6/23	C3	Organized Retail Theft	Between 3/13 and 5/9, three suspects entered Target on Stevens Creek Boulevard on eight separate occasions and worked together to steal merchandise with an aggregate total of approximately \$5,815. The suspects are known, and the case is being submitted to the District Attorney's Office for warrant issuance.
