Significant Weather

- Winter storm impacting the Northeastern U.S. will begin winding down today
- Light snow is expected to spread from the Central High Plains eastward to the Ohio Valley
- Critical Fire Weather Areas: None
- Red Flag Warnings: Florida
- Space Weather: No space weather storms observed or predicted

Tropical Activity: No activity threatening U.S. territories
Earthquake Activity: No significant activity

## Winter Storm Impacts, Dec 25-29

## Situation

- Strong winds, tornados \& heavy snow caused damage \& power outages in AR, TX, LA, MS \& AL
- Power restored to majority of customers in all states with the exception of AR
- Local damage assessments continue
- All state EOCs at normal operations
- No requests for FEMA assistance


## Arkansas

- Winter storms brought strong winds, freezing rain and heavy snow to portions of AR
- Governor declared a statewide disaster on December 26

(Source: National Weather Service, Little Rock, AR)
- 36,276 (-41,784) customer power outages (peak: 200,000) (Entergy; 5:30 a.m., Dec 30)
- 7 shelters with 107 (+24) occupants (ESF 6; 7 a.m. Dec 30)
- No critical facilities without power
- Out of state power crews aiding in restoration effort
- No fuel shortages reported


## Sandy/Nor'easter Recovery

## Summary

- 4,185 FEMA personnel are deployed supporting Sandy-related recovery operations across 11 states and District of Columbia 14 Major Disaster Declarations; 13 Emergency Declarations

New York (State EOC at Level III; Partial Activation)
A 3 shelters are open with 151 (-6) occupants (ESF 6, 7 a.m. Dec 30)

- 22 DRCs remain open
- Debris removal $75 \%$ (+2\%) complete (approx. 4.4 mil CY removed of 6.01 mil CY total)
- N-IMAT Blue is deployed to NY JFO
- Regional IMATs deployed to NY: R-II, R-IV, R-VIII, R-IX and R-X


## New Jersey (State EOC at Level II, Enhanced Ops)

- 24 DRCs remain open
- Debris removal $30 \%$ complete (approx. 3 mil CY removed of 10 mil CY total)
- N-IMAT Red is deployed to NJ JFO
