As announced at the Neighborhood Watch Program Kick-Off event, YAPD will begin implementing the RAVE Communication system within the Tunlii Community.

In order for our agency to roll out this new platform, we have to manually input every tenant's contact information into the system. We will then use this information to generate a group for Tunlii Residents in which YAPD can send instant push notifications to enrolled individuals in case of an emergency. This will also include alerts for meeting updates, roadway conditions, utility notifications and much more.

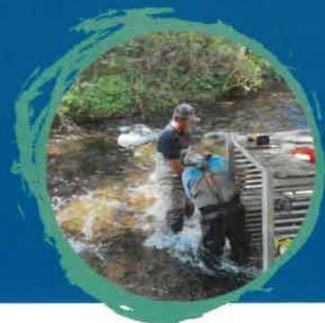
