Significant Activity: May 22- 23

Significant Events:

- Oklahoma tornado recovery

Significant Weather:

- Slight risk of severe thunderstorms - Southern Plains and Mid-Atlantic to Northeast
- Rain and thunderstorms – Deep South and front range of Rockies
- Red Flag Warnings: AZ, NM & CO
- Critical Fire Weather Areas: AZ, NM, CO, UT & NV
- Space Weather: strong – S3 level storms and R2 radio blackouts occurred; next 24 hours – strong – S3 level storms expected

Earthquake Activity: No significant activity

Tropical Activity: Eastern Pacific: Area 1- LOW chance (20%)

Tornado Recovery- Oklahoma

Situation

- May 20, EF-5 tornado impacted city of Moore (pop. 56,315), Cleveland County
 - ▲ Beginning transition from response to recovery; focus on debris removal and housing
 - ▲ Thunderstorms possible tonight over response area but severe storms not expected
- No unmet needs
 - ▲ Structures damaged/destroyed
 - Destroyed: 1,101
 - Damaged: 157 major; 48 minor
 - Impacted: 1,122
 - ▲ 24 confirmed fatalities and 324 (+87) injuries (OK SITREP)
 - ▲ 7,152 (-5,848) customers remain without power (DOE)

Critical Infrastructure

- ▲ Draper Lake Water Treatment Plant operational but Boil Water Advisories continue in some areas
- ▲ Amtrak has resumed service
- ▲ 1 cell site (peak 110) remains inoperable
- ▲ Flight restrictions over Moore cancelled; less restrictive TFR to go into effect today



Tornado Recovery - Oklahoma



State Response

- ▲ OK State EOC at Level III (Partial Activation); [will close for weekend/holiday](#)
- Unified Command established; Army and Air National Guard personnel remain deployed
- ▲ 5 shelters (includes independent shelters) open with 377 (+57) occupants (NSS)

FEMA Region VI Response

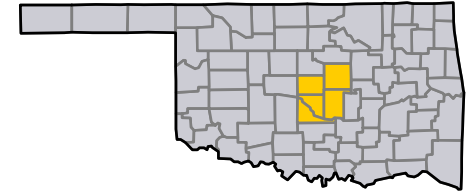
- ▲ RRCC transitioned to Level II
- IA/PA PDA teams deployed
- ▲ Civil Air Patrol conducted aerial PDAs on 5/21; PA PDAs are on hold
- ▲ FEMA Corps personnel supporting 2 DRCs that opened 5/22

FEMA Headquarters Response

- ▲ NRCC transitioned to Level II (day shift) with Enhanced Watch (night shift)
- Major Disaster Declaration FEMA-4117-DR-OK approved 5/20
- National IMAT-White deployed to OK State EOC
- Federal Search & Rescue Coordination Group activated
- ▲ US&R teams demobilizing today (TX TF-1, NE TF-1 & TN TF-1) MO TF-1 demobilized (5/22)
 - ▲ 1,708 structures searched to date
 - ▲ Red Incident Support Team (IST) to demobilize 5/24
- ▲ IOF established in Oklahoma City; [JFO location identified in Oklahoma City](#)
- ▲ ISB transitioned to a Federal Staging Area (FSA) at Will Rogers Airport
- 5 Disaster Survivor Assistance Teams (DSATs) deploying to affected areas
- USACE SME's onsite providing technical support for power & debris removal
- ▲ 8 MCOVs (6 on site and [2 en route](#)) and elements from 4 MERS detachments deployed

