

Travel Alert

Westbound Interstate 10 narrowed to one lane between Wild Horse Pass Blvd. and Chandler Blvd. – August 5-6, 2011

RESTRICTIONS

Westbound I-10 (from Tucson) narrowed to one lane between Wild Horse Pass Blvd. and Chandler Blvd. from 10 p.m. Friday (Aug. 5) to 9 p.m. Saturday (Aug. 6). EXPECT HEAVY DELAYS! Travel before or after this restriction if you can or use alternate routes into the Southeast Valley, such as northbound State Route 587.

Additional restrictions are planned overnight Friday and early Saturday at the I-10/Loop 202 (Santan Freeway/Pecos Road) interchange:

- ▶ Ramps from east and westbound Loop 202 to westbound I-10 closed from 10 p.m. Friday (Aug. 5) to 6 a.m. Saturday (Aug. 6)
- ▶ Ramps from westbound I-10 to east- and westbound Loop 202 closed from 3 a.m. to 10 a.m. Saturday (Aug. 6)

STAY UP TO DATE

Stay up to date about traffic conditions at az511.gov or by calling 5-1-1 from any landline or mobile phone from anywhere in Arizona.

These restrictions are necessary so crews can replace overhead freeway signage on westbound I-10 and shift westbound I-10 travel lanes to their original configuration.
