The City Manager finds:

That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within the City of El Segundo, as a result of the coronavirus identified as COVID-19. On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization ("WHO") declared COVID-19 to be a pandemic: the worldwide spread of a new disease against which most people do not have immunity.

The declaration by WHO on March 11, 2020 follows the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Emergency on March 4, 2020. On March 13, 2020, the President declared a National Emergency relating to COVID-19.

It is apparent that local resources are unable to completely cope with the effects of this emergency. These conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency.

Accordingly, pursuant to El Segundo Municipal Code § 2-2-5, a local emergency is proclaimed to exist within the City of El Segundo. This action will be taken to the City Council for confirmation within seven days.
