The goal of this training is to introduce patrol officers and investigators to sex and labor human trafficking investigations. The focus will be on understanding the fundamentals and complexity of human trafficking investigations and appreciating the importance of collaborating with community partners and other governmental organizations to ensure a victim-centered approach and successful prosecution. The four-hour training will include presentations from human trafficking survivors, human trafficking victim advocacy organizations, an experienced LAPD Human Trafficking Detective; prosecutors with substantial human trafficking experience, the Director of the Child Trafficking Unit of the Los Angeles County Probation Department, and a supervisor from the Commercial Sexually Exploited Children's Unit of the Los Angeles Department of Children and Family Services. Upon completion of the training, attendees will receive a Certificate of Completion.