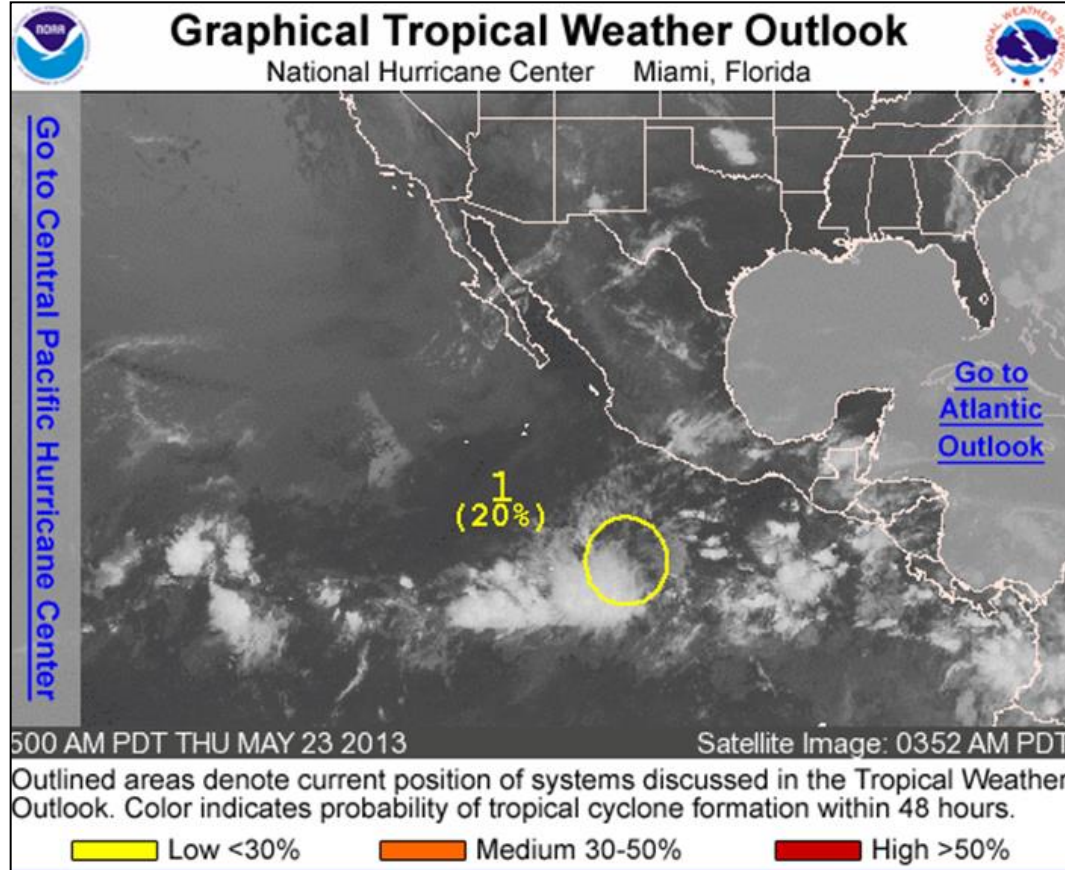

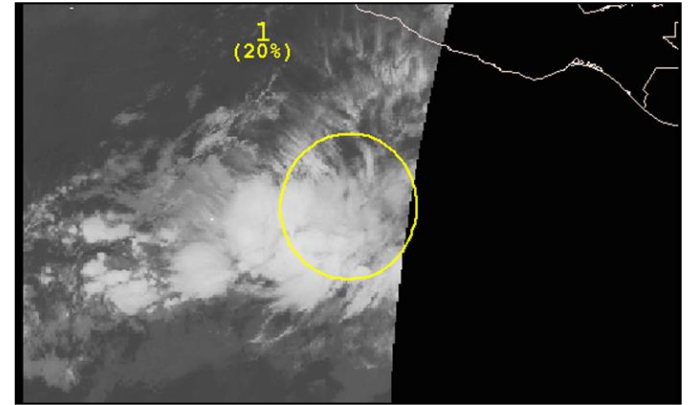
Eastern Pacific – Tropical Outlook



