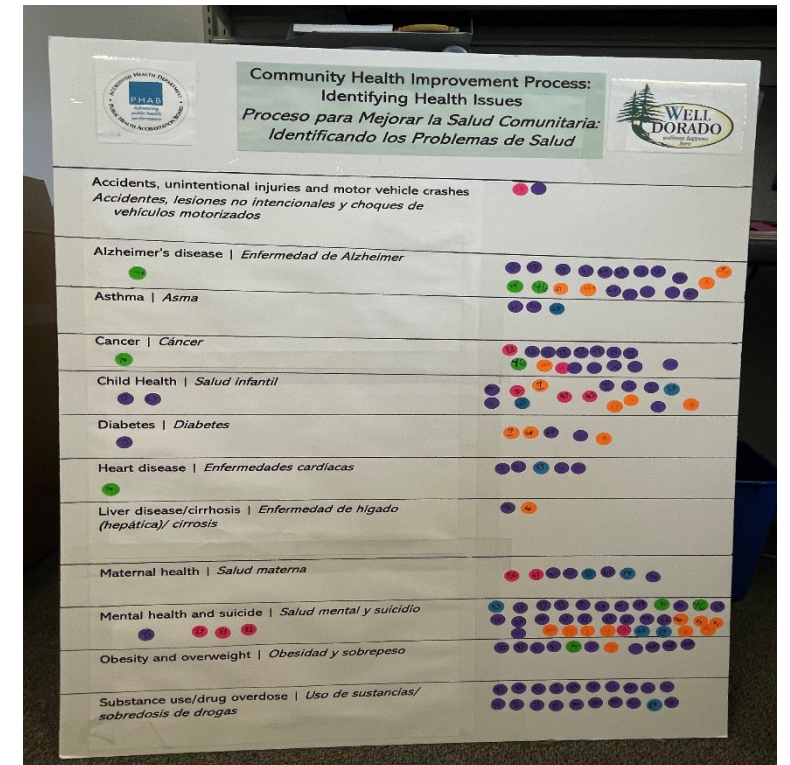

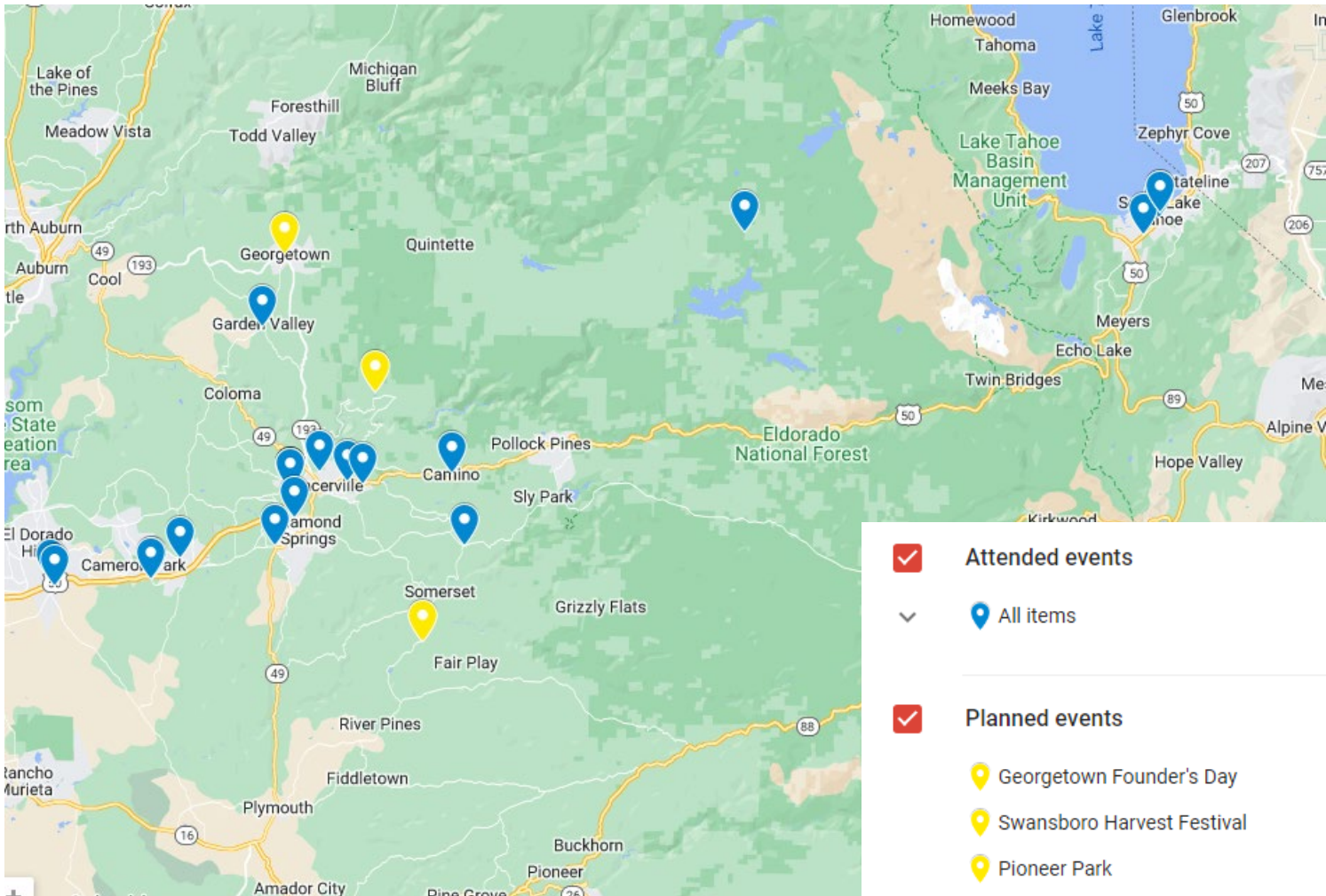

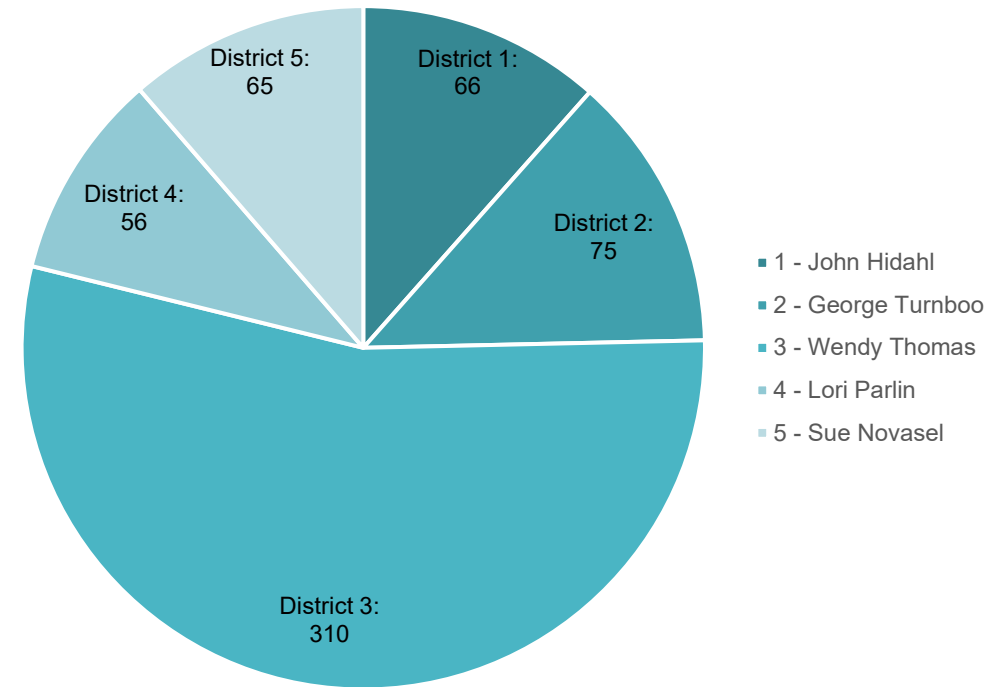

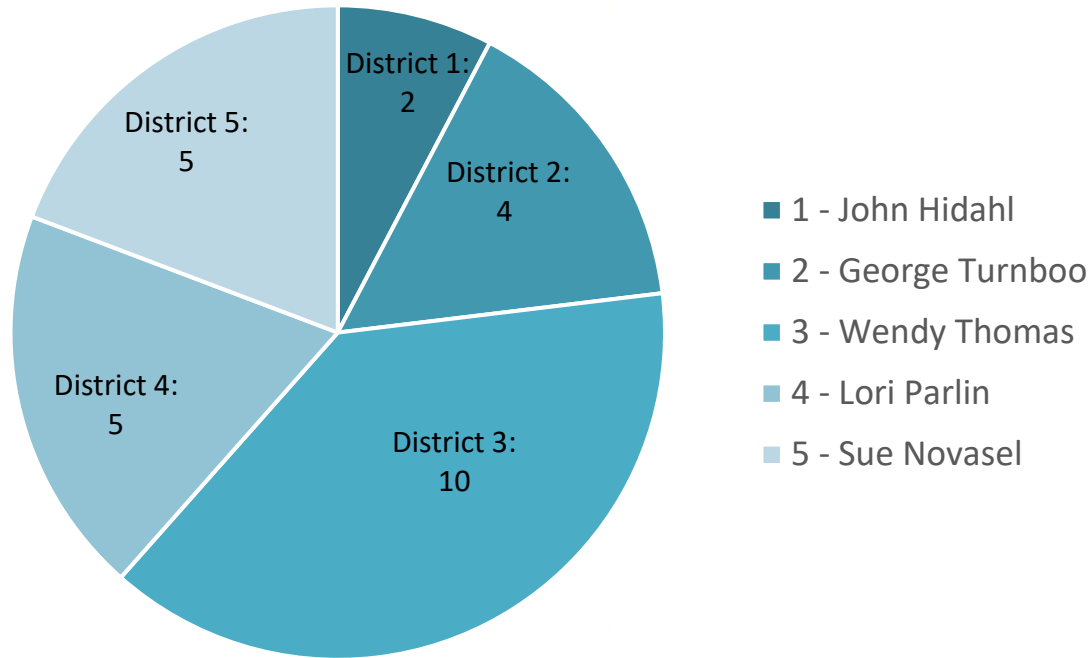


Supervisor Districts

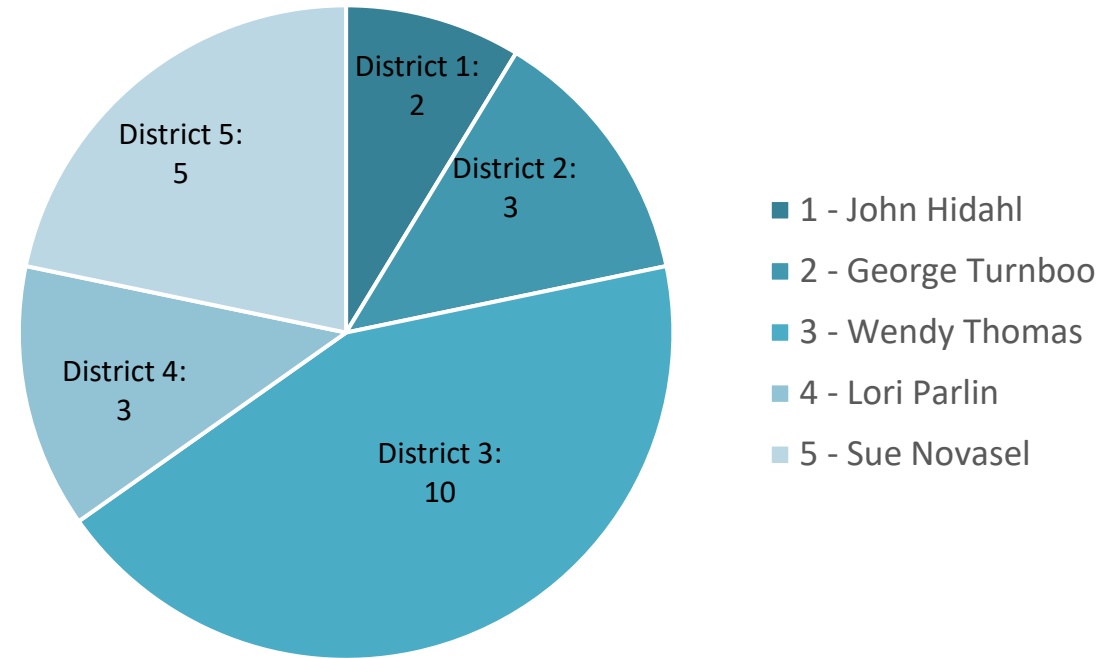


