Overview of Survey

- 808 participants
- Survey comprised of 28 questions, covering vaping, college preparation, bullying and mental health/wellness resources
- Students were questioned about awareness on all topics, ranked suggestions for future, etc.
- Students from Union Mine, Oak Ridge, El Dorado, EDUHSD Virtual
 Academy, Charter Connections, Charter University Prep, Charter College &
 Career Prep, and South Lake Tahoe



Results showed that 68% of students feel that they have at least one staff member or peer you can reach out to when feeling emotional and/or mental stress.






