The Summit will welcome 300+ participants, including service providers, advocates, policymakers and system leaders working to strengthen Alaska's aging and disability systems across urban, rural and Alaska Native communities. *Both in-person and virtual participation options are available.*

The Summit is hosted by the Alaska Commission on Aging in partnership with the Statewide Independent Living Council of Alaska, Special Olympics Alaska, Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority, AARP Alaska and additional local and national partners committed to advancing dignity and independence for Older Alaskans.

The **3-day Summit** will address the growing needs of Alaska's senior population focusing on innovation, cultural relevance and transforming the way we think about aging. Sessions will explore how Rural Health Transformation and other statewide reform efforts intersect with aging and disability services, including healthcare access and care coordination, dementia and chronic disease prevention, behavioral health and intellectual and developmental disabilities, workforce capacity and provider sustainability, elder justice and housing and home- and community-based services that support aging in place. Content will be organized into targeted tracks for different audiences while maintaining a shared statewide perspective.

Key goals include inspiring policy support for safe and independent aging, fostering cross-sector collaboration, generating actionable outcomes and shared advocacy priorities, and supporting development of Alaska's next State Plan for Senior Services.

The Summit will produce recommendations to improve older Alaskan care. The Alaska Commission on Aging will track progress of completing tasks following the Summit.