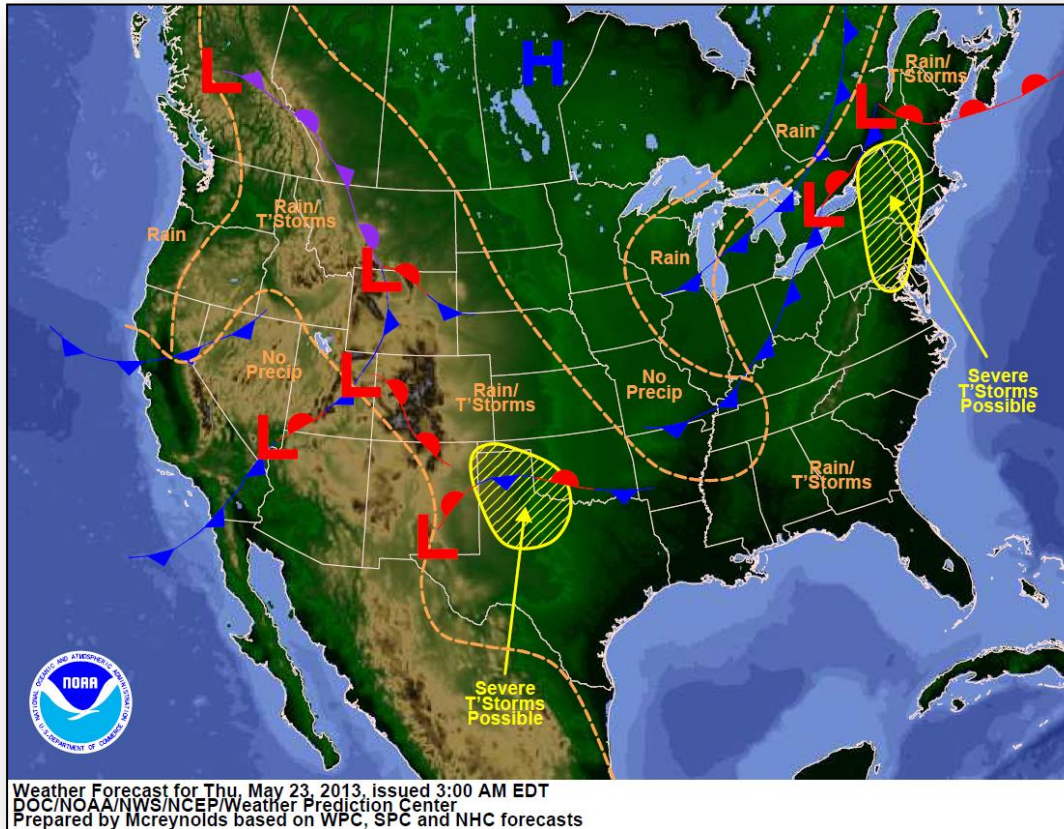
Eastern Pacific – Area 1

- LOW (20%) chance of becoming a tropical cyclone next 48 hours



