What to Look For



Pest shelter sources

Webs, wasps nests, pests under and around play equipment

Weeds or ant mounds in pavement cracks

Ant mounds in sandboxes and landscape

IPM actions

- Remove spiders and webs with web duster or vacuum
- Contact pest management professional for wasp and bee removal
- Sweep away mound and ants
- Pull up weeds and sweep away excess dirt
- Seal pavement cracks with sealant
- Bait for ants
- Large, loose soil ant mounds may indicate fire ant infestation
- Notify IPM Coordinator, contact pest management professional