Hot Dots Community Polling

Completed and Planned Events

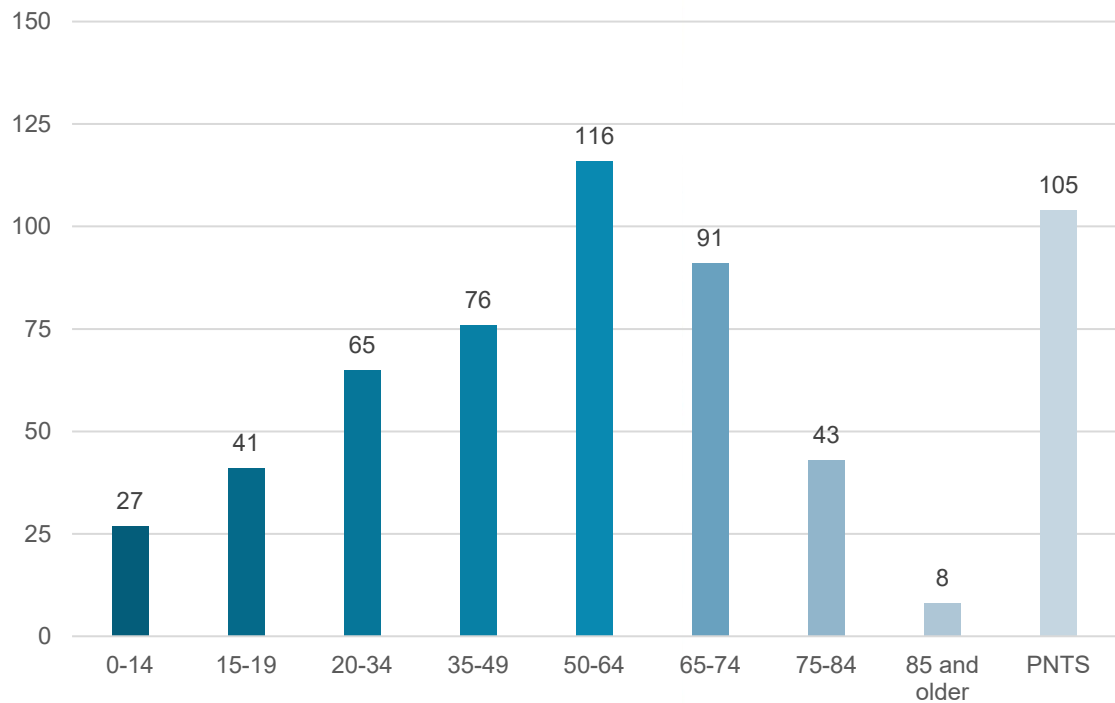


Completed Events as of 10-1-22

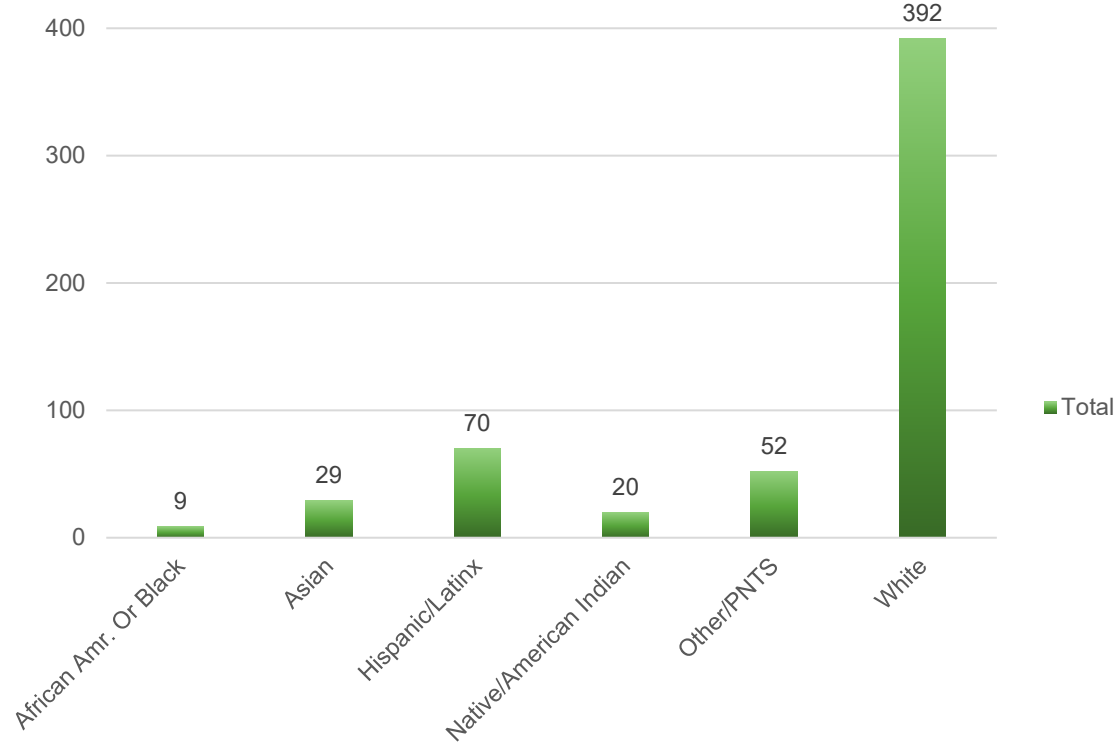


Hot dots demographics (age, race/ethnicity)*

