- STEP ZERO: BUILDING MOTIVATION
- During step zero, we'll cover building motivation, relationship, reward systems, communication for right and wrong, hunt games, searching for primary reinforcers, controls on reinforcers, capping games.
- This step is all the things that come before odor.
- STEP ONE: INTRODUCTION TO ODOR
- Odor imprinting and building obedience to odor. Introduction to the pros and cons to different systems in detection - pairing and delayed conditioning and how to balance that between the two. Problem solving and handler skills.
- There is no experience in detection required for this class. Food or toy motivation is very helpful. Dogs need to be suited to a group environment NO reactivity.