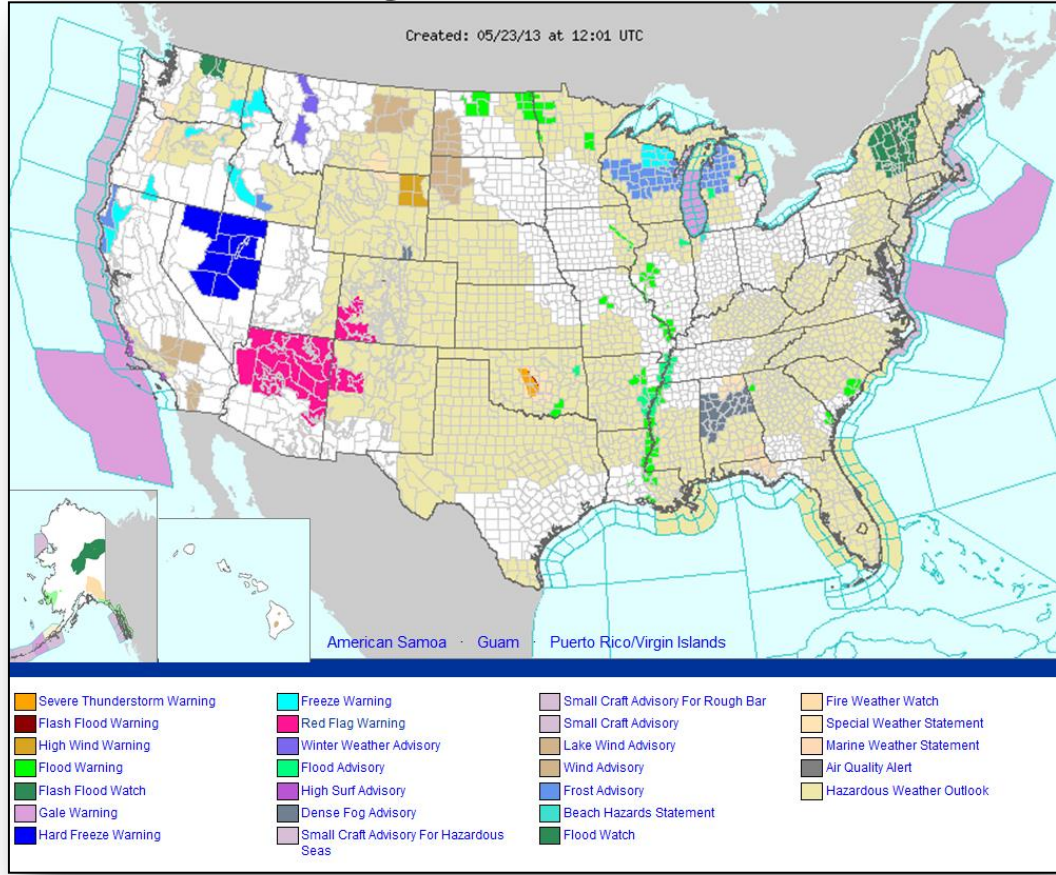

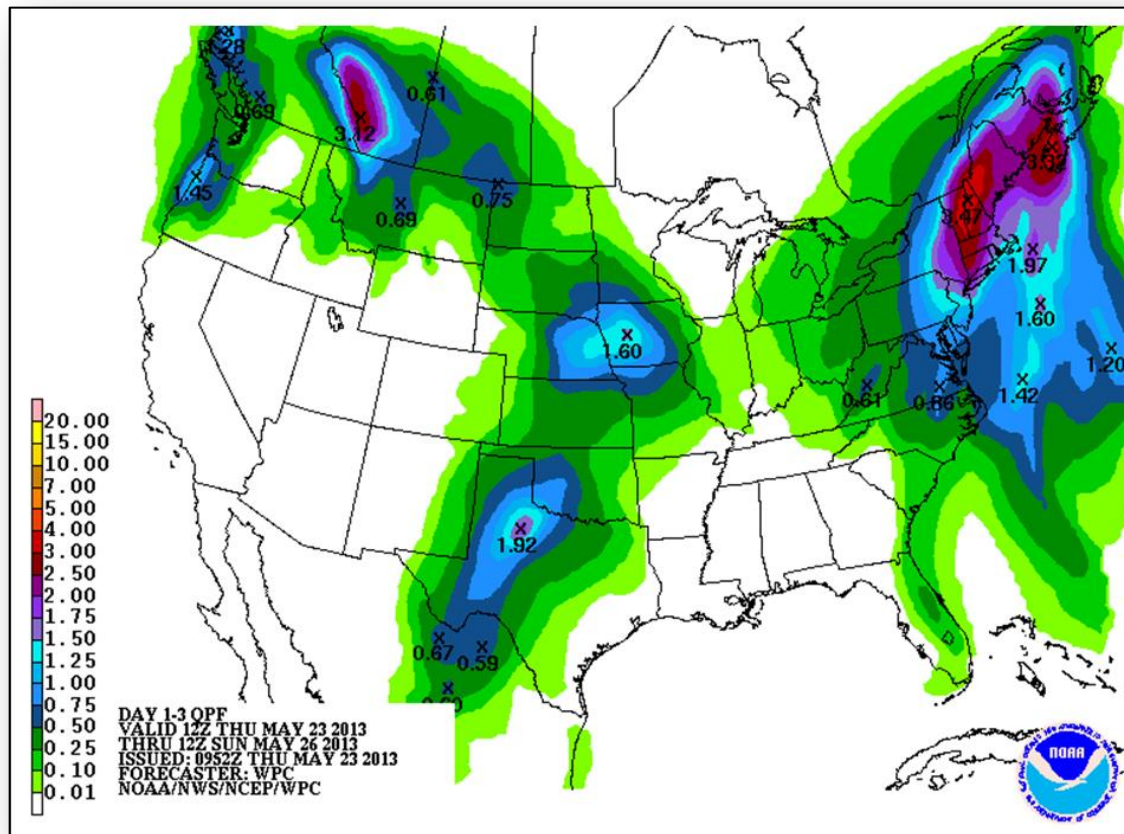