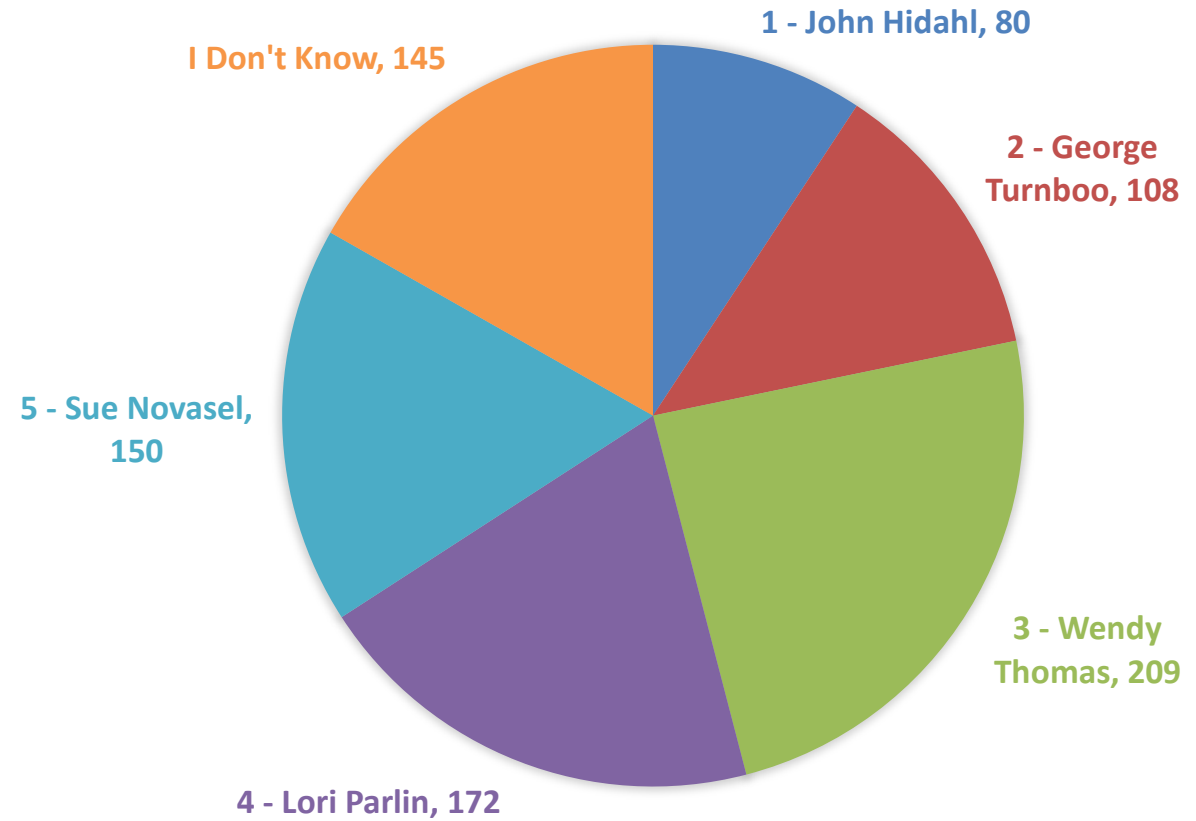

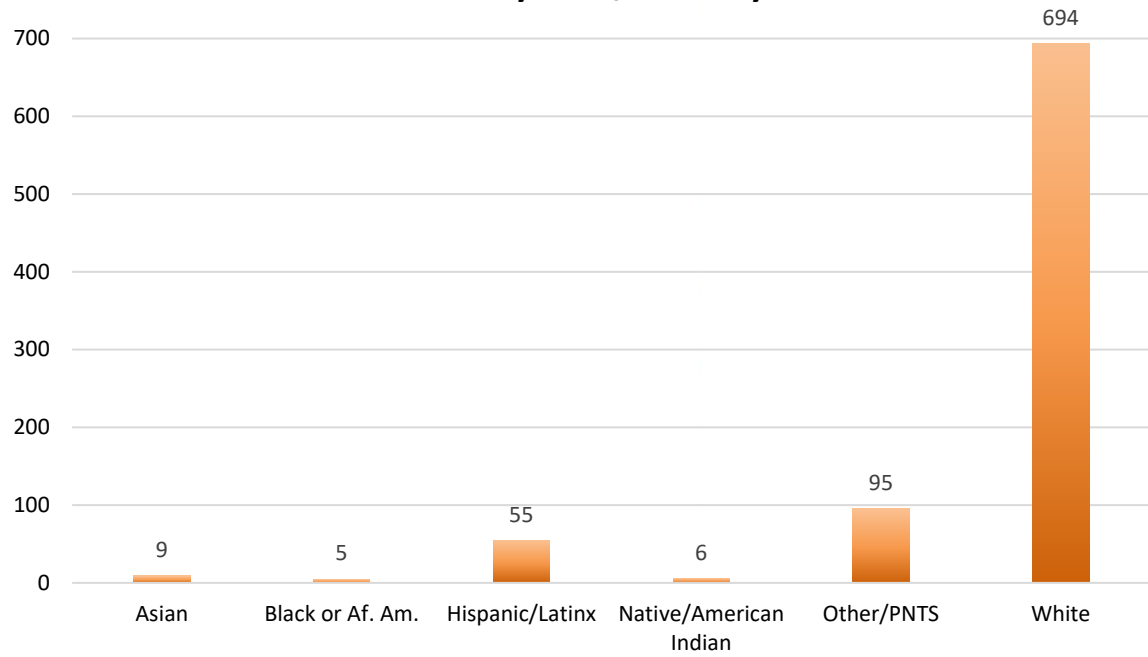

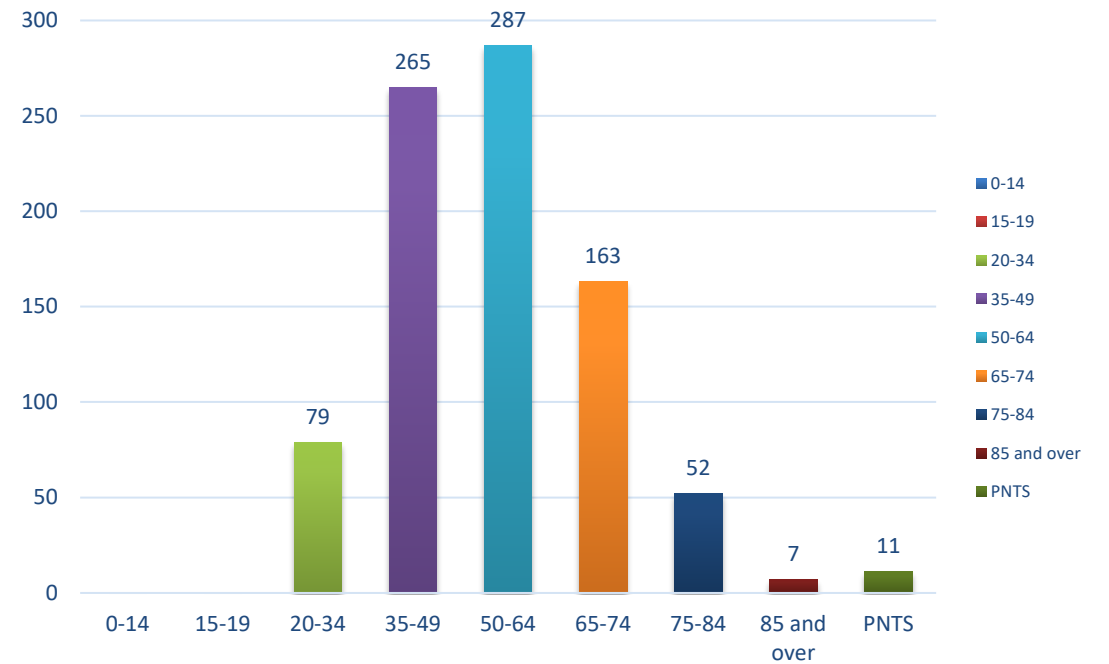


Survey Demographics

Total by Race/Ethnicity



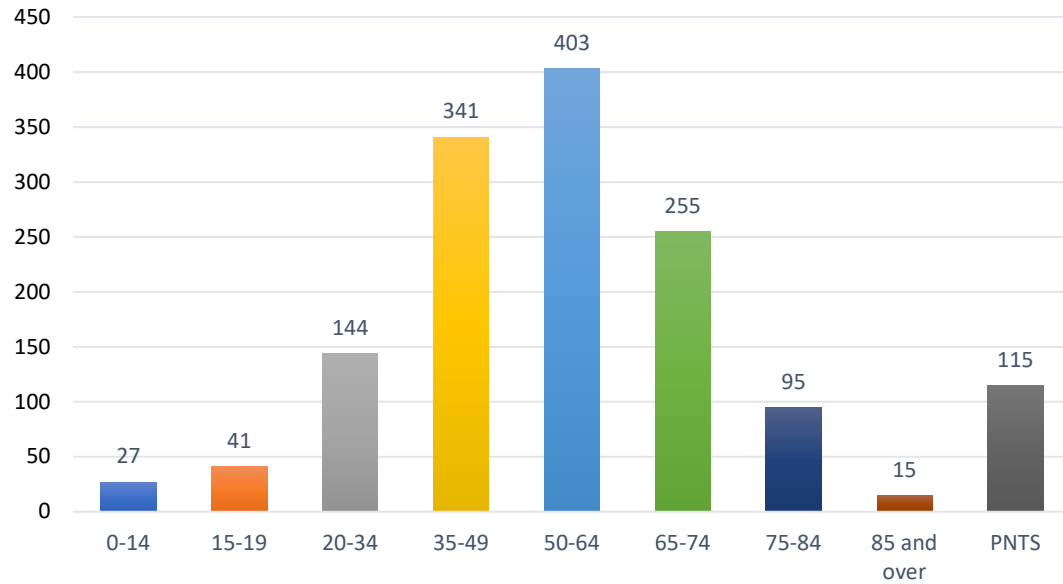
Total by Age



