WHEELER AVE. AT RAILROAD CROSSING (CITY OF LA VERNE)

EXTENDED: AUGUST 1 - AUGUST 13, 2022

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project, crews will return to complete roadway and median construction at the railroad crossing on Wheeler Ave. (north of Arrow Hwy) in the city of La Verne. This work requires a full closure of Wheeler Ave. at the railroad crossing. This is the final work needed to complete the railroad crossing reconstruction, following crews removing and relocating the freight track, installing the two light rail tracks and completing utility work during a three-month closure in Winter 2020.

WHEN

Ongoing and now continuing thru Saturday, August 13th, Wheeler Ave. will be fully closed to all traffic (vehicular and pedestrian) at the railroad crossing 24 hours a day/7 days a week. Arrow Highway (just south of the crossing) and Bonita Ave. (north of the crossing) will remain open and accessible by way of detour routes, see map below.

- Crews plan to work daily during double shift hours of 6:00 AM - 11:00 PM. Overnight work and Sunday shifts may also be required.

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

- Wheeler Ave. will be fully closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the railroad crossing.
- Access to homes and businesses on Wheeler Ave. within the closure area north and south of the railroad crossing will be maintained at all times, as well as access to Wheeler Park, Palomares Ave., 1st St., 2nd St., and 3rd St.

PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND BE PREPARED

- A detour route (see map below) will be in place during the closure and signage will be posted to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow detour signs.
 - ✓ Wheeler Ave. will be fully closed to all traffic at the railroad crossing between Arrow Highway and Bonita Ave.
 - ✓ San Dimas Canyon (northbound and southbound) will serve as the main detour route, see details below.
 - ✓ Arrow Highway (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.
 - ✓ Bonita Ave. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.

NOTE TO RESIDENTS / BUSINESS OWNERS

- Noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones.
- Bus stops may be temporarily relocated, for more information:
