Public Service Announcement

Town of Camp Verde – Street Signage Improvements

The Town of Camp Verde Streets Department has recently installed new traffic signage at the intersection of 7th Street and Hollamon Street to enhance safety and improve driver awareness.

Northbound motorists on 7th Street will now see an intersection advance warning sign with a reduced speed advisory of 15 MPH approximately 350 feet south of the Hollamon Street intersection.

In addition, eastbound and westbound traffic on Hollamon Street will notice new signage at the stop signs indicating that cross traffic on 7th Street does not stop.

These improvements are intended to promote safety, increase driver awareness, and reduce the potential for vehicle collisions at this location.

When traveling through the area, please remain alert, watch for potential hazards, and obey all posted traffic control devices.
