EMPLOYMENT LAW UPDATE: A CLOSER LOOK AT COBRA

COBRA – the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act – requires group health plans to offer continuation coverage to covered employees, former employees, spouses, former spouses, and dependent children when group health coverage would otherwise be lost due to certain events.

This program will discuss the nuances of COBRA, common pitfalls and tips for compliance. Topics include:

- Which employers are subject to COBRA and who is considered a qualified beneficiary
- COBRA qualifying events and duration of coverage
- COBRA notice requirements
- Interaction between COBRA and Medicare
- COBRA and business reorganizations
- Coordination of COBRA and Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA)

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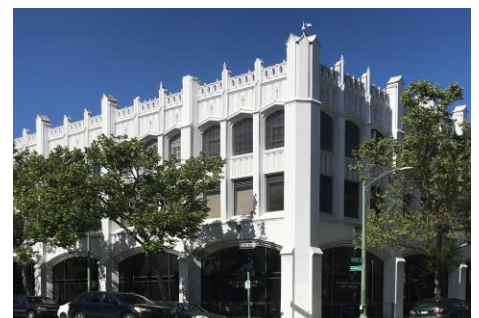
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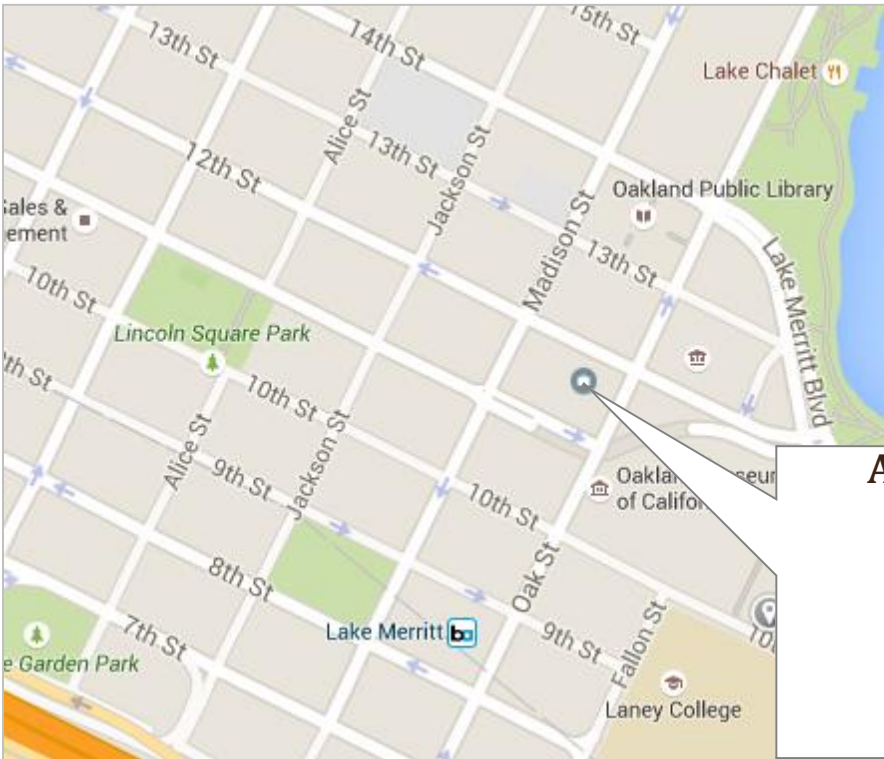
