## Our Prospectus contains...

In line with government expectations the purpose of our devolution plans is to increase productivity. The prospectus is a starting point for negotiation and further development. It is [available online](#) and focuses on six key 'golden opportunities':

- Marine
- Nuclear
- Aerospace and advanced engineering
- Data analytics
- Rural productivity
- Health and care

Our proposals seek devolved powers and funds to deliver greater productivity, better infrastructure and public sector reform. In return for devolved powers we offer:

- An overarching Productivity Plan to drive economic growth, encompassing:
  - A Strategic Labour Market Plan to reshape the skills and training environment
  - A Strategic Infrastructure Plan for the area
- A scaled up and secure Growth Hub providing a seamless approach to business support
- A whole-system approach to health and care

By 2030 our plans will deliver or help deliver:

- An additional £4bn GVA
- 163,000 new jobs
- 179,000 new homes
- Higher wage levels, more apprenticeships, and 60% of our workforce qualified to NVQ level 4 or above
- Approximately £113m additional tax revenue for the Treasury per year
- Faster and more reliable road and rail journeys
- 100% superfast broadband access

We have proposed to create a Combined Authority to deliver our devolution deal.