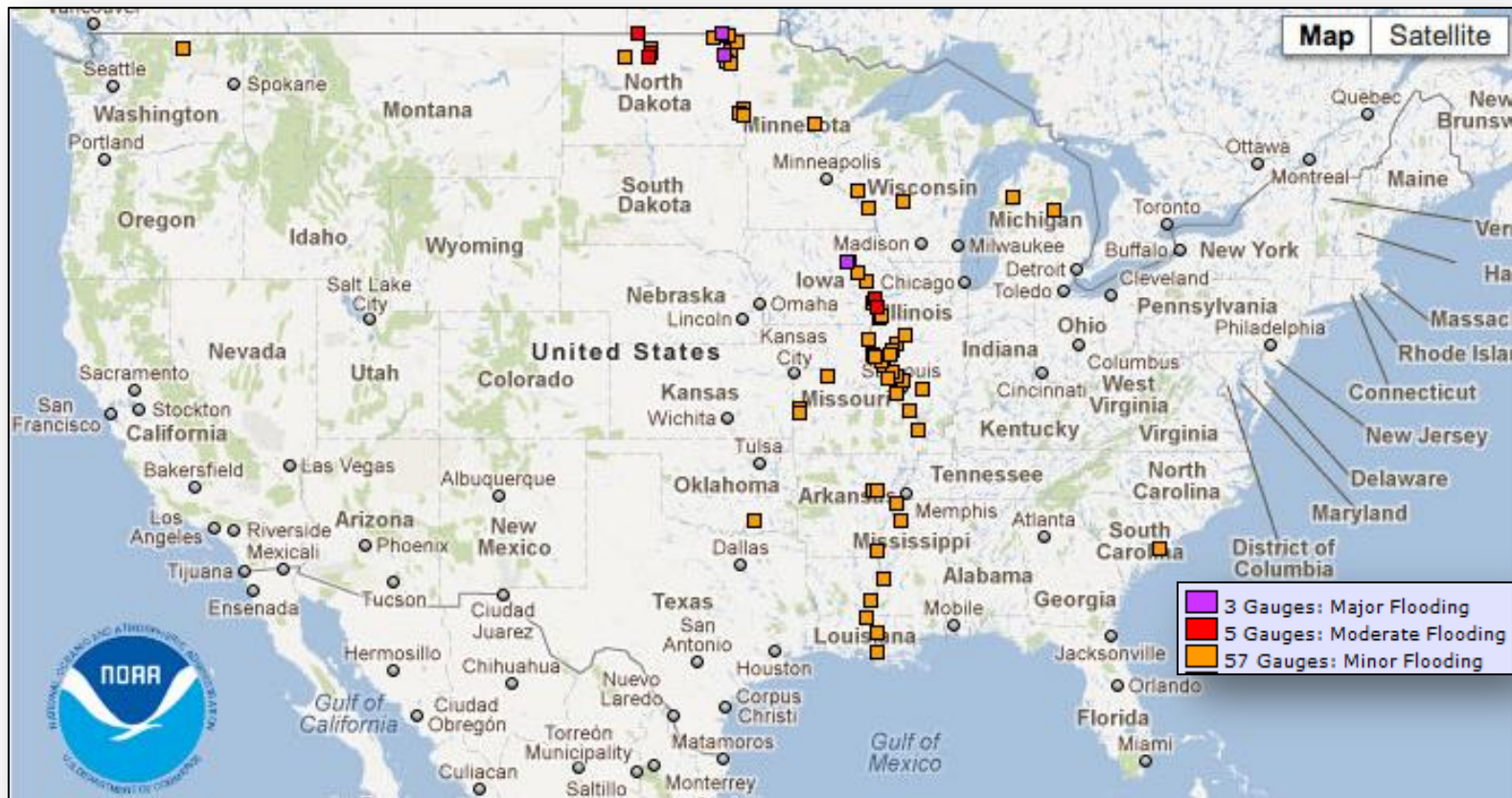
Precipitation Forecast Days 1 – 3



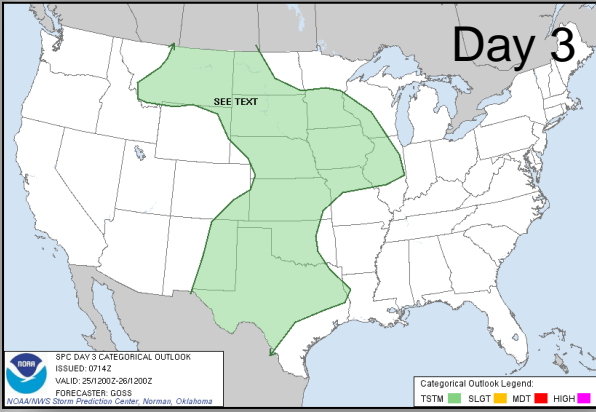
