IT HAS BEEN 20 YEARS SINCE SUNOL RESIDENTS APPROVED A SCHOOL BOND. IN ORDER TO REMAIN PRESERVED AND COMPETITIVE AS A DISTRICT, THE STRUCTURAL INADEQUACIES OF OUR SCHOOL NEED TO BE ADDRESSED. AS COSTS CONTINUE TO RISE, DELAYING PROJECTS WILL ONLY COST US MORE IN THE FUTURE.