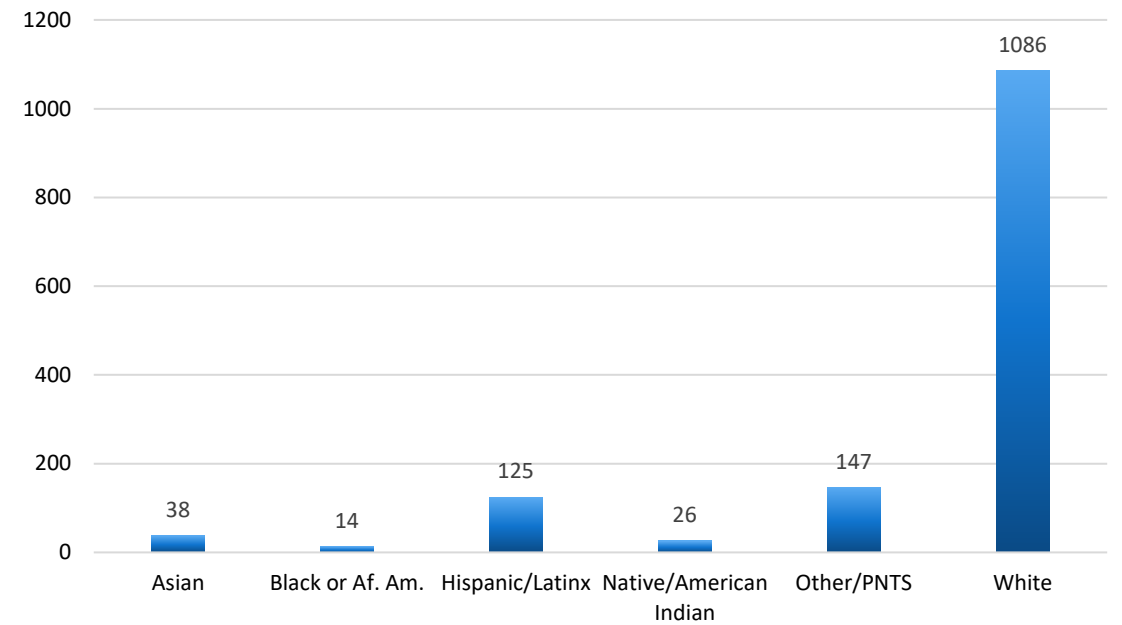
Combined Hot Dots and Survey Results*

Total by Age



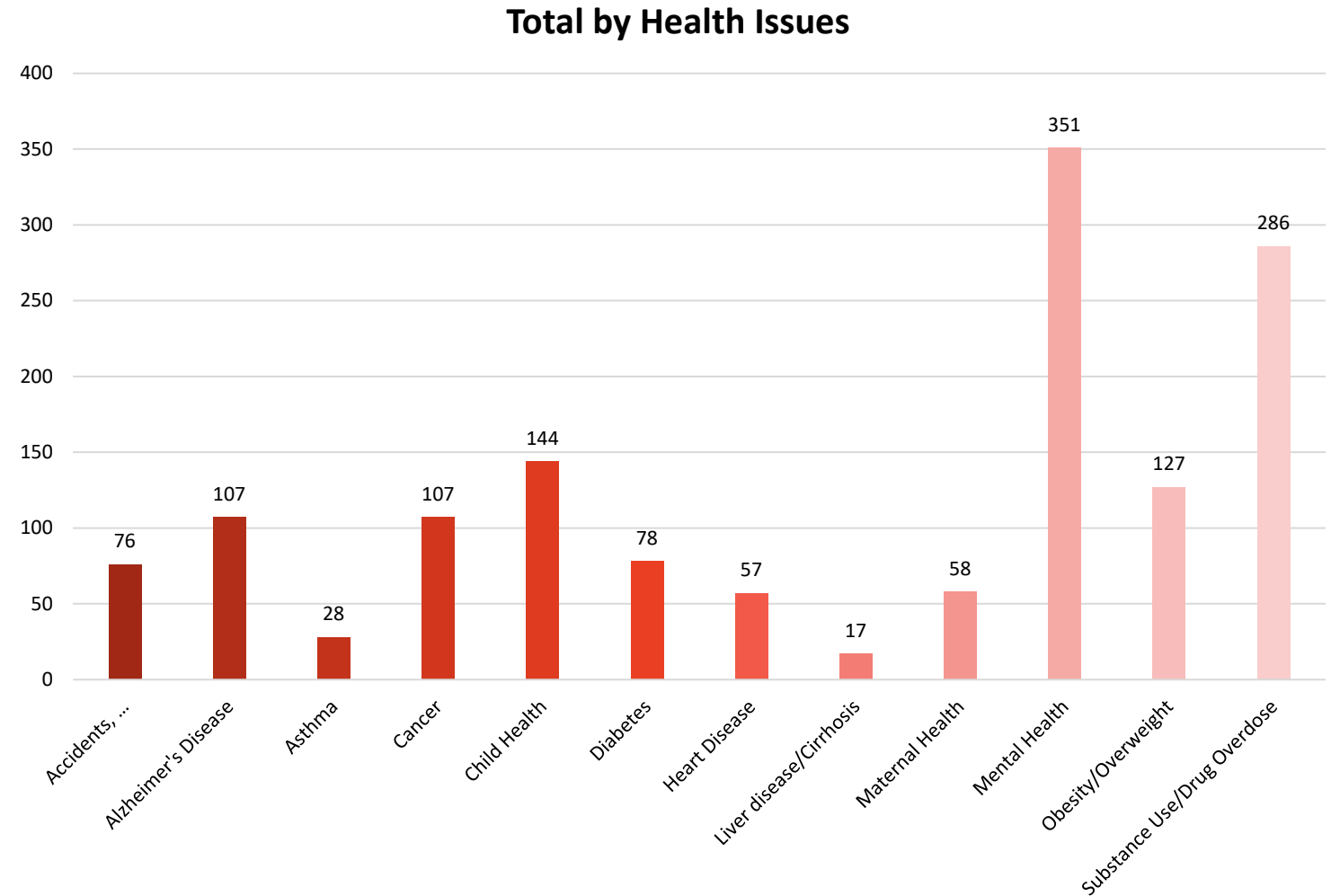
Totals by Race/Ethnicity

2. Substance Use/Drug Overdose
3. Child Health
4. Obesity/Overweight





Top Health Issues by Race/Ethnicity

- **African American or Black:** Substance Use/Drug Overdose; Mental Health; Diabetes; Heart Disease
- **Asian:** Mental Health and Suicide; Alzheimer's Disease; Substance Use/Drug Overdose; Obesity/Overweight
- **Hispanic/Latinx:** Mental Health and Suicide; Diabetes; Child Health; Obesity/Overweight
- **Native/American Indian:** Mental Health and Suicide; Substance Use/Drug Overdose; Obesity/Overweight; Alzheimer's Disease
- **Other/PNTS:** Mental Health and Suicide; Substance Use/Drug Overdose; Obesity/Overweight; Cancer
- **White:** Mental Health and Suicide; Substance Use/Drug Overdose; Child Health; Obesity/Overweight