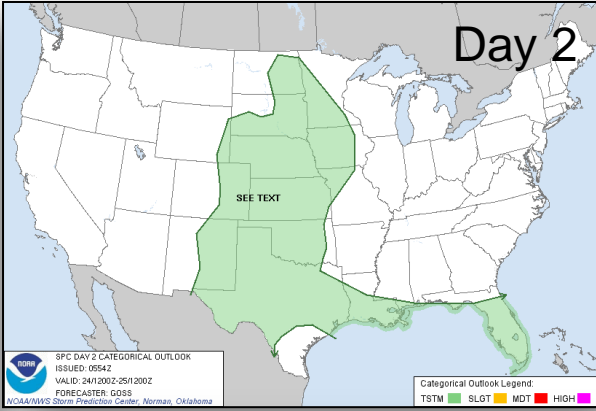
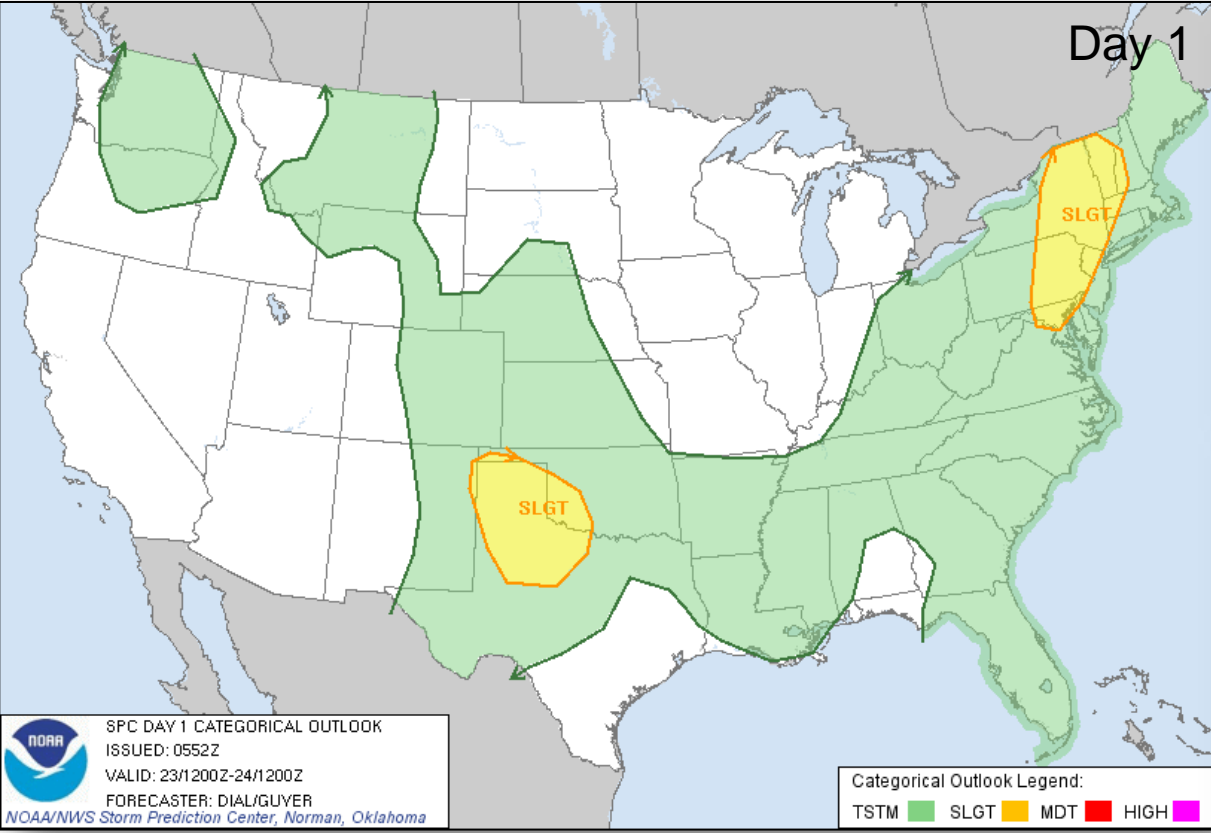
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