

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS BID PROPOSALS SOUGHT FOR 2012 RESURFACING OF FEDERAL AID ROUTES PROJECT

The City of Menlo Park invites qualified contractors to submit sealed bid proposals for the **2012 RESURFACING OF FEDERAL AID ROUTES PROJECT** along Sand Hill Road and Marsh Road. The work consists of a base bid to remove and replace eleven (11) curb ramps, six (6) inch dig outs of failed asphalt concrete pavement, two (2) inch depth cold-mill and asphalt concrete pavement overlay, raise utilities to grade, replace striping, markers and markings, install two (2) pedestrian push buttons, heads, and mounts, install detector loops, and other incidentals as necessary to complete the work as shown on the Plans and as specified in the Special Provisions.

A valid **Class "A" or Class "C-12" license applicable to the Work** is required for this Project. No bid will be accepted from a Contractor who has not been licensed according to Chapter 9, Division 3 of the Business and Professional Code. Specialized subcontractor services shall be performed by contractors licensed in the appropriate classifications. DBE participation is expected for this project. Project documents and copies of the prevailing rate of wages can be obtained from the Menlo Park Engineering Division, located in the Administrative Building at 701 Laurel St. Sealed bid proposals will be received at the Engineering Division office until 2 p.m. on Thursday, September 20, 2012, at which time they will be opened and publicly read.
