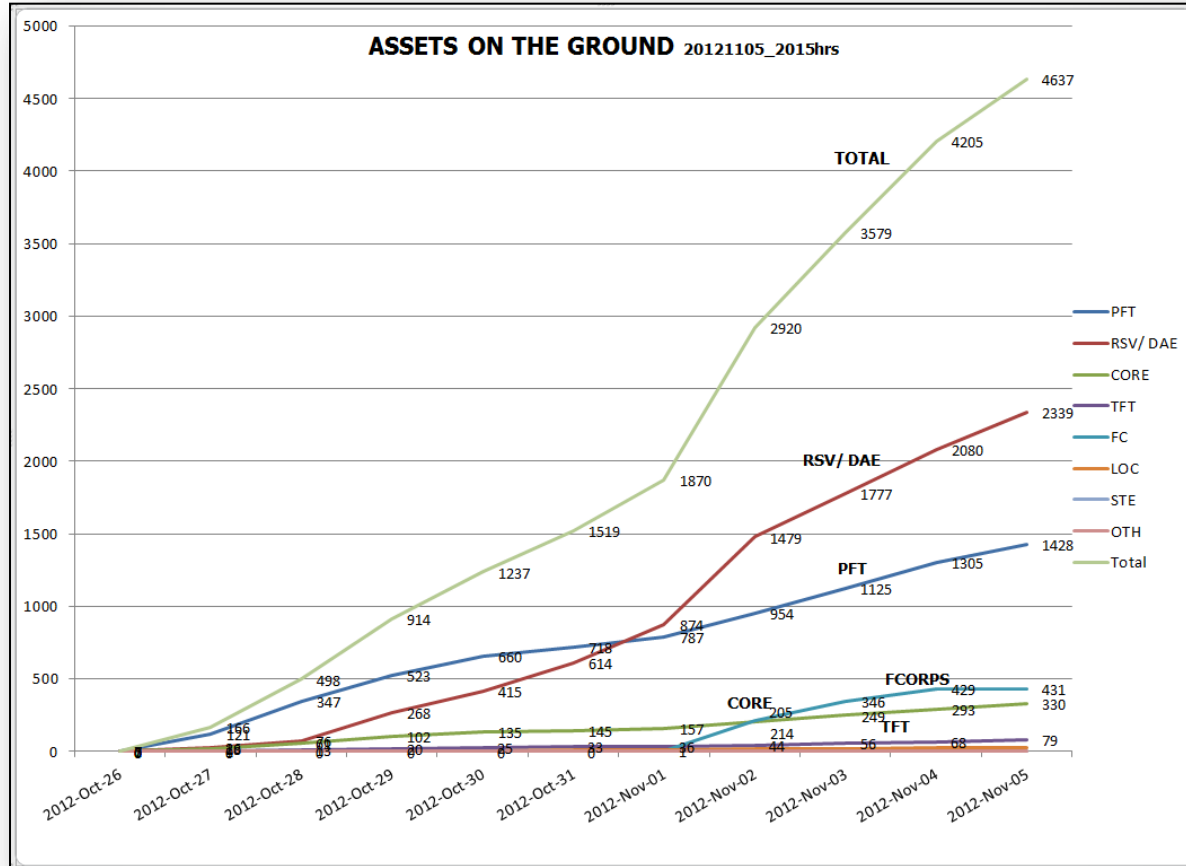

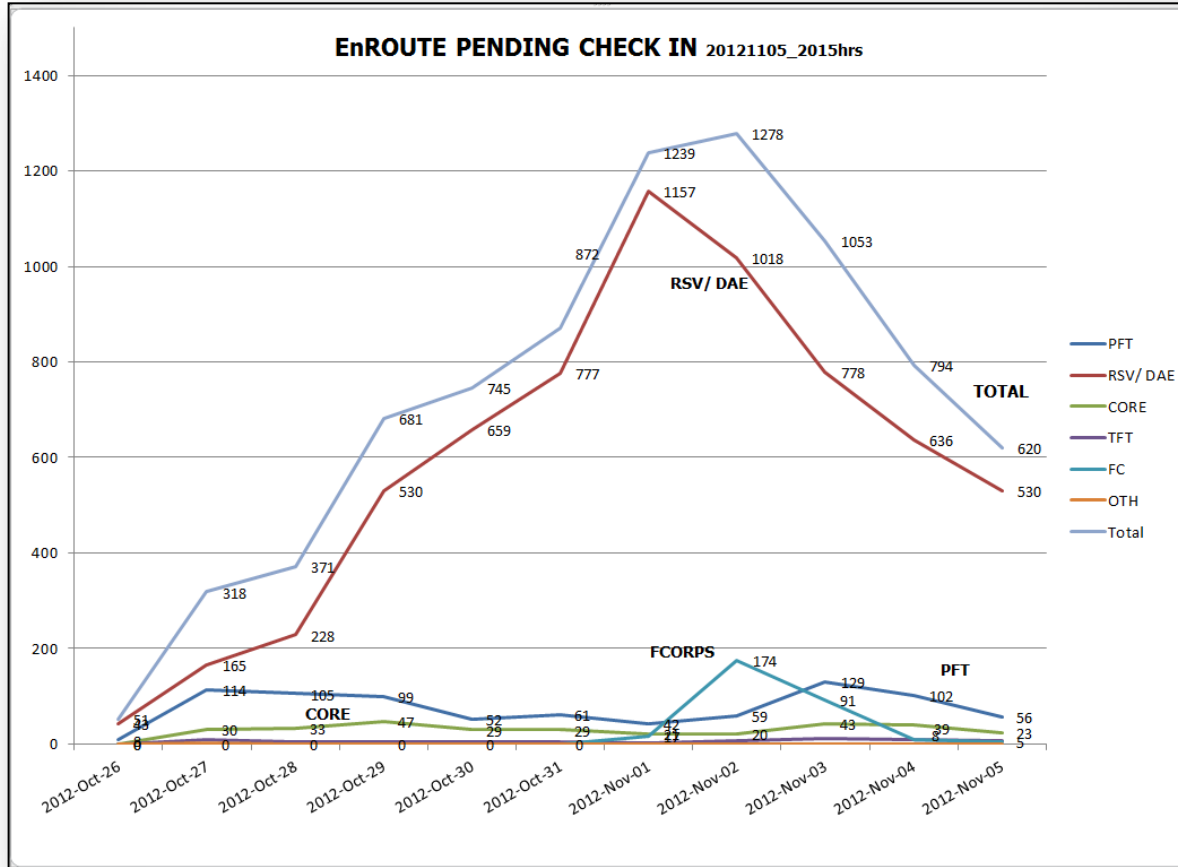