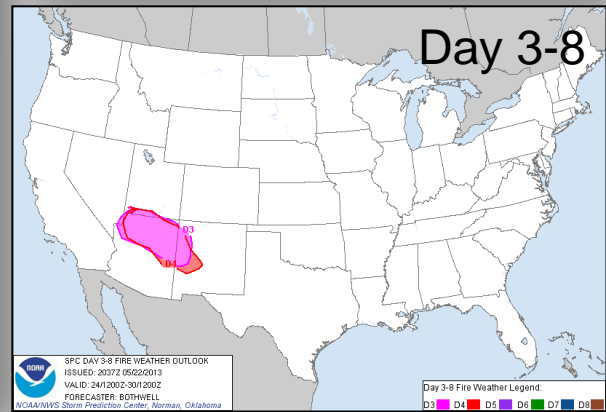
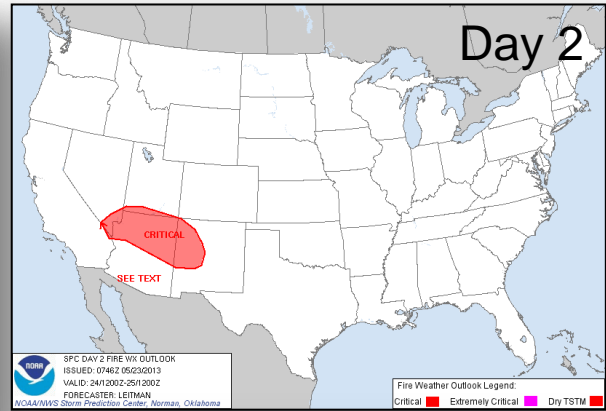
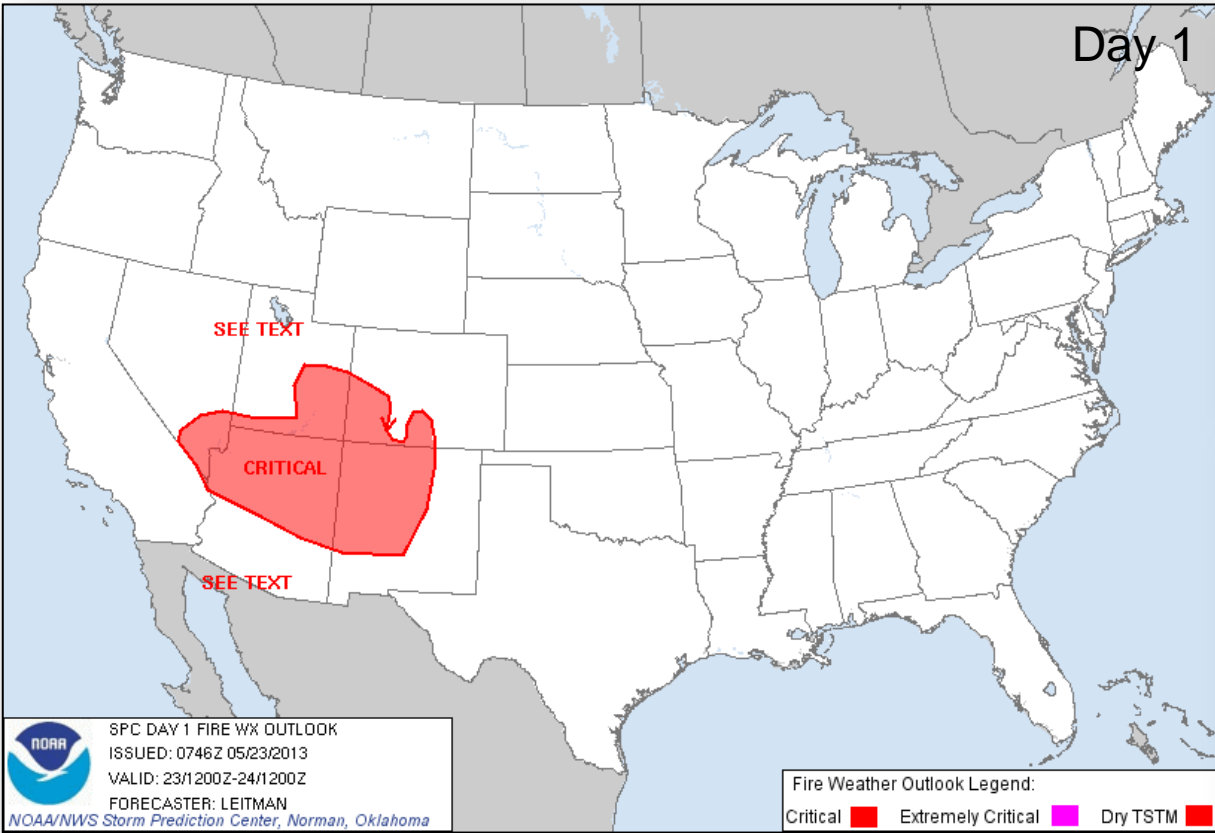

