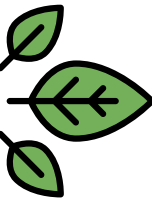

FARMERS' MARKET PROGRAM



Low-income Alaska seniors can receive **\$55*** to buy locally grown fruits, vegetables, herbs and honey.

Support Alaska's farmers by shopping with over **60** authorized farmers selling produce at farmers' markets, farms and farm stands in:

- Anchorage
- Eagle River
- Haines
- Kodiak
- Sitka
- Delta Junction
- Fairbanks
- Kenai Peninsula
- Mat-Su
- Willow

Alaska residents are eligible if 60 years or older and either:

- Have an income less than 185% of the federal poverty level or
- Are receiving Commodity Supplemental Food Program benefits

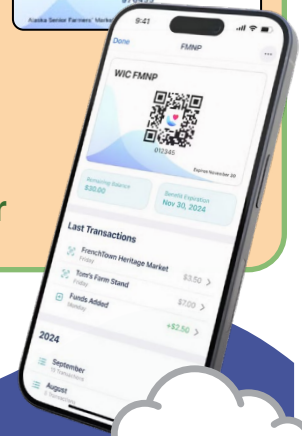
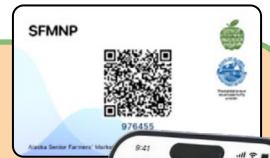
