The Wisconsin Local Food Expo brings together institutions, groceries and restaurants to meet with exhibiting local food suppliers. The Expo will be held on Tuesday, September 18 from 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. at the Alliant Energy Center Exhibition Hall in Madison.
