- <u>Alameda Meals on Wheels (AMOW)</u>: AMOW delivers nutritionally balanced meals to Alameda residents of all ages that need our assistance whether due to recent surgery or hospitalization, because they aren't able to get out to grocery shop, or because they can't cook their own meals. - Dig Deep Farms (DDF) Food Hub food distribution: The DDF Food Hub is distributing food every Friday from 1 PM-2 PM at 2700 Fairmont Drive in San Leandro. Food delivery is also available for families in need. If you need food delivered, please fill out the Deputy Sheriff's Activities League (DSAL) sign-up form.

- <u>SOS Meals on Wheels (MOW)</u>: SOS MOW delivers nutritionally balanced meals to individuals aged 60 and older, individuals who are unable to shop for food or prepare meals for themselves, and do not have a caregiver. SOS MOW's serves individuals in Castro Valley, San Leandro, San Lorenzo, Hayward, and Oakland.