Hurricane Sandy – En route (Pending Check-in)



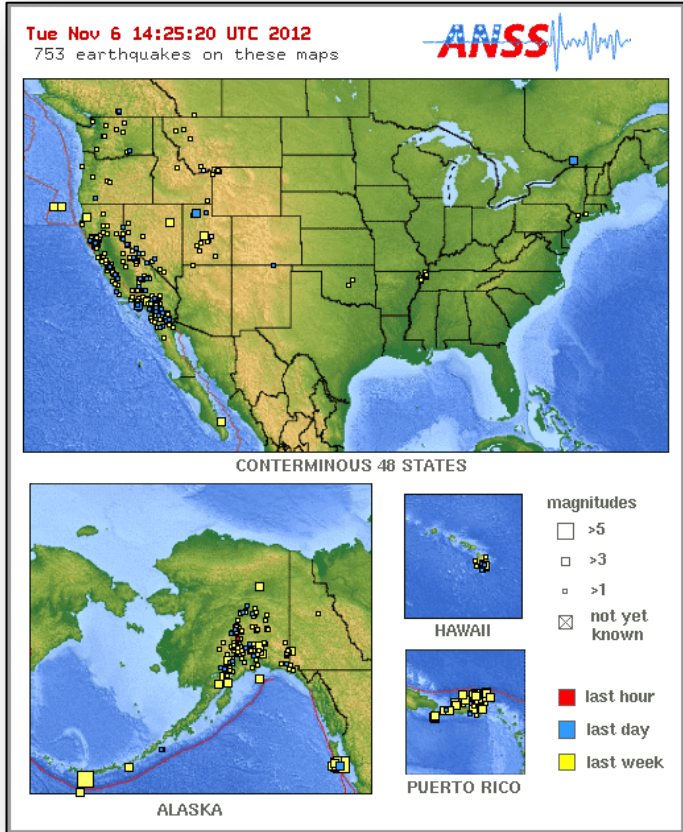

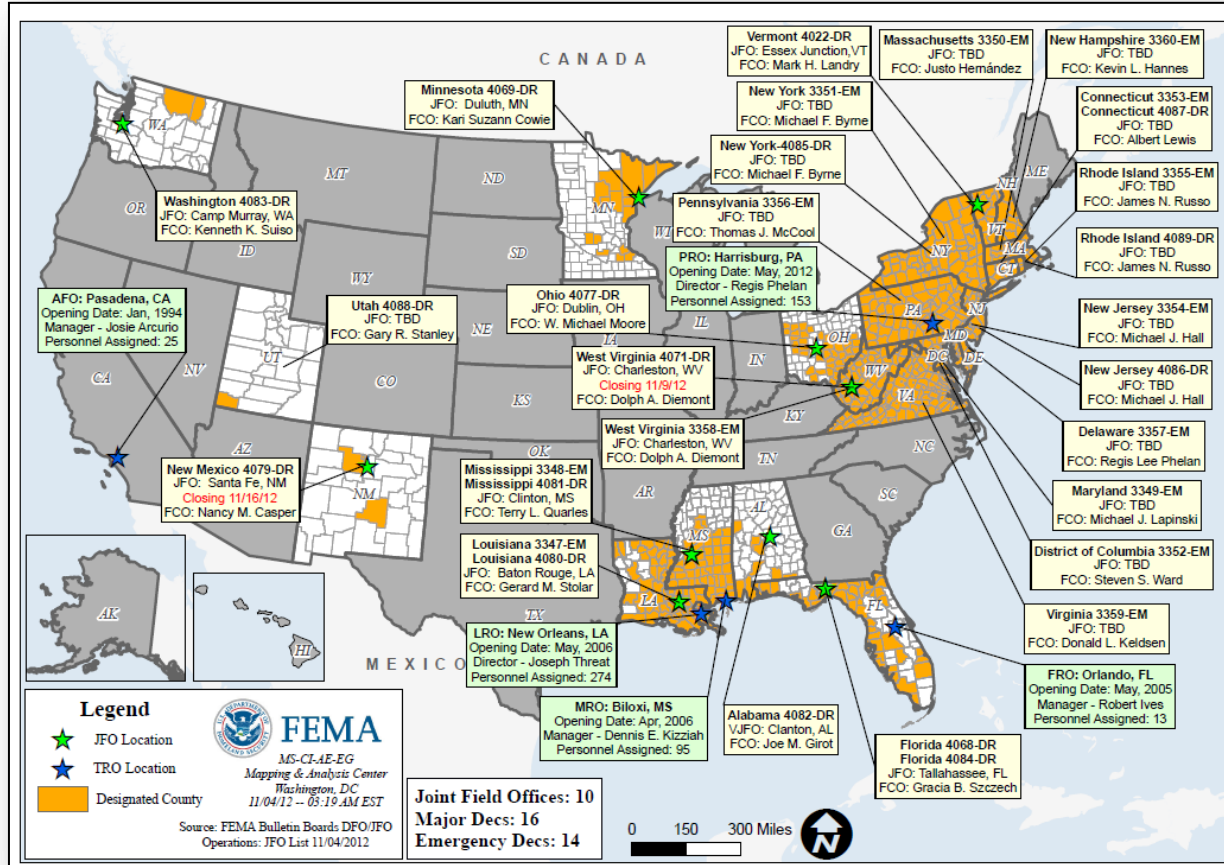