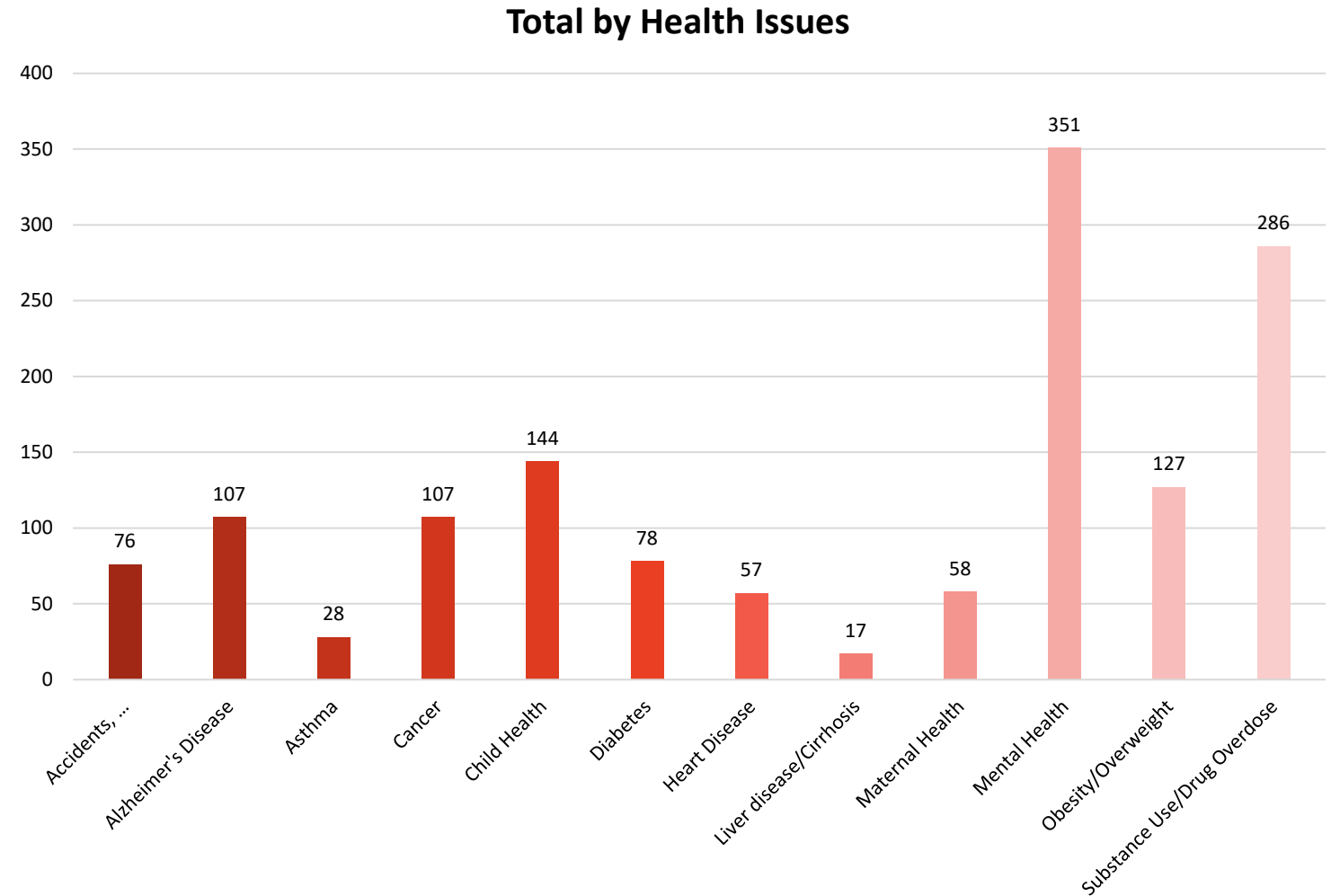


Top Health Issues by Age Category

- **Ages 0-34:** Mental Health and Suicide; Substance Abuse/Drug Overdose; Child Health; Obesity/Overweight
- **Ages 35-64:** Mental Health and Suicide; Substance Abuse/Drug Overdose; Obesity/Overweight; (tie) Alzheimer's Disease and Child Health
- **Ages 65+:** Mental Health and Suicide; Substance Abuse/Drug Overdose; Alzheimer's Disease; (tie) Obesity/Overweight and Child Health
- **Prefer not to share:** Mental Health and Suicide; Substance Abuse/Drug Overdose; Cancer; Obesity/Overweight
