PROCLAMATION "Domestic Violence Awareness Month" October 2015

Whereas, domestic violence is an epidemic affecting Americans in all communities, regardless of age, gender, economic status, race, religion, or educational background; and

Whereas, domestic violence is a pattern of coercive control where one partner uses their power to control the other partner through physical, sexual, emotional, or financial abuse; and

Whereas, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports that nearly 1 in 4 women & 1 in 7 men have experienced domestic violence in their lifetime; therefore, 800,000 women and 450,000 men in Arizona may experience domestic violence in their lifetime; and

Whereas, in 2014, 109 people were killed in domestic violence related homicides in Arizona according to the Arizona Coalition to End Sexual and Domestic Violence; and

Whereas, the Arizona Department of Health Services advises that in Arizona, one or more children witness a domestic violence incident every 44 minutes; and

Whereas, in one 24-hour period in 2014, 35 programs in Arizona served 1,602 victims of domestic violence as documented by the National Network To End Domestic Violence; and

Whereas, the Arizona Department of Health Services advises that most cases of domestic violence are never reported to law enforcement authorities; and

Whereas, enhanced education, prevention, and intervention efforts will increase public awareness, mobilize community action, and confront the abuse of power and control in interpersonal relationships;




