

COVID-19 Therapeutics Locator

Fact Sheet

Purpose

The COVID-19 Therapeutics Locator is an interactive map that assists health care providers with identifying licensed and authorized locations where patients can fill prescriptions or receive therapy. The locator displays public locations with available courses of U.S. Government-procured COVID-19 therapeutics. These therapeutics are available under U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Emergency Use Authorizations (EUA). The locations displayed can be filtered by product name via the “therapeutic selector” drop box. The number of courses available at each location is listed.

What's New

Data Available



The locator displays the address of therapeutic sites and courses available at locations that meet three criteria:

1. Sites have been designated as a public provider of therapeutic treatment.
2. Sites have self-reported, within the past seven days, the number of therapeutic courses available.
3. Sites have courses available.

The locator is updated daily.

Added Therapeutics

The therapeutics locator now includes: Sotrovimab, bebtelovimab, Evusheld, molnupirivir, and Paxlovid.
