



Significant Updates

- City Manager Scott Mitnick made a Proclamation of Local Emergency for El Segundo today. It will be presented to City Council for ratification tomorrow evening.
- City Manager Scott Mitnick made an Administrative Orders requiring bars breweries, wine lounges, cigar lounges, and nightclubs closed to the public. Those establishments that serve food may continue to prepare and offer food for takeout or delivery. Restaurants and retail food establishments are also only open for takeout and delivery.
- El Segundo is working with philanthropic groups to provide for the needs of elderly and those with medical issues that have been advised to remain indoors.
- El Segundo is working with Park Vista on the best practices of COVID-19 mitigation with the property group.
- Staff attended a downtown restaurant owners meeting to understand and address their concerns.
- Departments continue to develop continuity plans for level two and three.

Current Initiatives

El Segundo is working with Park Vista on the best practices of COVID-19 mitigation with the property group.
El Segundo is working with philanthropic groups to provide for the needs of elderly and those with medical issues that have been advised to remain indoors.
Recreation and Parks is delivering meals on wheels.
El Segundo has activated a COVID-19 Task Force to monitor the situation and coordinate plans and actions in preparation for pandemic conditions.
El Segundo has established a crisis communications team to monitor information and approve messaging to the public.
El Segundo has closed the El Segundo Public Library, the Jocelyn Center, and Recreation and Parks organized activities.

External Operations Impacting El Segundo

Dockweiler Park: LA County OEM/LA County Dept of Health is utilizing Dockweiler RV Park as an isolation zone for people who have COVID-19 and have no place to self-isolate. El Segundo is recommending residents avoid the area. Currently there are 25 RV's in place. They are taking delivery of 20-25 per day. They plan to have them all by Thursday. El Segundo residents should not go north of 12505 Vista Del Mar where the Youth Center and Beach Café are.