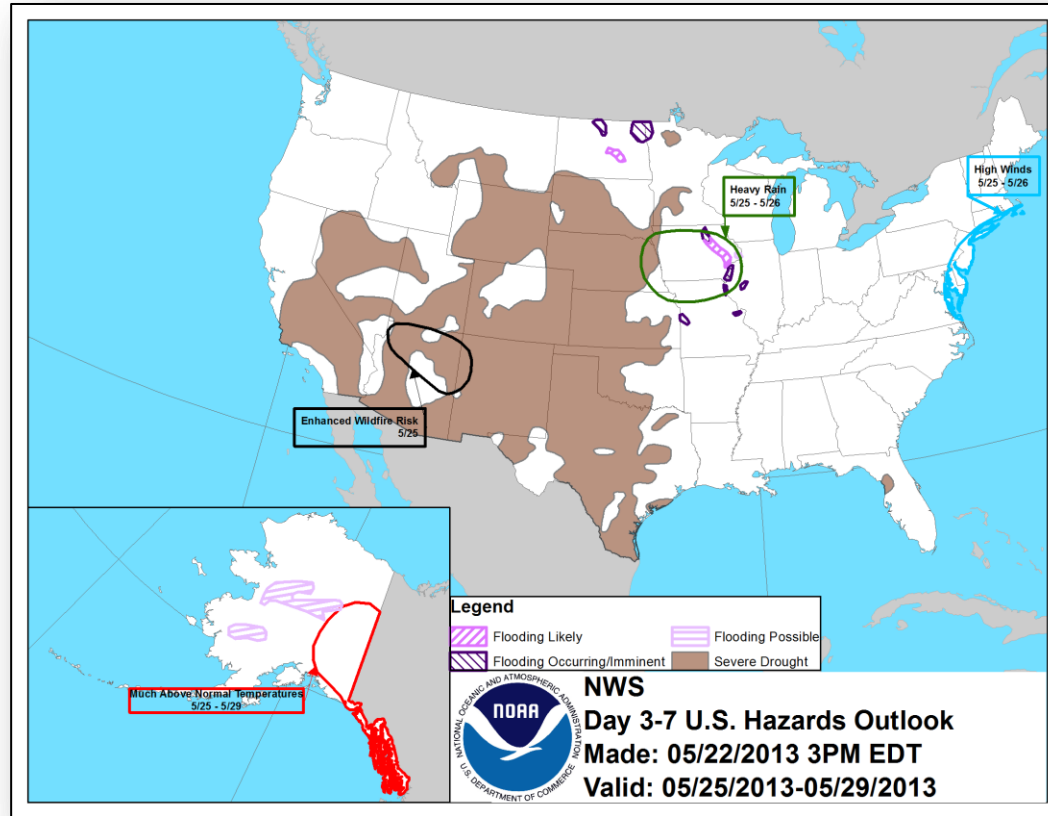
Convective Outlooks Days 1 – 3



Critical Fire Weather Areas Days 1 – 8

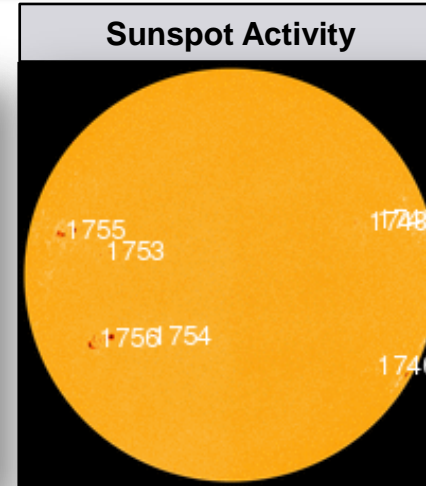
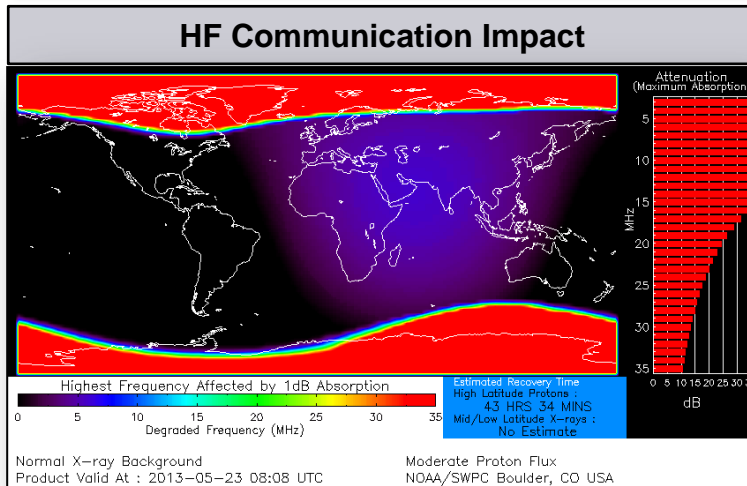

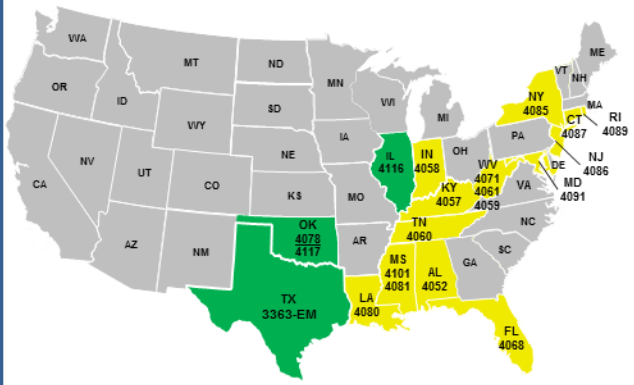

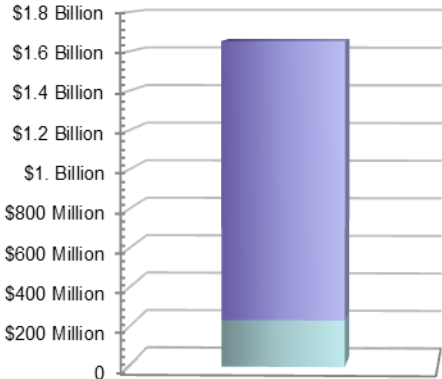

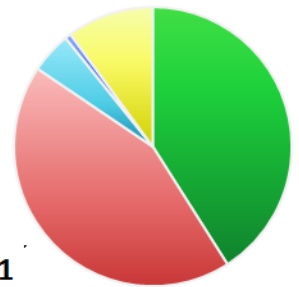

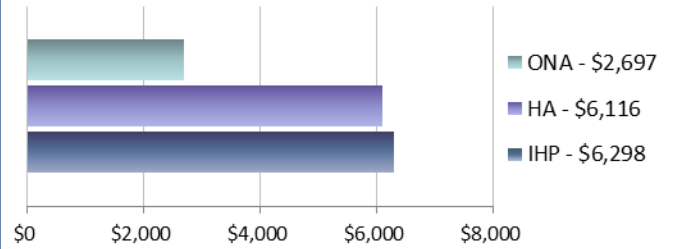
