Dear Potential Vendor,

On September 18, 2018 the Alameda County Sheriff's Office Inmate Services Unit will host our annual Re-Entry Expo. The Re-Entry Expo serves as a bridge between community-based organizations, government agencies, and prospective clients.

The expo is held in the Transition Center at the Santa Rita Jail. The format of the expo is intended to mirror employment and resource fairs held in the community. Our event allows those incarcerated to speak openly with service providers about available re-entry resources. We believe the connections created at this event are an invaluable tool as the inmates make plans for a successful transition from incarceration back to their families, and communities.

The Re-Entry Expo benefits the vendors by providing pre-release access to more than 400 potential clients. The population attending the expo will include men, women, parents, veterans, homeless, and those sentenced under AB-109. Members of the Alameda County Sheriff's Office, and the Alameda County Probation Department will be in attendance to learn about the many programs.

If you are an organization that provides information or services regarding: Counseling, Family Resources, Health and Wellness, Social Services, Legal Resources, Education, Training, Employment, Veterans Services, Rehabilitation, Housing, wrap around services, or any basic needs, we ask that you consider setting up a booth at our event.

The expo hours are 7:30 A.M. to 1:30 P.M. We will serve a continental breakfast and lunch. Each vendor will be provided a booth that will include a table and two chairs. There is no cost to attend. Vendor registration is limited to sixty agencies.

Attached is the registration packet which includes a site clearance, and vendor registration form. Registration packets must be completed and submitted no later than August 31, 2018.

The Alameda County Sheriff's Office thanks you for your consideration to be a vendor. The incarcerated population is in great need of your services.

## ALAMEDA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE INMATE SERVICES UNIT SECURITY SITE CLEARANCE FORM – INSTRUCTIONS

All Re-Entry Expo participants requesting access to the Santa Rita Jail must fill out a Security Site Clearance form.

When filling out the form, please do not leave any lines blank. If the line does not apply to you, please use the acronym "NA" so that we know the question was not skipped. If the question requires a YES or NO answer, please answer appropriately.

If you have ever been arrested or charged with a crime, please provide the appropriate information. Having been arrested or charged with a crime **does not** automatically disqualify you. Not listing the arrest, conviction, or other contact is an automatic disqualifier.

Examples:

- If you were arrested but never charged or the case was dismissed, please list the incident because it will show on the arrest history.
- If you were arrested, convicted, and then sentenced to county jail but later had your case dismissed through PC 1203.4 then you must list the arrest.

We understand that complete information regarding arrests that occurred several years ago is not always available. Please give us as much information as possible. Per the Alameda County Sheriff's Office policy, applicants will be denied if they are not truthful, omit information, or are deceptive.

Results of the security site clearance will be shared with the applicants only.
